



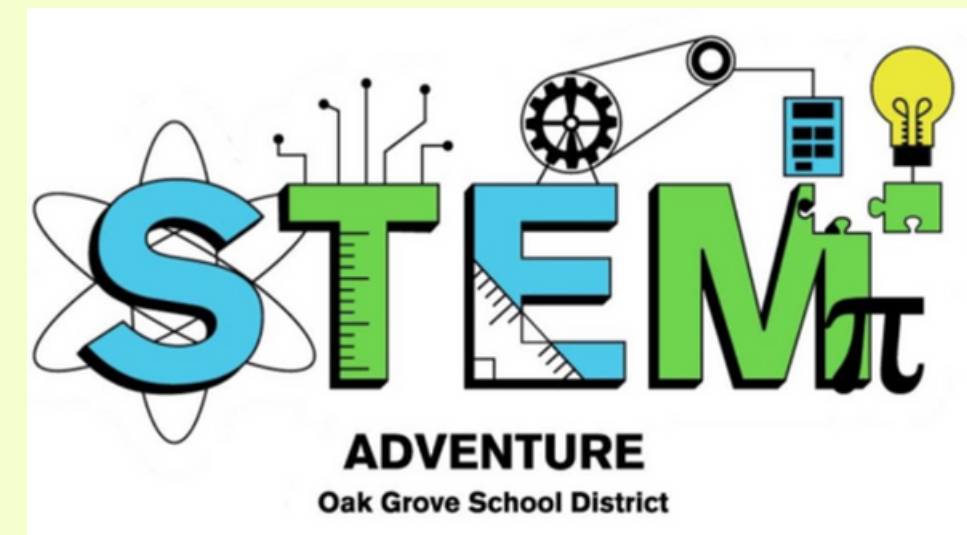
OUR PROGRAM

The curriculum is based on Common Core Standards. Students have access to technology in all classes and gain hands-on experience in STEM fields through real-world projects, public speaking presentations and guest speakers. Students participate in all aspects of middle-school life, including daily Physical Education, after school sports (6th-8th grades), lunchtime clubs and technology-centered classes such as Maker Space, computer science, video-game design, and engineering design. Students are welcome to apply at any grade-level, however, students benefit from the full AdVENTURE experience if enrolled for multiple years.

- *Like to figure out how things work.*



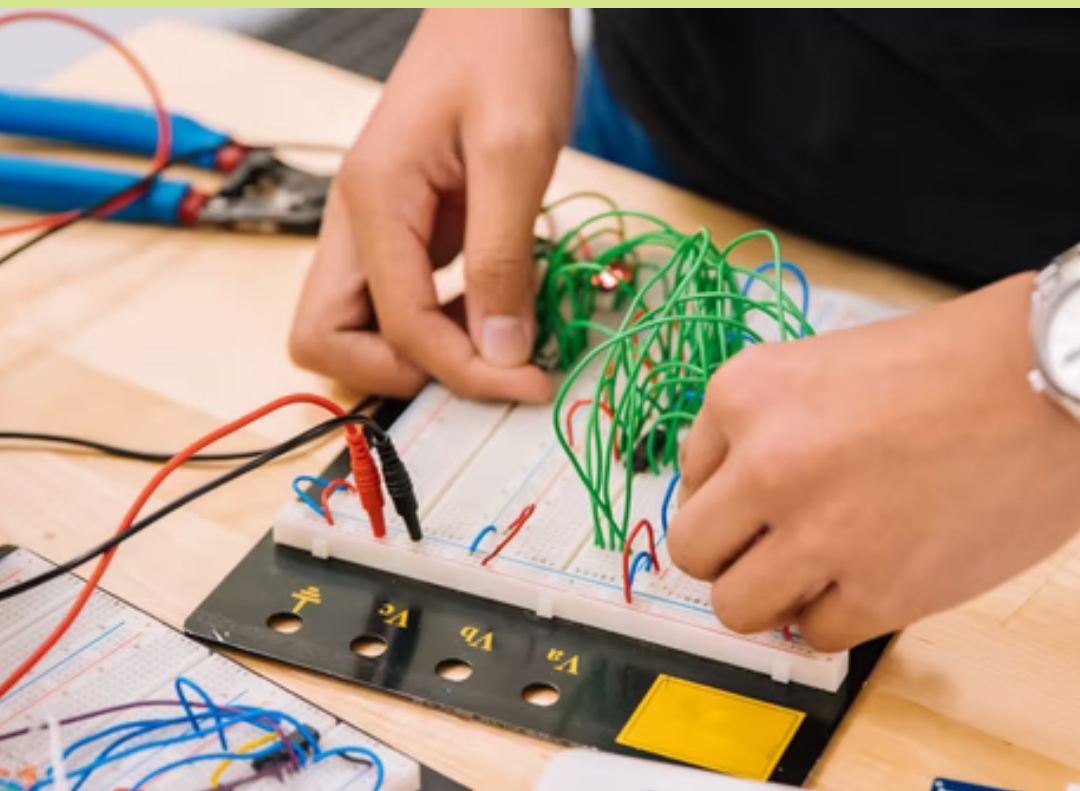
ADVENTURE STEM
