

BOARD OFFICERS

The board shall elect, at its regular meeting in May each year, one of its members to serve as president and one to serve as vice-president. The election shall be by open ballot. The newly elected officers will begin to serve June 1.

The president shall preside at all meetings of the board, and he/she shall call special meetings when required. He/she shall sign, with the superintendent, the minutes and other official documents which require the signature of the president. He/she shall perform other duties prescribed by law or board policy.

In the absence of the president or in the event of his/her death, or his/her inability or failure to act, the vice-president shall perform the duties of the president, and when so acting, shall have all the power of the president.

The superintendent or his or her designee will serve as secretary to the board.
