<b>Eligibility:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be an African American student who is a resident of Brazoria County</li> <li>Must be a student at Angleton, Brazosport, Brazoswood, Columbia, or Sweeny High School</li> <li>Must be an active participant in extracurricular activities</li> <li>Must be an active participant in one or more church and civic activities.</li> </ul>
