

## SCHOOL BOARD ATTORNEY

The attorney for the board will be appointed by the board after consulting with and, if possible, securing the concurrence of the superintendent. Questions involving interpretations of federal or state law or judicial precedents not provided by the Attorney General, or covering specific legal procedures may be referred to the attorney for his/her recommendations. Matters specifically involving policy rather than law will be interpreted by the board with assistance from the superintendent. The board may retain secondary legal counsel to assist and handle matters that are of an unusual nature.
