


## OAKS CHRISTIAN SCHOOL



Known as the "Living Curriculum" our faculty engage with students academically but also care deeply about them as individuals. The world class Oaks Christian faculty is comprised of instructors who not only excel in their subject area, but also have a heart and calling to mentor young people. Faculty and staff lead advisory groups, volunteer to chaperone class level trips, and often welcome students at lunchtime or out of class hours for conversation and connection. The teacher—to—student ratio is 8:1, allowing for the kind of access that changes and impacts young lives. Our faculty and staff also excel professionally outside the classroom—publishing original works, having art nationally recognized, and being recognized and awarded as leaders in their fields, to name a few.





The Institute of Engineering at Oaks Christian is a hub of energy and ideas! Housed in the state-of-the art 13,000 sq-foot IDEA Lab, students analyze, model, and design engineering systems, develop skills to solve complex problems, and master the use of software and prototyping tools used in the industry. From creating fiber optic cable lines, designing a complete watering system for a village in Honduras, to building tiny houses and electric cars, students are problem solving for real world applications. Engineering students benefit from guest speakers as well as off-campus excursions to industry locations and extracurricular activities in robotics, cyberpatriots, and the annual solar cup competition.



The Institute of Arts and Innovation is the place for creativity and artistic expression! Traditional visual and performing arts core classes are paired with cutting-edge and innovative arts classes. Students enjoy opportunities such as master classes, guest speakers, internships, and mentorships in the student's chosen pathway: music production, songwriting, vocal performance, film and television, acting for the camera dance or photography. The goal is to develop ethical artists who will impact the world by elevating the culture through their art. Immersive four-year courses of study challenge students and connect them to real-world opportunities and industry leaders. An emphasis on business and entrepreneurship is one of the hallmarks of the institute, helping students to develop and forward their brand in the marketplace.
