

## Santee 6th Grade Behavior Management Policy

Students are expected to follow the school norms in and outside of the classroom. These norms are: be respectful, be responsible, be a problem solver, and be safe.

In order to monitor student behavior we monitor the class in 3 ways: individual, groups, and whole class.

We use a behavior chart to monitor *individual* classroom behavior. Students will get rewarded for positive behavior.

We use group points to monitor cooperative **group** team work.

We use class points to monitor whole **class** behavior. Class points are given or taken away on a number line.

Positive rewards for following the school norms:

Individual- Positive notes sent to family, phone calls to parents, prizes.

Group- Group reward

Class- When the class gets 10 points, the class will get to choose a class reward. Examples: 10 minutes of game time, art time, sports, drawing, pencils.

Consequences for making wrong choices:

Individual- Loss of individual points. Warning for minor violations with a student reflection, Possible loss of recess, red card sent home to parents, phone call home, a student may also be asked to take a break from the class or his/her group. If behavior continues, the student may be asked to have a conference with the principal.
