




Copper Canyon Elementary School



- The area in between SR-36 and Broadway, and 1000 N and 500 N has been moved to the Copper Canyon boundary.
- The boundary between Copper Canyon and Middle Canyon no longer weaves between houses and instead follows 520 E.




Copper Canyon Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Copper Canyon would be approximately:


- 48 students in Kindergarten.

Rose Springs Elementary School




Boundary Proposals


Rose Springs Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Rose Springs would be approximately:


- 39 students in Kindergarten.

Middle Canyon Elementary School




Boundary Proposals

 The boundary between Copper Canyon and Middle Canyon no longer weaves between houses and instead follows 520 E.




Middle Canyon Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Middle Canyon would be approximately:


- 33 students in Kindergarten.

The total student population would be 285 students. Middle Canyon's maximum student capacity is 800.






Northlake Elementary School

- The Gleneagles neighborhood has moved to Overlake's boundary, dividing along the train tracks.




Northlake Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Northlake would be approximately:


- 68 students in Kindergarten.

The total student population would be 518 students. Northlake's maximum student capacity is 950.






Overlake Elementary School

- The Gleneagles neighborhood has moved to Overlake's boundary, dividing along the train tracks.




Overlake Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Overlake would be approximately:


- 79 students in Kindergarten.

The total student population would be 609 students. Overlake's maximum student capacity is 825.






Settlement Canyon Elementary School

- The boundary that ran along Settlement Canyon Rd has moved south, all houses on the road now go to Sterling.




Settlement Canyon Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Settlement would be approximately:


- 67 students in Kindergarten.

The total student population would be 500 students. Settlement's maximum student capacity is 700.






Sterling Elementary School

- The boundary that ran along Settlement Canyon Rd has moved to include all houses on the road to go to Sterling.




Sterling Student Summary



With the proposed changes the student population at Sterling would be approximately:


- 110 students in Kindergarten.
- 118 students in 1st grade.
- 119 students in 2nd grade.
- 121 students in 3rd grade.
- 138 students in 4th grade.
- 126 students in 5th grade.
- 112 students in 6th grade.

The total student population would be 844 students. Sterling's maximum student capacity is 1050.






West Elementary School



- West's Boundaries have been reinstated.
- The southern boundary has been moved from 700 S to 770 S.
- The neighborhood between 400 S and 520 S has been moved from Sterling into West.



West Student Summary
