With every twist of a wire and connection made, students will exercise their essential problem-solving and critical-thinking skills. By the end of the course, they'll be confident in their ability to design and create impressive circuit-powered gadgets.

Code & Create an APP & Video Game Coding Design

With the power of coding, anything is possible! That's the primary lesson of iCAMP's Code and Create an App course, which uses age-appropriate platforms and interactive challenges to introduce coding concepts like loops, conditionals, cause and effect, and much more.

Throughout the course, young coders will use these concepts to build their own video games, quizzes, and apps. Students will collaborate with their peers to test and revise these apps and their interfaces, learning how to use constructive feedback along the way. With Blocksmith, a 3D content creation tool, students will learn the basics of modern game and app design.

Junior Chemists

We are happy to announce the return of Junior Chemists! Provided by our vendor iCamp and instructed by Ms. Neishtadt, students in N-K have the opportunity to explore chain reactions, the different states of matter, motion, and energy.

Every lesson is designed to engage young scientific minds, allowing students to express their creativity and pick up new interests. Your junior scientists will learn about everything from astronomy to basic physics, expanding their perspective of the world around them with each new project.

Science Experiments

Put on your lab coats and don your safety glasses, iCAMP's Little Einsteins' fun with Science! The course is a broad introduction to core scientific concepts for young learners.

Experiments like self-inflating baking soda and vinegar balloons and mini volcanos encased in lemons will teach them that incredible scientific discoveries wait around every corner, if they just know where to look.

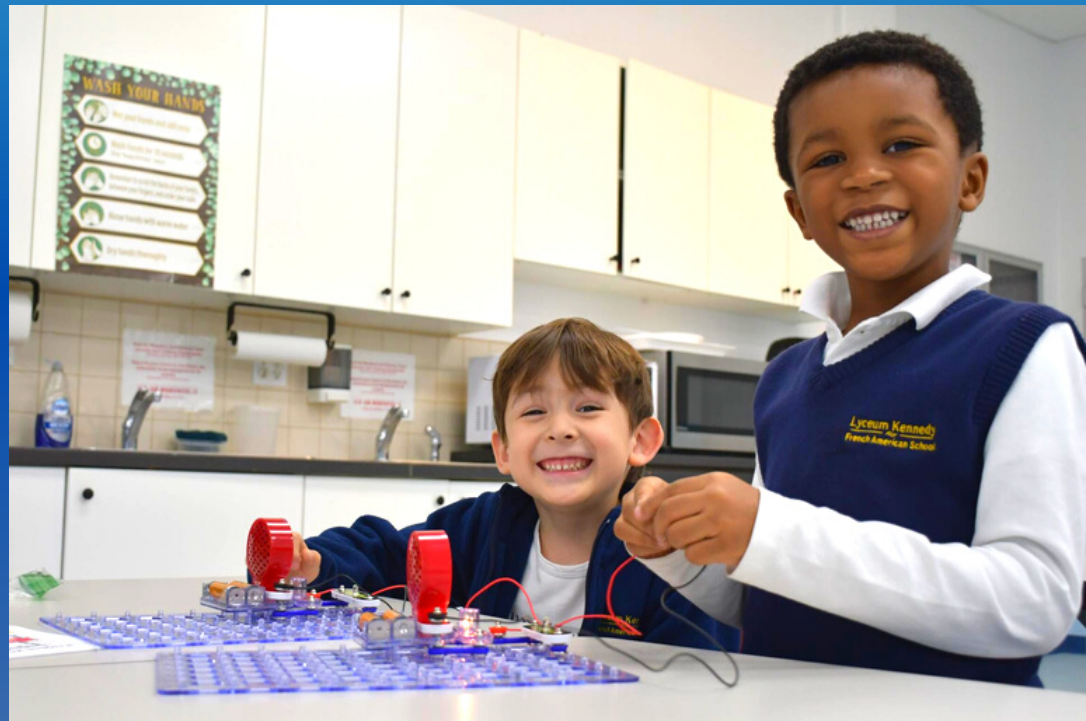
