

MINUTES

The Campbell County Board of Education Athletic Committee met on Thursday, April 12, 2012, 5:30 p.m., at the Central Office conference room. Committee members present were: Johnny Creekmore, Chairman, Johnny Byrge, Rector Miller, Josh Parker, and Scott Hill. Director of Schools, Donnie Poston was present and Gail Parks kept the minutes.

Call meeting to order.

I. Discuss elementary basketball scheduling.

Johnny Bruce stated he had met with the principals and coaches and they recommend that one game per week be played and to play on Tuesday night. This schedule is only for elementary schools and teams may not play more than 10 games. Each team will play each other only once until the county tournament. Board member Miller asked how many problem incidents occurred this season. Mr. Bruce stated the majority of problems came from cheerleading issues.

II. Approve elementary basketball schedule.

Motion by Miller, second by Byrge to approve elementary basketball scheduling. All committee members concurred.

III. Approve elementary basketball rules.

Johnny Bruce distributed the elementary basketball rules.

Motion by Miller, second by Hill to approve elementary basketball rules. All committee members concurred.

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- IV. Approve Valley View elementary for host of 2012 countywide basketball tournament.

Chairman Creekmore asked if the facility was large enough to accommodate everyone. Mr. Bruce stated yes. Mr. Rutherford has assured Mr. Bruce that someone would be on duty watching the cars parked in the back of the building. Board member Byrge feels like they need to get to the point of where they have the tournament in Jellico one year and the next year have it a central location and split the money between the schools. Mr. Bruce stated this was on a rotational basis.

Motion by Miller, second by Byrge to approve Valley View Elementary to host the 2012 countywide basketball tournament.

All committee members concurred.

- V. Discuss scoreboard at Jellico High School.

Johnny Bruce discussed the condition of the scoreboard at Jellico High School. The scoreboard needs to be replaced. Mr. Bruce stated this would give the opportunity to take the current one at Jellico High and move it to Jellico Elementary. Board member Rutherford asked if the Pepsi Company would donate one. Board member Miller stated they would only give a discount on one. Chairman Creekmore stated he was told the approximate cost would be \$9000.00. Board member Rutherford stated this could be put into a budget request for next year's budget. Board member Hill stated he didn't know how much would be left in Capital Outlay. Board member Byrge recommended that Pepsi be contacted and see if something could be worked out for both high schools. They could possible get sponsors. Chairman Creekmore request Johnny Bruce to get estimates and this item will be discussed in the finance committee.

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VI. Discuss Volunteer Coaches.

A list of volunteer coaches was distributed. Board member Miller stated there have been some issues and the board may want to try to consider to get an employee or teacher to fill the volunteer coaching positions. Director Poston was in agreement with this suggestion. Board member Miller made the recommendation for each principal and athletic director to make every effort to get a school employee before volunteer coaches are considered. Johnny Bruce stated if you have a school employee they have someone they have to answer to. Board member Miller stated it also needed to be added volunteer paid coaches because they all receive a supplement. All volunteer coaches will be approved through the Athletic Committee. The volunteer coaches list will be available in August. A list of individual schools head coaches was distributed. Chairman Creekmore stated that by looking at the head coaches list there was no coach listed at Jellico Elementary. Chairman Creekmore asked Mr. Bruce to check and see if any money was being spent on football at Jellico Elementary. Board member Miller asked if each coach has been evaluated. A name was deleted due to not being evaluated. Board member Miller recommended they accept and approve the names on head coaching list due to the evaluation process with the exception Jellico Elementary. Recommendation by second by Byrge. All committee members concurred.
