WHAT MAKES A GOOD FACE COVERING?



An effective face covering should:

HAVE MULTIPLE LAYERS

The best face coverings provide multiple layers of fabric for increased defense against droplets.



FIT SNUGLY

Loose face coverings may droop, causing your nose or mouth to be exposed. If needed, double loop over ears for a more snug fit.

BE WASHABLE

Face coverings made of cloth are ideal since they can be machine washed and dried; and should be frequently.

BE SECURED WITH TIES OR EAR LOOPS

Use these ties to put on and remove your covering. Avoid touching the part of your face covering that is near your mouth and nose.

COVER YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH

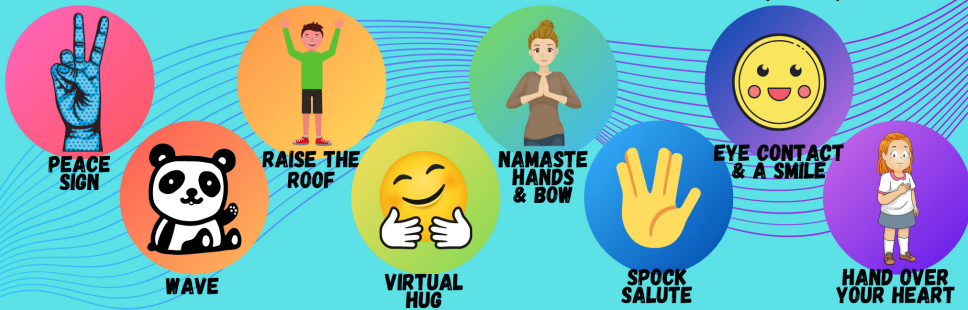
Both sneezing and coughing release droplets. By covering both your nose and mouth, the maximum number of droplets are kept from entering the air.

ALLOW YOU TO BREATHE FREELY

Face coverings are designed so oxygen can pass through while droplets are limited. Avoid wet face coverings.

Day Plus is our district's fee based before and after school care service for students in grades Pre-K through 5th. Day Plus also offers homework help and offers a variety of activities. During the school year, Day Plus operates from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. (mornings) and 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (after school) Day Plus offers after school care on half days as well. When school is not in session, Day Plus offers full day care from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on teacher in-service days, inclement weather days depending on severity of weather, and some holiday vacation days when school is closed. Day Plus also offers full day care 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during the summer. A variety of fee options are available for families on a limited budget. The district offers sliding scale fees to families which qualify for Department of Family Services financial assistance.
