WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Education is committed to meeting the unique needs of all students, including military connected students; and



WHEREAS, the Madison County School System will ask students, faculty, and staff to wear purple on a designated day each April to show support and to thank military children for their strength and sacrifices.






