

MINUTES

The Campbell County Board of Education Athletic Committee met on Tuesday, August 9, 2011, at 5:30 p.m., at the Central Office conference room. Board members present were: Johnny Creekmore, Johnny Byrge, J.L. "Sarge" Collins, Rector Miller, Mike Orick. Director of Schools, Donnie Poston was present and Gail T. Parks kept the minutes.

Countywide Athletic Director, Johnny Bruce informed the board that he has requested from principals a monthly statement of gate and concessions received at their schools.

- I. Adopt mandatory beverage purchase from Beverage Company at all schools and events.

Motion by Orick, second by Lynch to adopt mandatory beverage purchase from Beverage Company at all schools and events. All members approved the motion.

- II. Discuss building usage to civic groups and other organizations.

Board member Miller stated this was a concern especially at Campbell County High School. People do not need to bring in food and drinks into the new auditorium to spill on the new seats. The fee should be set high to use the facility. Board member Byrge stated we should get a policy in place. Johnny Bruce is to contact surrounding counties to see what their system has in place for using facilities and bring back recommendation to the Athletic Committee.

- III. Old and new business.

Johnny Bruce stated he had spoken with Athletic Directors at each school regarding admission of staff at athletic events. After discussion the committee agreed to set the price of events at \$5.00 per adult and \$3.00 for students if sold in advance. Only staff members at the hosting school of the event will be permitted to free admission.

Motion by Orick, second by Lynch to set fee of athletic events at \$5.00 per adult and \$3.00 advance sale for students. Only staff members at the hosting school of the event will be permitted for free admission. All members approved the motion.

Chairman Orick stated LaFollette Middle School was in need of football equipment and the school is facing financial difficulties and recommended the board help them by giving \$6,000.00 towards this purchase. The funds will be used from Capital Outlay. All members of the committee agreed to Chairman Orick's recommendation.

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Johnny Bruce informed the board that elementary sports will remain the same. 5 additional boys and girls games will be scheduled for Junior Varsity. All schools are required to submit athletic financial reports to Johnny Bruce.
