## MINNEAPOLIS How to Complete an MPS School Request

- Gather Information and learn about placement options for Pre-K through grade 12:
  - Visit **ExploreMPS.org**, attend school tours.
  - Reach out to the Enrollment Team with questions: 612.668.1840 or sps.department@mpls.k12.mn.us
- Request up to three schools.
  - If your first choice is your community school, you do not need to add any other schools.
  - If you are requesting one magnet and your community school, you do not need to add a third choice.
  - If you are requesting two magnets, we recommend that you list your community school as your third choice.
- Submit your request on or before January 31, 2024 Requests received by the due date are included in the 2024-2025 school request lottery and assure you a placement notification by the end of February 2024.
- High Five students attending their community school will be automatically enrolled in kindergarten at that school. High Fivers attending an out of area community school will be automatically assigned to their community school based on their home address. In most cases, High Five students attending magnet schools will be automatically assigned to kindergarten at that school.
- Proof of address will be required for students who are new to MPS, have a new address, or are requesting an oversubscribed school.

## High Five and Three School (Information below pertains to both programs):

Three School and High Five are the MPS preschool programs for eligible children who turn three for Three School or four for High Five on or by September 1, 2024. Most High Five sessions are full-day, with some half-day seats available. Visit ece.mpls.k12.mn.us for more information.

#### Eligibility

Students who A) live in Minneapolis B) will turn three/four years old on or before September 1, 2024, and C) meet at least one of the eligibility requirements below will be entered in a placement lottery. Eligible students:

- 1. Have a Special Education IEP (speech-only does not qualify), or
- 2. Are experiencing Homelessness (HHM, or Homeless/Highly Mobile), or
- 3. Qualify for Educational Benefits (see income guide below);
- 4. Have a Home language other than English plus one of the three criteria listed above.

#### Sliding Fee Scale for High Five

- Tuition costs \$720 per month for Full Day program (\$360 per month
- The sliding fee scale reflects the cost for service based on family income and family size.
- No child will be excluded because of their family's inability to pay.
- The fee for High Five is waived for children who qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- Families who do not qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reducedprice lunch program) will be charged based on a sliding-fee scale.
