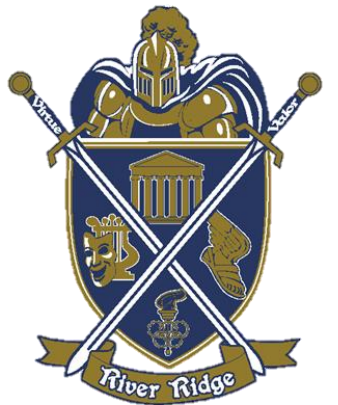
# World Language Pathway

- World Language is **NOT** a graduation requirement
- Students are required to have two years to enter a four-year university
  - KSU, USA, GaTech, GA Southern
- Students who wish to begin a world language need to have strong grades and test scores to be placed. Not all 9<sup>th</sup> graders who request will be placed in World Language.

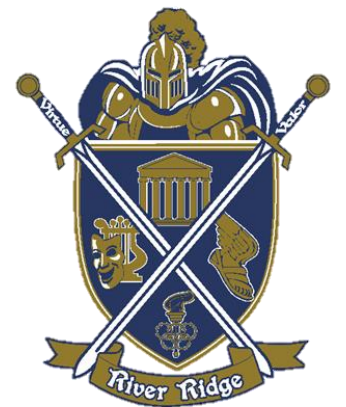
- Spanish

RRHS offers the International Skills Diploma Seal for students who excel in language study. Ask your counselor about the requirements if you wish to pursue this seal.



# Fine Arts Pathway

- Students who are in Band, Chorus, Drama, or pursuing a career in visual arts will be encouraged to take these courses all 4 years.
- Counselors will work with students to set up individual plans to meet all graduation requirements and to stay within their fine arts curriculum.
- RRHS offers the Fine Arts Graduation Seal. Ask your counselor or an art teacher for more information.



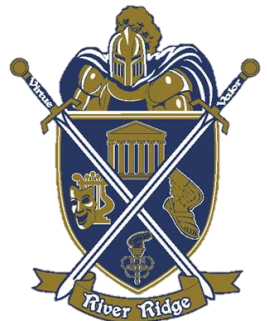
# Pathway Electives

For example:

Students who compete interscholastically are encouraged to take Strength and Conditioning.

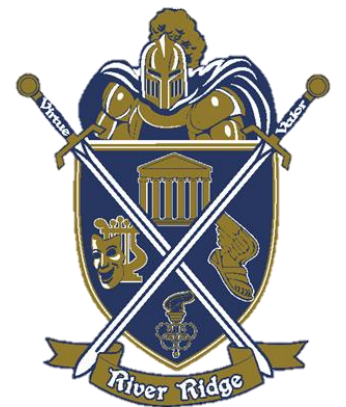
General Physical Education is the course title in the system.

Students who do not compete in sports can take

- Weight Training

- Any other PE elective

Athletes who do not have room in their schedule for Strength and Conditioning need to work with their coaches to be sure they participate in strength and conditioning programs in some other way.



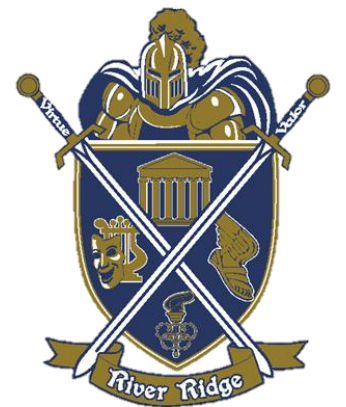

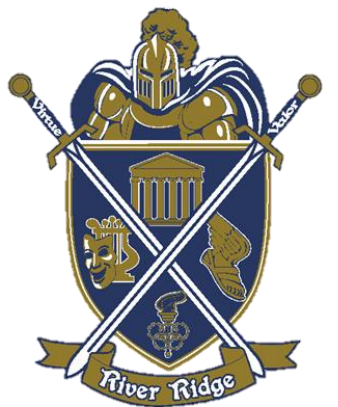
# AP Course Requests

Students wishing to take an AP course should request the course digitally.

The teacher will check the student's transcript and other test scores (PSAT, EOC, etc.) to ensure the proper placement for the student.

The teacher will then recommend qualified student to be placed in the AP course.

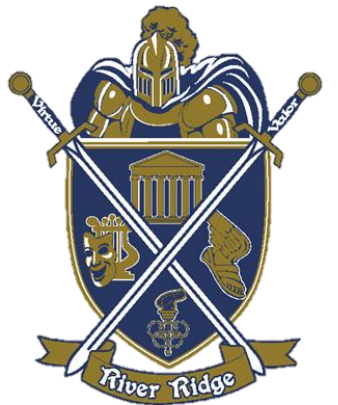

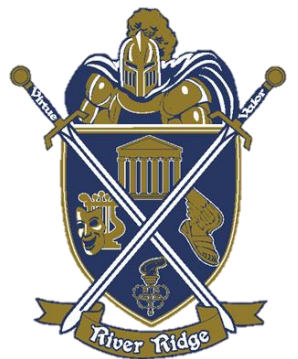
# Honors Course Requests

- Students will be placed in honors courses by their current teachers.

- Students wishing to move down from Honors level will need to have their parent/guardian request the drop in level via email.



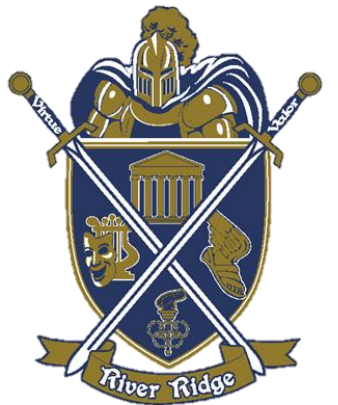
# Registration - Elective Offerings

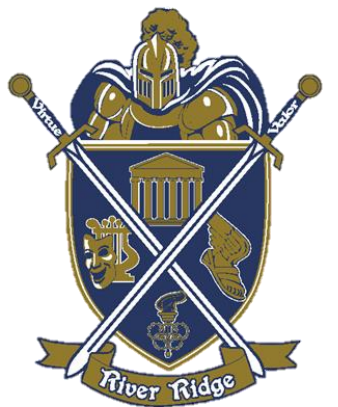
# HOPE Scholarship

- 4 rigor courses

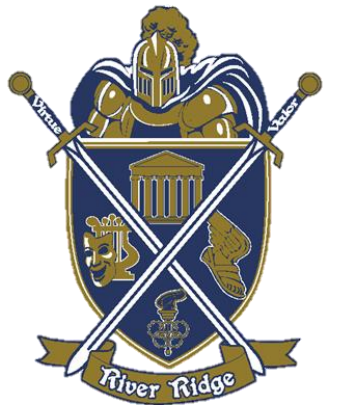

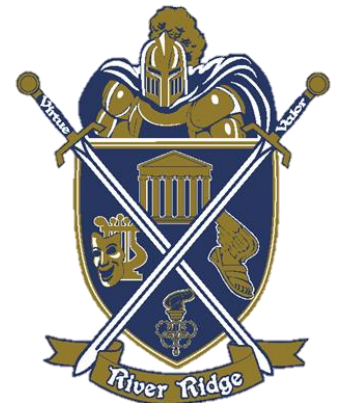
