Curriculum Update – Jolene Johnson

Principal Report

She is working on getting the district qualified for School-wide Title I Program, that way all the students can be helped. It will be better for the school but the paperwork behind it will take a bit of effort. They also received a grant for paint from East Idaho Public Health, for a Senior Project one senior will be painting hopscotch and other games on the cement.

Superintendent Update
