PROGRAM

CREDIT BY EXAMINATION

As required by state law, the Board approves a system for the award of credit towards high school graduation that will permit the student to progress at his own rate and increase the effectiveness of his high school experience by awarding credit for competence demonstrated by examination.

Eligibility to receive credit by examination will be limited to those students regularly enrolled in a Douglas County School District high school and whom have never taken the course for which a test is offered. Students so enrolled may receive high school credit in the following designated courses specifically offered in the program of instruction of the Douglas County School District: Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Math I, Math II, Math III, Trigonometry, Computer Literacy, English I, English II, English III, English IV, Principles of Science, Life Science, Physical Science, Health, History of the United States, World History, Government of the United States, Sociology and World Languages..
