

EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

The School System will emphasize upon the nondiscriminatory provision of educational opportunities for students. The School System does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, disability, national origin, age, or sex in its programs and activities, and provides equal access to the Boy Scouts and other designated youth groups. Programs offered by schools within the School System will be open to all students in compliance with applicable outside-agency guidelines, statutory and judicial requirements, and Board policy.

The Superintendent will designate a member of the staff to investigate any and all complaints which may be brought against the School System in regard to any alleged discriminatory action.
