

AISD REQUIRED STUDENT VACCINES

All 1st Grade and older students must have the following series of vaccinations completed:

- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis - 5 doses
- Polio - 4 doses
- MMR - 2 doses - Both given after the age of 12 months
- Varicella (Chickenpox) - 2 doses or evidence of prior infection
- Hepatitis A - 2 doses at least 6 months apart.

Copies of vaccination records will be required during the Admission process.

For children entering PreK 3, PreK 4 and Kindergarten - Proof of vaccination of the above vaccines will be required to the age-appropriate level as per US CDC guidelines.

AISD RECOMMENDED VACCINES

The following vaccinations series are highly recommended for life in Bangladesh:

- Rabies
- Typhoid
- Hepatitis B
- Japanese Encephalitis

We also strongly recommend remaining up to date with the childhood immunization schedule of your home country, and/or Bangladesh. An annual Influenza vaccination is also recommended. Please regularly check with your healthcare provider to ensure that vaccinations are up to date, as schedules change intermittently.

A Mantoux skin test (PPD) or chest x-ray to screen for tuberculosis is recommended on entry into the country and upon leaving once your family's time in Dhaka has ended. Children who have had a BCG vaccination do not need to be screened.
