<b>Writing</b>  <b>Focus: Forming Letters Correctly</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Work on correct formation of letters and provide D'Nealian guides for correct letter formation to parents for practice at home.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Build fine motor skills with activities like cutting with scissors and playing with PlayDough.</li> <li>- Model correct formation of letters and numbers.</li> <li>- Provide time and materials for writing letters.</li> <li>- Use markers on white boards, sidewalk chalk, fingers in sand, or pencils to practice writing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Practice writing letters at home using the correct form.</li> </ul>
<b>Math</b>  <b>Focus: Labeling sets to 20</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Provide suggestions for online activities or games that involve counting.</li> <li>- Provide materials to help students build number sense.</li> <li>- Set goals with students to promote success with counting.</li> <li>- Provide Parent Night to assist in building number sense.</li> <li>- Provide students with take home packets to use to practice fluency.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Provide sets of objects (pennies, blocks, cars, legos) for student to count. Watch to make sure students touch each object and say one number at a time.</li> <li>- Utilize materials sent home to help students build number sense.</li> <li>- Monitor progress on child's goals in math.</li> <li>- Attend Parent Night to learn how to help your student build number sense.</li> <li>- Use take home packets to help students with fluency.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Practice counting sets of objects and writing the correct number to go with sets.</li> <li>- Use materials sent home to help learn more about numbers.</li> <li>- Know goals in math.</li> <li>- Use materials and activities from Parent Night to build number sense.</li> <li>- Practice with the take home packets.</li> </ul>
