

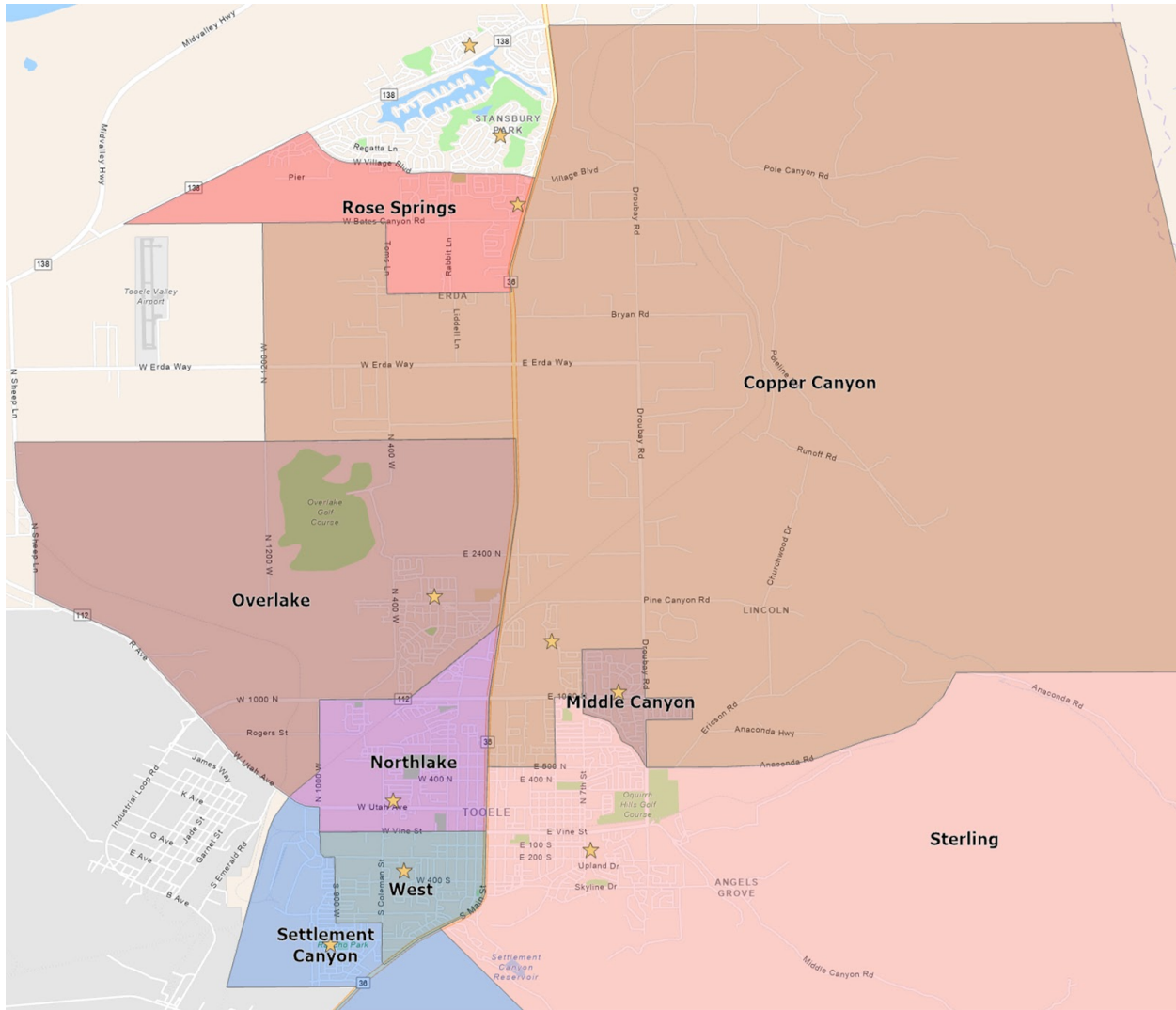

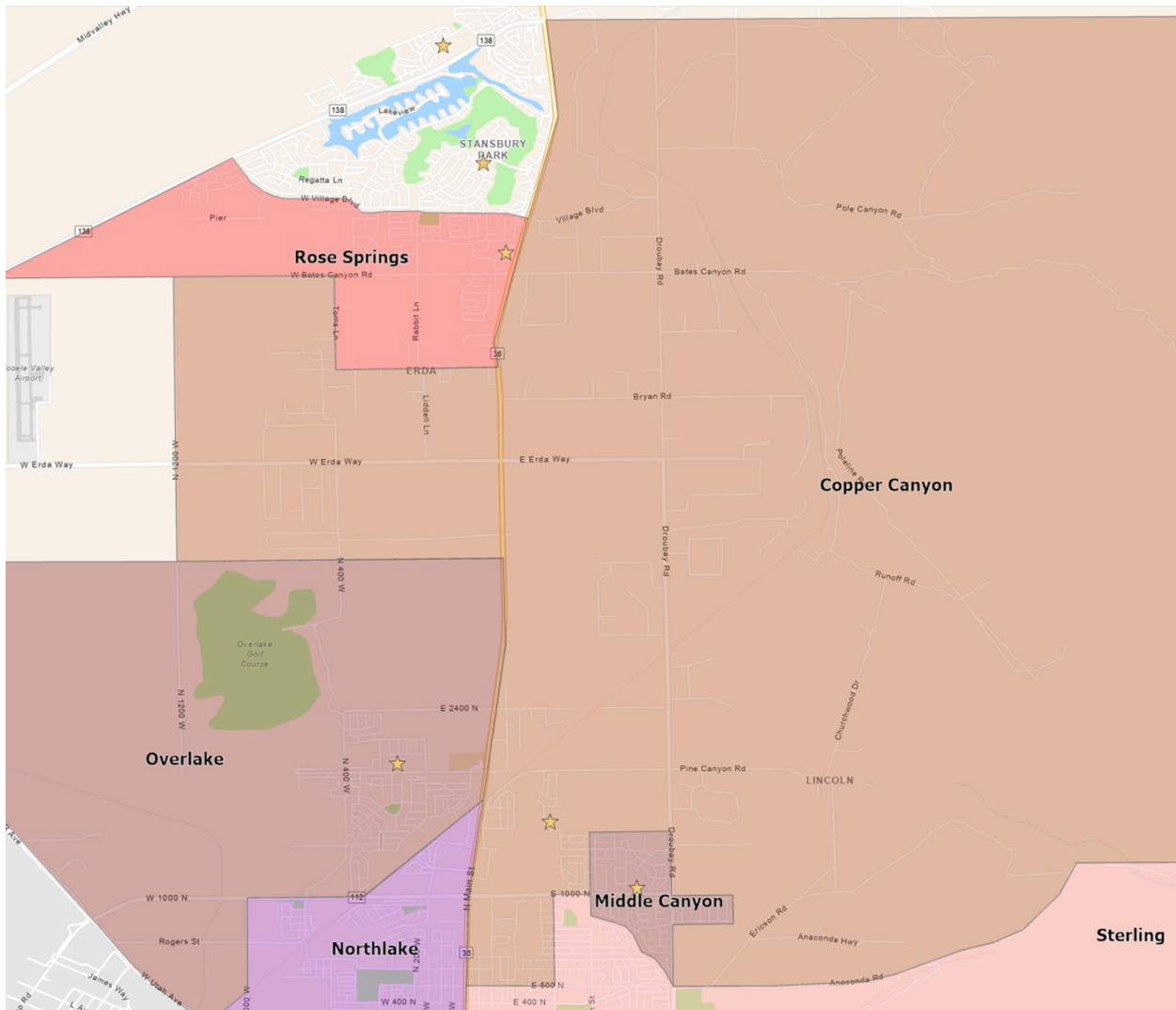
Moving West Erda from Overlake's boundary to Copper Canyon's boundary.

## Copper Canyon Elementary School

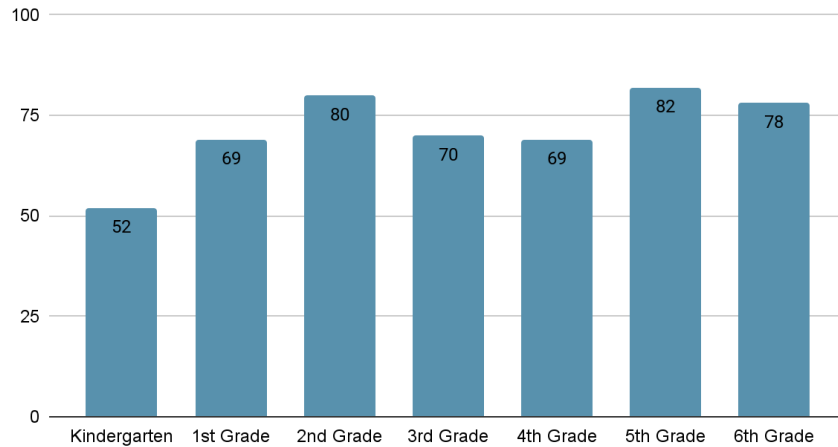


### Boundary Proposals

- Erda, west of SR-36, has been moved from Overlake to Copper Canyon's boundary.
- The area in between SR-36 and Broadway, and 1000 N and 500 N has been moved to the Copper Canyon boundary.
- The boundary between Copper Canyon and Middle Canyon no longer weaves between houses and instead follows 520 E.

Student Population

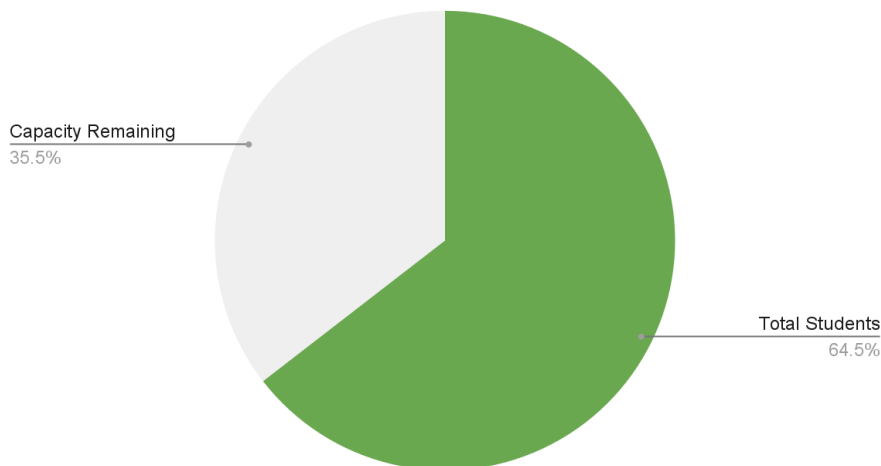


With the proposed changes the student population at Copper Canyon would be approximately:

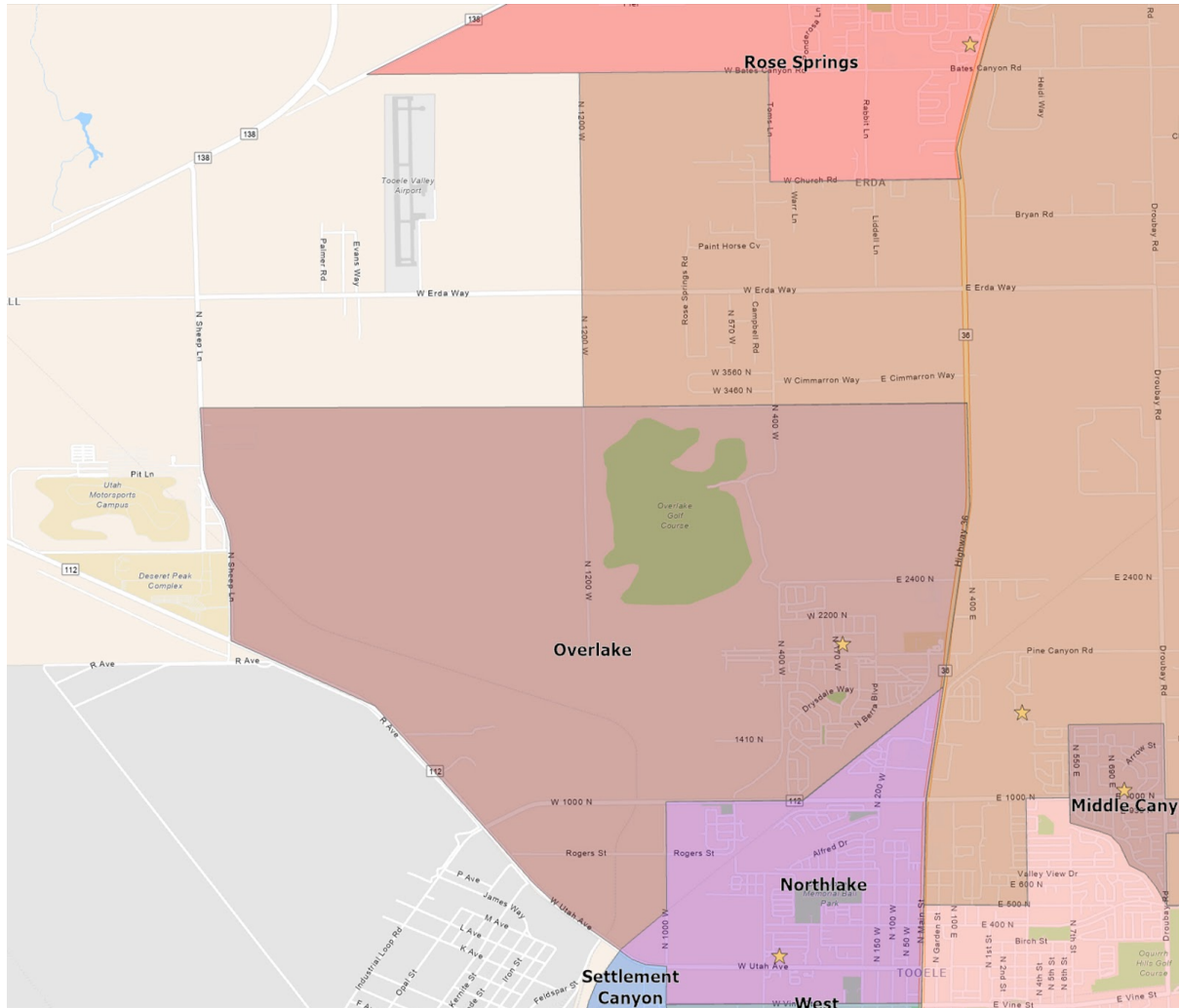
- 52 students in Kindergarten.
- 69 students in 1st grade.
- 80 students in 2nd grade.
- 70 students in 3rd grade.
- 69 students in 4th grade.
- 82 students in 5th grade.
- 78 students in 6th grade.

The total student population would be 500 students. Copper Canyon's maximum student capacity is 775.

## Overlake Elementary School

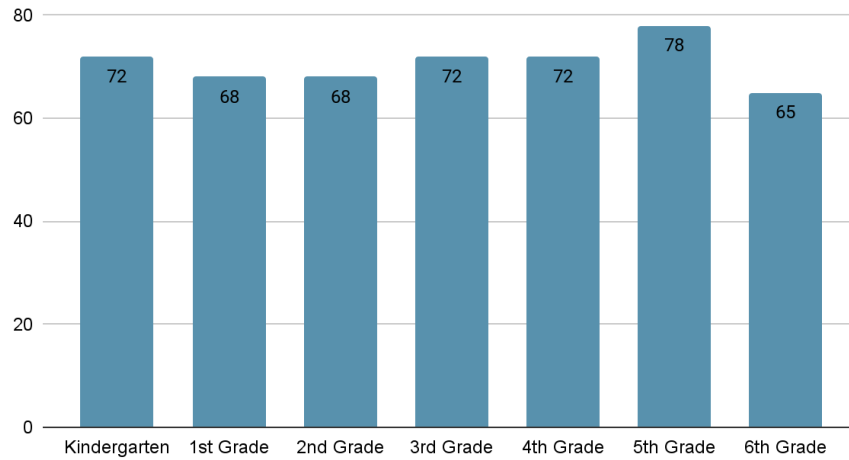


### Boundary Proposals

- The northern boundary is now the northern edge of the Overlake Golf Course.
- The Gleneagles neighborhood has moved to Overlake's boundary, dividing along the train tracks.

## Overlake Student Summary

Student Population



With the proposed changes the student population at Overlake would be approximately:

- 72 students in Kindergarten.
- 68 students in 1st grade.
- 68 students in 2nd grade.
- 72 students in 3rd grade.
- 72 students in 4th grade.
- 78 students in 5th grade.
- 65 students in 6th grade.

The total student population would be 609 students. Overlake's maximum student capacity is 825.
