

MINUTES

The Campbell County Board of Education Security Committee met on Tuesday, December 10, 2013, 5:00 p.m., in the Central Office conference room. Members present were: Rector Miller, Josh Parker and Scott Hill. Officer Shayne Wolfenbarger with the Campbell County Sheriff's Department was present along with Director of Schools Donnie Poston and Gail Parks kept the minutes.

Officer Wolfenbarger gave an overview of the schools. He made a request for 6 lapel cameras which he stated would cost approximately \$100.00 each. Officer Wolfenbarger stated these cameras document incidents. The new camera system at Campbell County High school has a new DVR system and they are in need of more. The text a tip has been slower than usual. Officer Wolfenbarger has a new card and will give one out to the board next week. Officer Wolfenbarger also discussed the upcoming vestibule project and stated he felt there was a need to filter everyone to one side of the building.

Discussion was held regarding improvement on the security guard at Campbell County High School and was recommended that the person in this position wear a security uniform. Board member Parker stated that a deterrence. Board member Miller asked if the doors were being checked. Officer Wolfenbarger stated yes and a camera was also needed at the guard shack and on outside of the building. Board member Parker asked if middle schools were eligible for the grant this upcoming year and perhaps we could have a company to come and give estimates for cameras in all our schools.

Board member Miller stated he has been asked what the purpose was for Officer Lindsay at Campbell County High Schools. Mrs. Tammie Lay stated he monitored the building after hours. Officer Wolfenbarger expressed his concern about drama with Facebook and Twitter and they need to be able to see what was happening with some instances.

Discussion was held regarding the possibility of using Constables and retired officers for security personnel to possibly work at ballgames and etc. Board attorney Cantrell can give the board a needed clear and precise decision if they could be utilized for security personnel.

Board member Hill stated that an actual security person was needed at the guard shack. Officer Wolfenbarger stated they need a photo ID. Board member Miller stated if you have a photo ID if someone is not supposed to be in the building a picture could be posted. Mr. Cannon will be contacted about this issue of photo ID's.

Discussion was held regarding additional School Resource Officers for Elementary Schools. Board member Miller stated he hoped to have this funded for next year. Board member Miller stated our security and safety was more important than our find balance. Board member Miller stated our sheriff's department was doing an excellent job. Board member Hill asked if there were any potential grants for this issue. Director Poston stated he will be looking for any opportunities.

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Board member Hill stated he felt that they should have done 1 or 2 this year and they have identified the need. Board member Miller stated he was concerned about the schools in the mountain area. Director Poston will work on this.

An update was given on the security vestibules. The finance department as approved the firm of JBJM for this project
