Christine Richiez – Girls Tennis

*Mr. Brown spoke about the athletic teams being honored tonight. His first award presentation was to Christine Richiez, for being named Athlete of the Week by The Record for her accomplishments in Girls Tennis. He mentioned that this was her second time being named Athlete of the Week. He also reviewed some of her accomplishments, which included having a perfect record for the year, and being the all-time winningest Girls Tennis player at Park Ridge.*

*His next presentation was to the members of the Girls Tennis team which finished the year with a 13-1 divisional record. He mentioned that was on their journey to winning the Patriot division. He then called each member of the team up and presented them each with a championship sweatshirt. He concluded by calling up the coaching staff to acknowledge their accomplishments.*

*Mr. Brown then spoke about the Girl's Cross-country team. He indicated that they had a banner year, winning the NJIC Patriot Division, and being the Bergen County Group C Champions, and the North 1 Group 1 State sectional champs. The team was also named Bergen County Group Small School team of the year. They finished their season with a perfect 10-0 record. He mentioned that this was the first State Sectional title for Park Ridge in this sport. He then called each member of the team up and presented them with a championship sweatshirt. He concluded by recognizing the team's coaches.*

*Mr. Farrell was also honored as NJIC Patriot Division Coach of the year for his work with the Girls Cross Country team. Mr. Brown pointed out that it was a historic season for the team and a tremendous accomplishment. He presented the coach with a trophy and certificate.*

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## **IX. President's Report**

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Mr. Bradler updated the public on the proposed Football merger with Emerson. The State association reviewed the application and rejected it. The next step is to present the matter to the Executive Board for appeal. If approved, it would go back to the State Association for reconsideration. If rejected, then there is still one more level of appeal that can be pursued. For now, Park Ridge programs will move forward as they had before. If something changes, the program will adapt to the new situation.

Mr. Bradler then thanked Dr. Bernardo and the rest of the administration for their recent success during the QSAC review.

He also congratulated all the sports teams on their success.

## **X. Superintendent's Report**

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### **HIB Update**

Dr. Gamper reported that there were 4 HIB incidents at the High School with one being confirmed. There were none at West Ridge or East Brook.

He stated that on March 7, wearing a mask in school will become optional, including transport on buses.

He mentioned that the Girls and Boys Basketball teams were having home playoff games this week. He thanked the administration for having a successful QSAC review and indicated that the district did "very well" and was in good shape.

He concluded by reporting that the meeting with the State on the Emerson Merger will be on March 10, 2022, in Robbinsville, NJ.

## **XI. BOE Committee Reports**

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**Buildings & Grounds/Security** – Reviewed plans on the bathroom renovations. Bids will be out in March and construction will be done over the summer. The Nurse's office will be renovated and a single-use bathroom added. The district will be adding security cameras to the front of the building and areas outside the cafeteria. There will be a rekeying project going on in all three buildings. The Tennis court project is out for bid and moving forward.

*Education – Discussed revising the job description for the Special Education Supervisor. They also reviewed the State mandated curriculum updates and reviewed staffing requests. They spoke about summer 2022 programs and the incoming 7th-grade orientation.*

*Finance – Met twice in the past month to discuss the 2022-23 budget. They reviewed the staffing requests. At the second meeting, they brought the budget down and covered the additional staff. In the process now of preparing budget submission documents for County review.*

*Policy – Newly established committee. They met for the first time to review and discuss several areas of concern.*

*Personnel – Met with the Administrator and Supervisors Union to discuss a new bargaining agreement. They also discussed the potential of adding a health teacher and are awaiting additional information on this.*

**XIV. Hearing of Citizens**

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*Ms. Cooper expressed concerns about students being quarantined constantly. She felt it was disruptive to their education.*

*Ms. Wagner responded by stating that the Policy Committee met this evening. They recommend that there be a stigma-free environment and that the district should make it a priority to keep kids in school. The district will also stress that children or staff who are feeling sick, should stay at home. Dr. Gamper will be sending out more specific information on this.*

*Ms. Frank commented that she agreed with Ms. Cooper. She read something about the Middletown NJ school district which made quarantining optional. Two months later, the data showed that it did not lead to an increase in cases.*

*Dr. Gamper responded that Middletown and Westwood have both dropped contact tracing. The focus for Park Ridge will be to have healthy children stay in school and try to avoid remote learning.*
