

Fourth Grade Behavior Management Policy

Students are expected to follow the school norms inside and outside of the classroom. These norms are: **be respectful, be responsible, be a problem solver, and be safe.**

In order to monitor student behavior we monitor the class in 3 ways: individual, groups, and whole class. Students will get rewarded for positive behavior. We use group points to monitor cooperative group teamwork. We use class points to monitor whole class behavior.

Warning for minor violations with a student can result in a reflection, possible loss of recess, after school detention, and/or a phone call home. If behavior continues, the student may be asked to have a conference with the principal.
