PATHWAY TO THE SEAL OF BILITERACY AWARD

The State Seal of Biliteracy recognizes students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school. At Oak Grove School District, we created a pathway for students to be recognized for their successful academic achievement in English and Spanish. Students who participate in our Dual Language programs will have the opportunity to obtain the Pathway to the Seal of Biliteracy Award.

This award intends to encourage students to continue their journey toward biliteracy as they progress through middle school to high school. Students who meet this local criterion will be granted the Pathway to the Seal of Biliteracy Award at the end of eighth grade







THE PROGRAM

Dual Language Immersion is a unique educational model where children learn to think, read, write and communicate naturally in two languages: English and Spanish. Native Spanish and English speaking students study both languages beginning in Kindergarten through 8th grade, to be biliterate in both languages.

The Davis Intermediate Two-Way Bilingual Immersion program is an option in OGSD for students to continue their pathway to biliteracy. Students who participated in dual language programs in elementary school will automatically transfer to Davis to continue in grades 7-8, unless they initiate a transfer to their home intermediate school. Students who immigrate from Spanish speaking countries can enter on a case by case basis, depending on proficiency.
