Once registered, you can attend the meeting through the online link, or by telephone (a call-in number and audio PIN will be provided after you register and prior to the meeting).

PUBLIC COMMENTS

If you would like to make a comment during the Public Comment section or during an agenda item, you may do so in two ways: (1) click the "Raise Hand" icon on the control panel; or (2) email your comment to comment@ecrchs.net and it will be read on the record. **Please note:** your name will be read on the record along with your comment; if you do not wish to have your name read, please indicate on your email.

In order to conduct an orderly meeting, all members of the public will be placed on mute during the Committee meeting, except during public comments. Note that for those who elect to participate through the call-in number, you will not have the option of being unmuted during the meeting.

The Public Comments agenda item is set aside for members of the audience to raise issues that are not specifically on the agenda. However, due to public meeting laws, the Committee can only listen to your issue, not respond or take action. The Committee may give direction to staff to respond to your concern or you may be offered the option of returning with a citizen-requested item. These presentations are limited to three (3) minutes and total time allotted to non-agenda items will not exceed thirty (30) minutes. A member of the public who requires the use of a translator, in order to receive the same opportunity as others to directly address the Committee, shall have twice the allotted time to speak. When addressing the Committee, speakers are requested to adhere to the time limits set forth. In order to maintain allotted time limits, the Committee Chair may modify speaker time allocations or the total amount of allotted time for an item.

Consent Agenda: All matters listed under the consent agenda are considered by the Committee to be routine and will be approved/enacted by the Committee in one motion in the form listed below. Unless specifically requested by a Committee member for further discussion or removed from the agenda, there will be no discussion of these items prior to the Committee votes on them. The Committee recommends approval of all consent agenda items.

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and upon request, El Camino Real Alliance may furnish reasonable auxiliary aids and services to qualified individuals with disabilities. CDO Academic Decathlon Round 1 Scrimmage

December 3 and 4, 2019

Dear Academic Decathlon Coach,

You are cordially invited to attend the annual Canyon del Oro Academic Decathlon Round 1 Scrimmage, which will take place on **Friday and Saturday, December 3 and 4, 2021**. I hope that this scrimmage will be an invaluable tool in helping to train your team for the regional competition and to aid you in determining the make-up of your team. Please read the following information carefully. This scrimmage will be completely in person this year, with safety protocols in place.

Teams: The scrimmage is open to up to 20 schools, divided into two divisions: the Arizona Division, consisting of teams from Arizona, and the National Division, consisting of teams from outside of Arizona. Each team may bring up to 18 students. We will be using the official USAD Round 1, v2 tests, which may be distinct from the Round 1 tests given elsewhere. **If you plan to attend, please fill out the team form immediately at: <https://forms.gle/XnFGCErfZi3NsF3LA>**

Prizes: For each subject there will be certificates for the top five students in each GPA category. Furthermore, the top three overall (ten event) scores in each GPA category will receive medals. The top three teams at the Super Quiz relay will each receive a plaque. The three highest scoring teams overall will win trophies. Please see the registration link in the section at the end of this letter.

Tentative Competition Schedule: The CDO Scrimmage will follow a schedule similar to that of the Arizona regional and state competitions.

Financial and Judging Support: The cost of the scrimmage will be \$25 per student. If you cannot provide the requisite number of judges (see below), this will increase to \$35 per student. **The full amount (or a PO for this amount) is due by Friday, November 19, 2019.** This will cover the cost of dinner on Friday as well as the costs of judges' meals, trophies, plaques, certificates, medals, answer forms, copying costs, etc. **Any team paying after the November 19 deadline must pay a \$5 per student additional fee.** Please start the paperwork for your payment immediately! **Each team (competing in all ten events) must furnish at least 2 essay judges, 2 speech judges and 2 interview judges, more if possible.** If you will not be able to supply the judges, you will have to pay an additional amount for each student, as outlined above. Please see the judge registration link in the section at the end of this letter.

Testing Only Option (In-Person): Those coaches who want their teams to have the opportunity of taking the scrimmage tests, but don't want the cost or bother of providing judges, can choose the option of having their teams take the tests only. The tests will be administered on Saturday, December 4, starting at 8:00AM in a specially designated testing room at CDO. The cost is only \$10 per student, and students are still eligible to win prizes. However, these students will not be able to participate in the speech, interview or essay competition. Please see the registration link in the section below.


Testing Only Option (Remote): Teams wishing to take the scrimmage tests remotely can do so but will not be eligible for any awards. They will receive a full scoring report. There is some flexibility in the testing date, but should be on Saturday, 12/4. The cost for this option is \$5 per student. Please see the registration link in the section below.

Super Quiz Relay: We will have a collaborative Super Quiz Relay. All three Varsity students from each team will take the floor, and answer 12 questions, 2 from each academic area (except math), spending 10 seconds discussing the responses with each other before time is called. All three Scholastic students, and then all three Honor students will follow them in subsequent rounds. Extra students will be able to form overflow teams. The results from the Relay will NOT be used as part of the overall team score; however, we will award a plaque to the top three teams in the Relay.

IMPORTANT: Please email me immediately if you plan to attend. All other forms (and payments) are due no later than November 19, 2021, preferably sooner.
