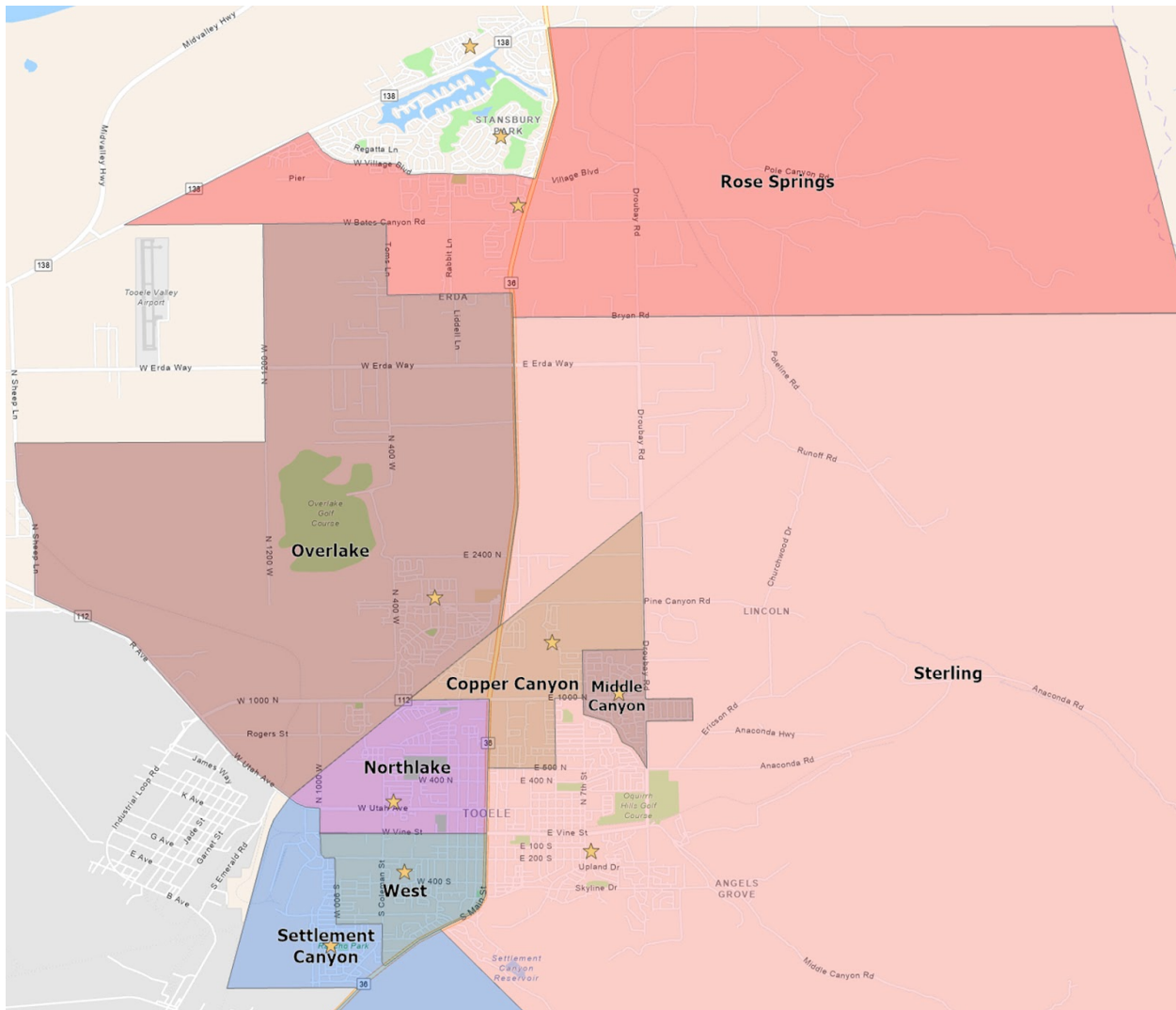




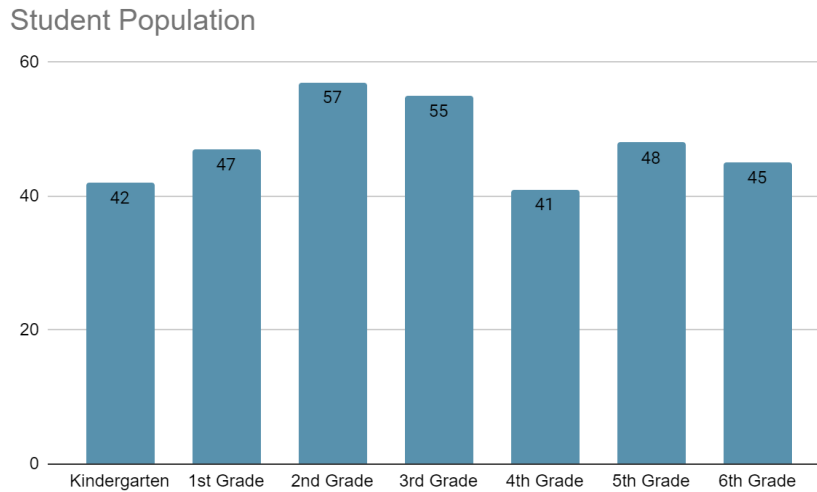

Copper Canyon Student Summary

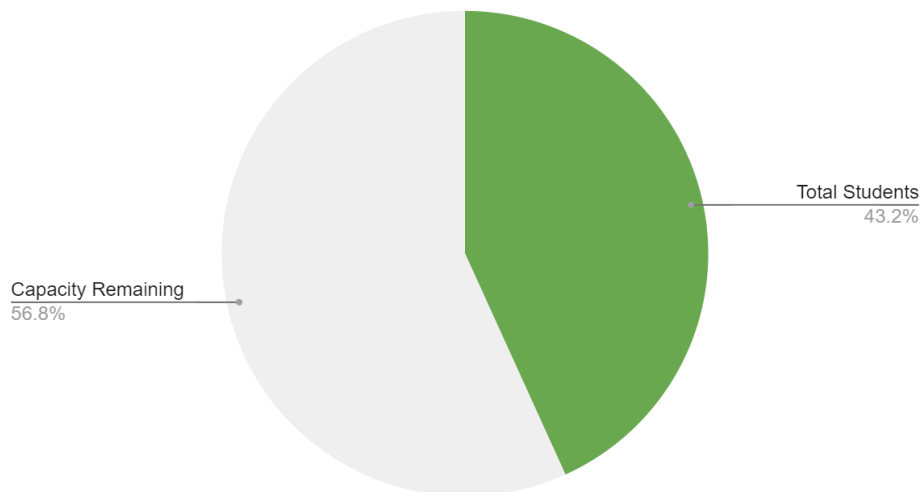


With the proposed changes the student population at Copper Canyon would be approximately:

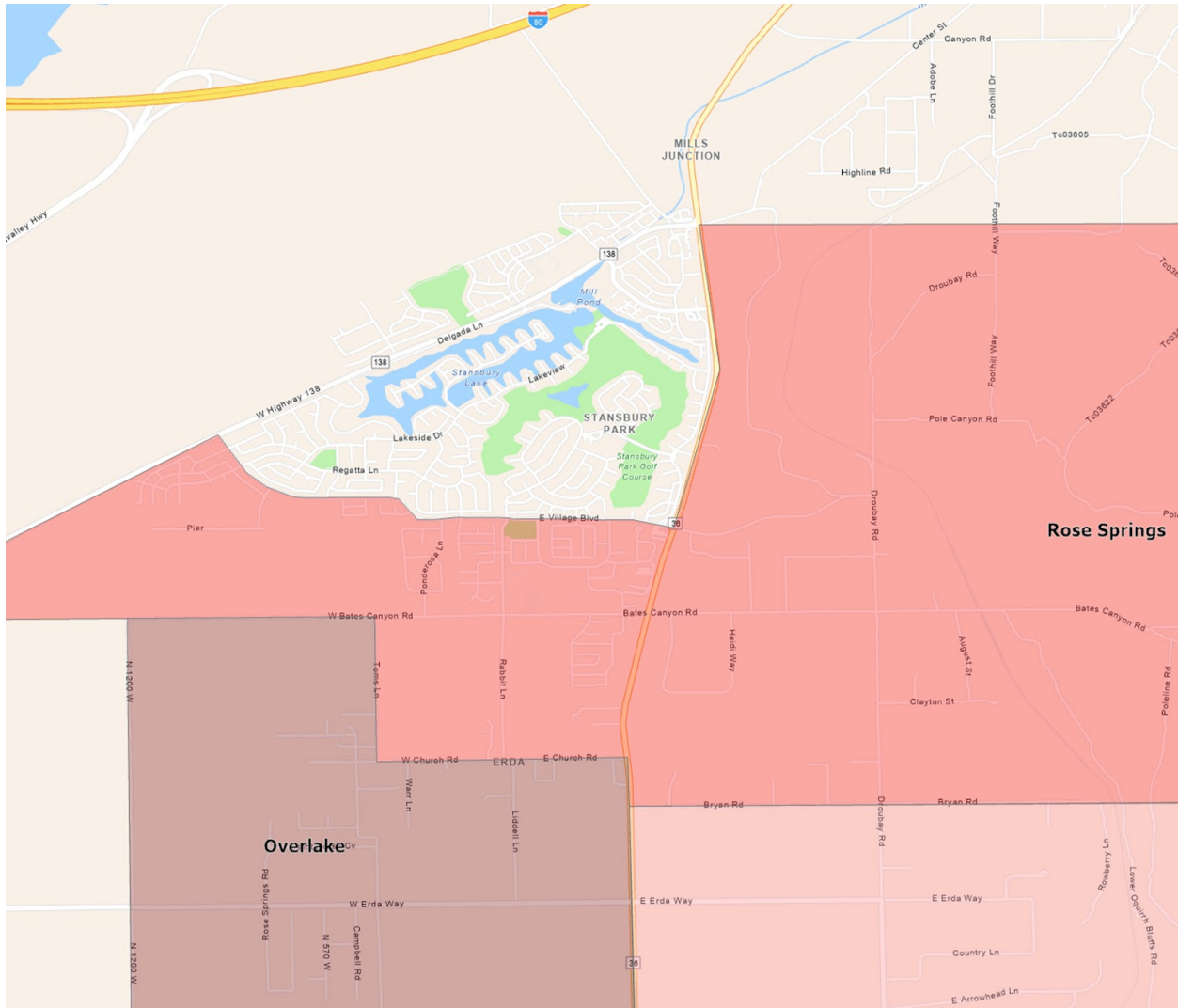
- 42 students in Kindergarten.

Rose Springs Elementary School

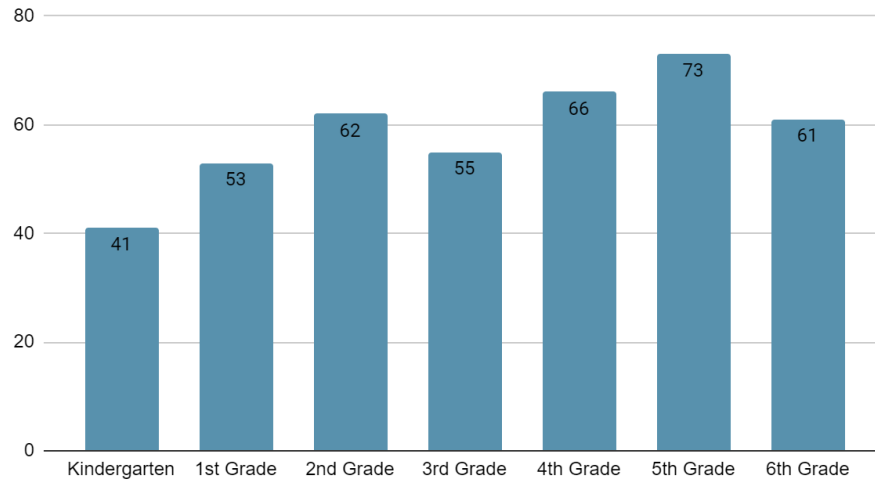


Boundary Proposals

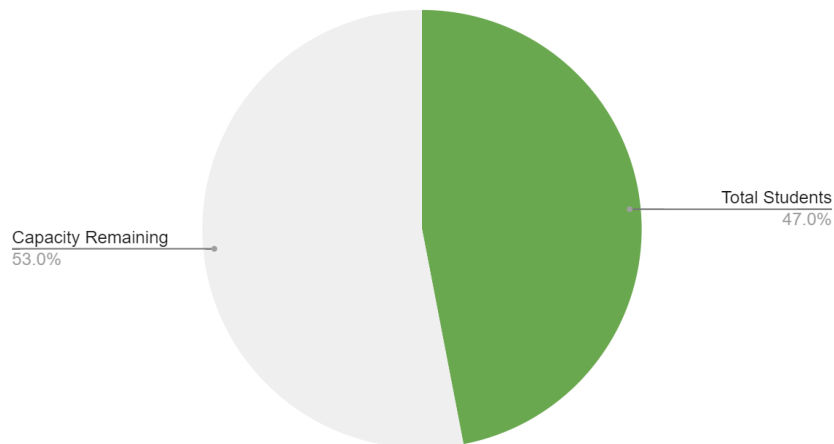


With the proposed changes the student population at Rose Springs would be approximately:

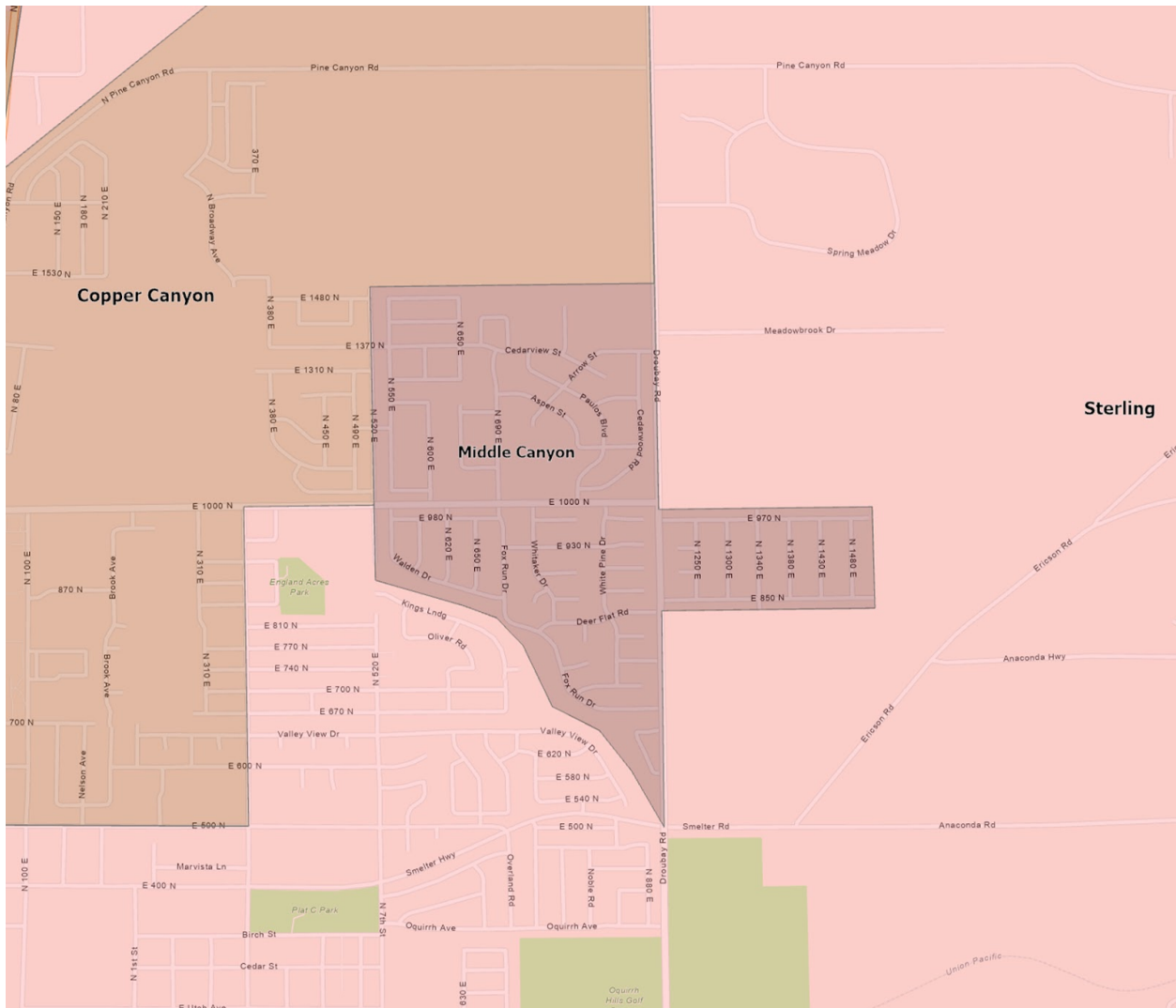
- 41 students in Kindergarten.

Middle Canyon Elementary School

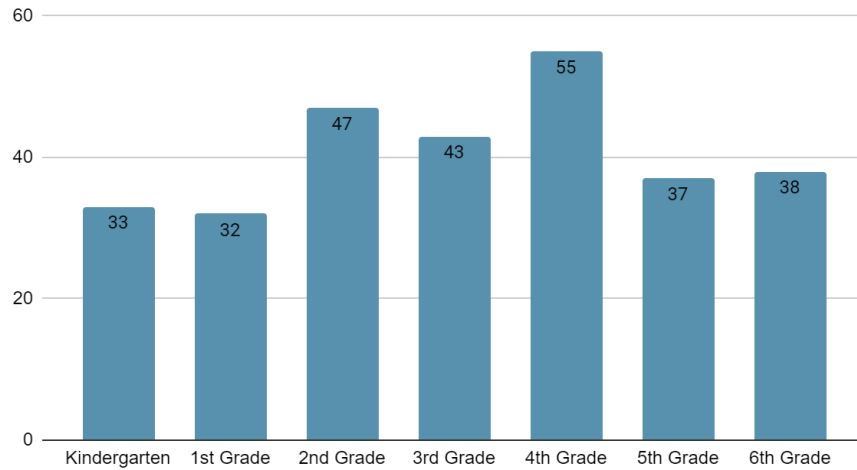


Boundary Proposals

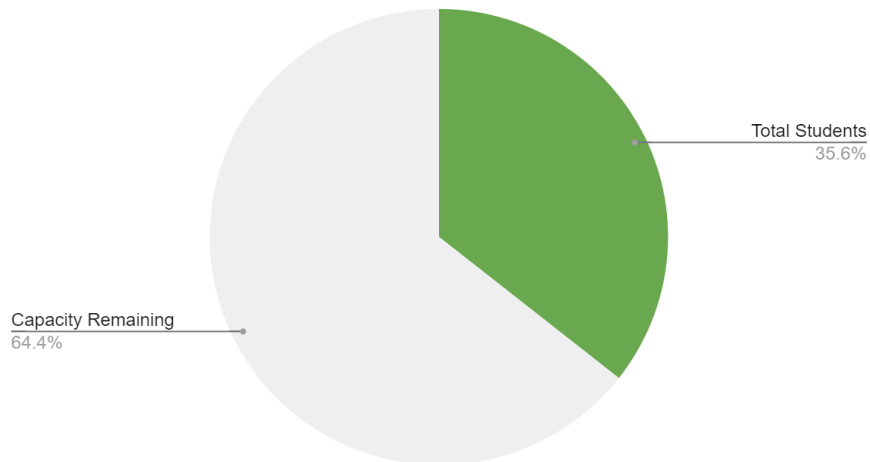


With the proposed changes the student population at Middle Canyon would be approximately:

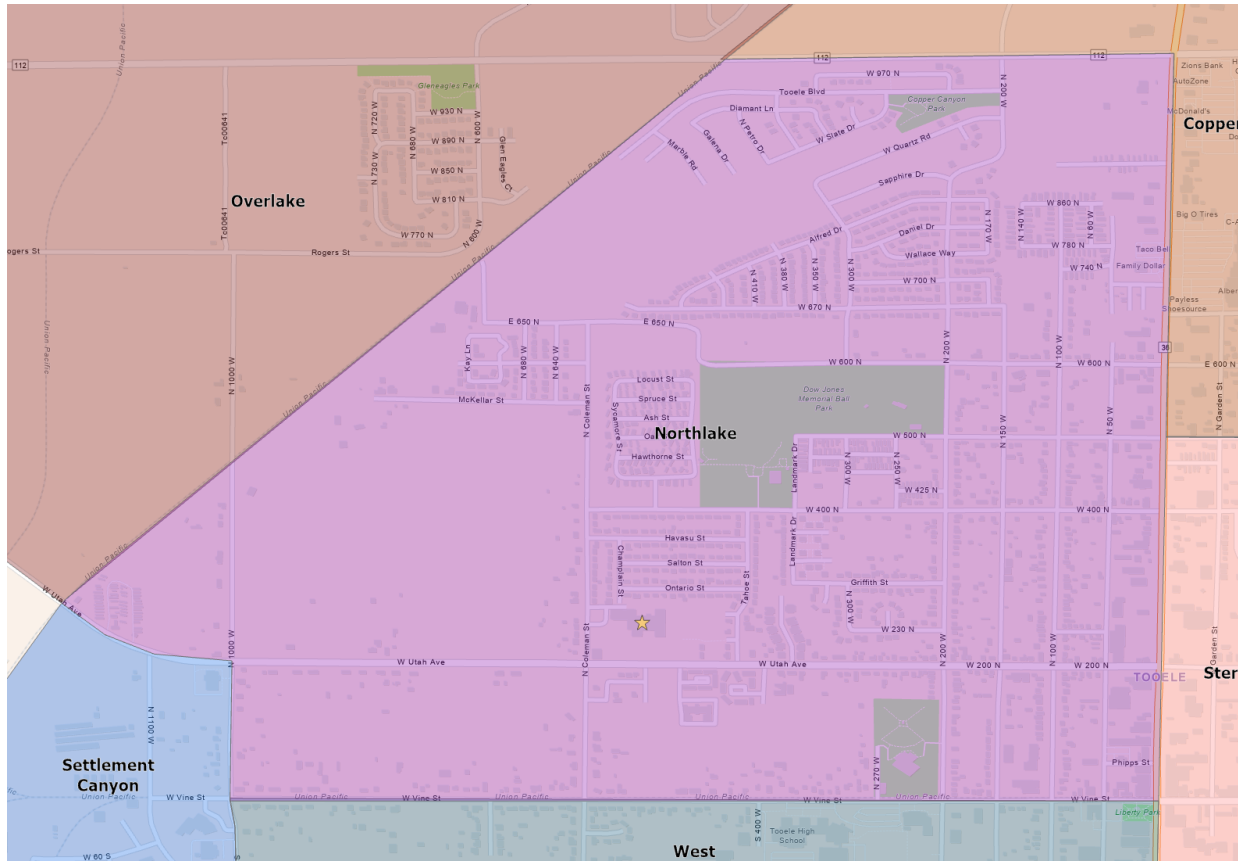

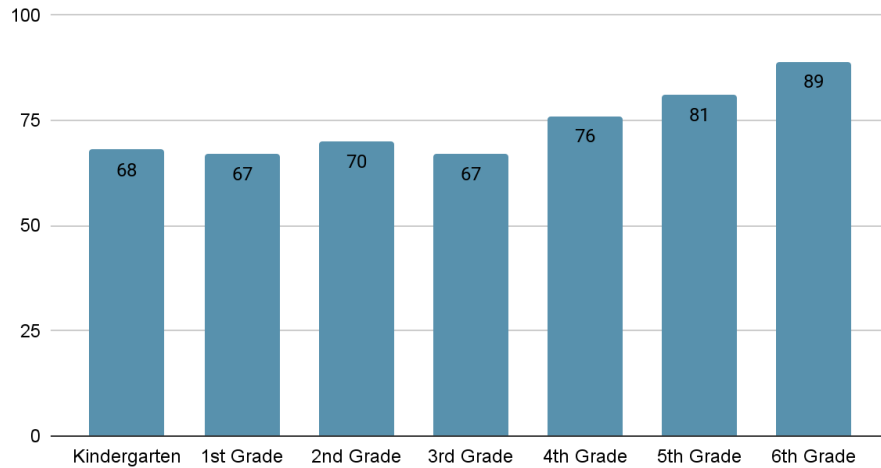


Boundary Proposals

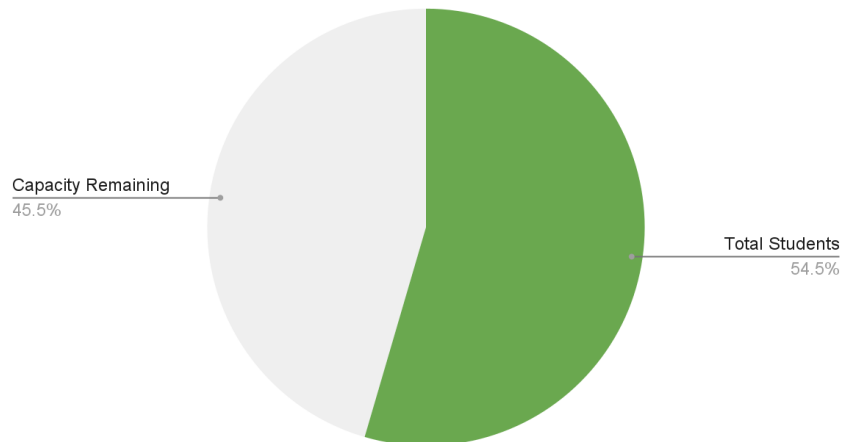


With the proposed changes the student population at Northlake would be approximately:

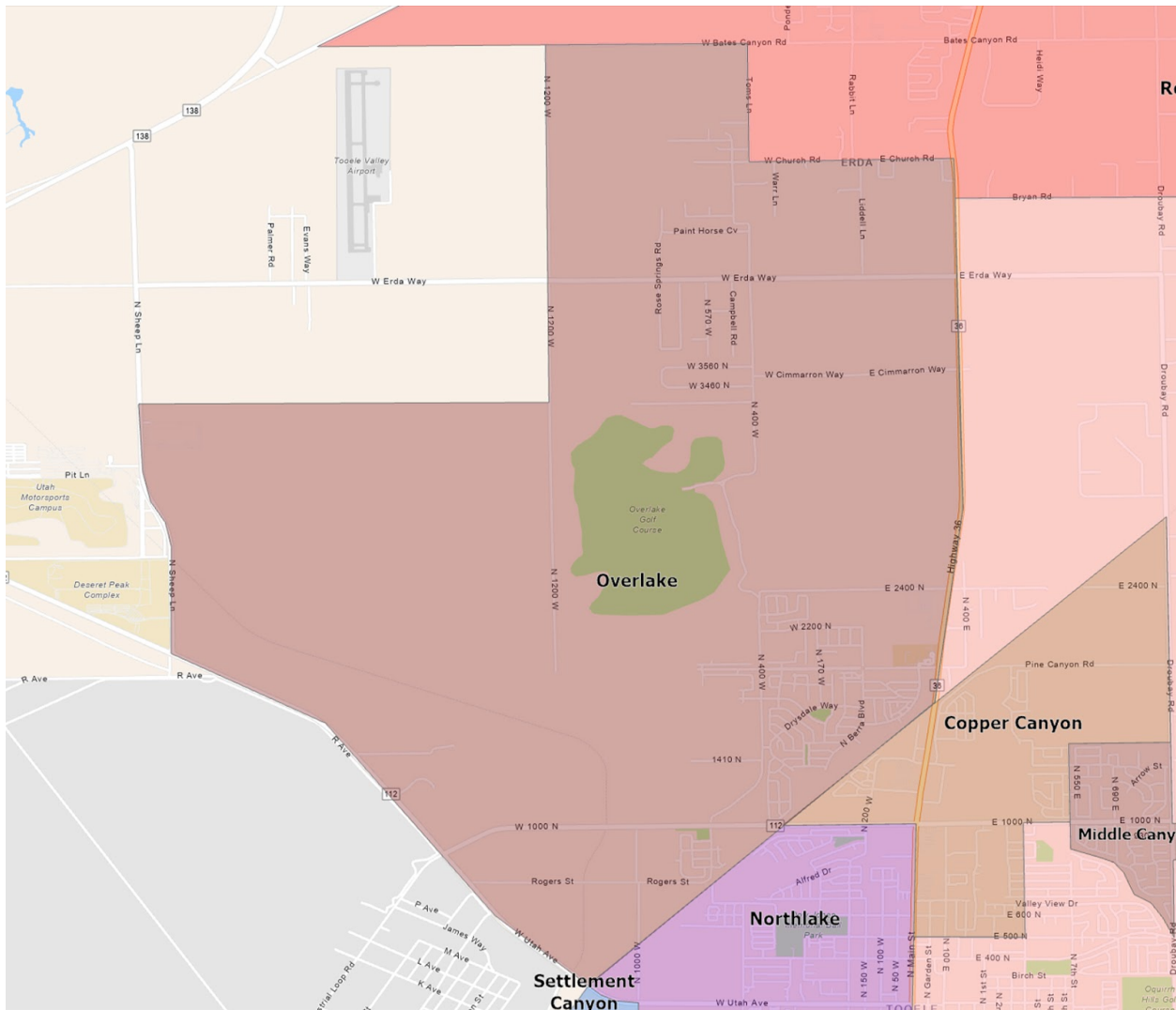

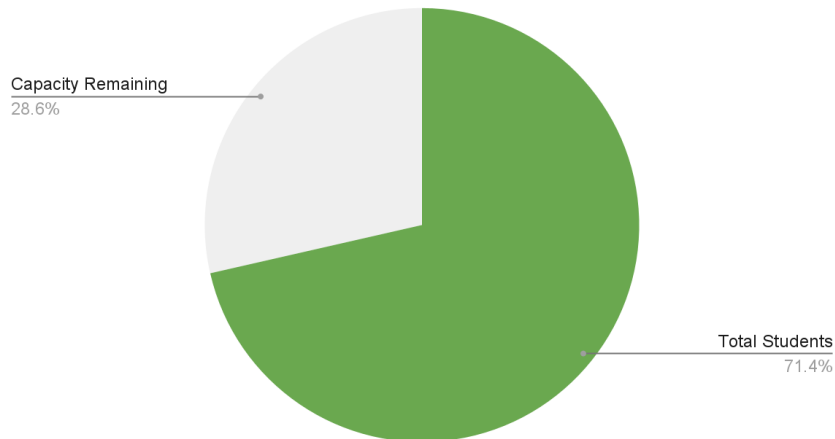


With the proposed changes the student population at Settlement would be approximately:

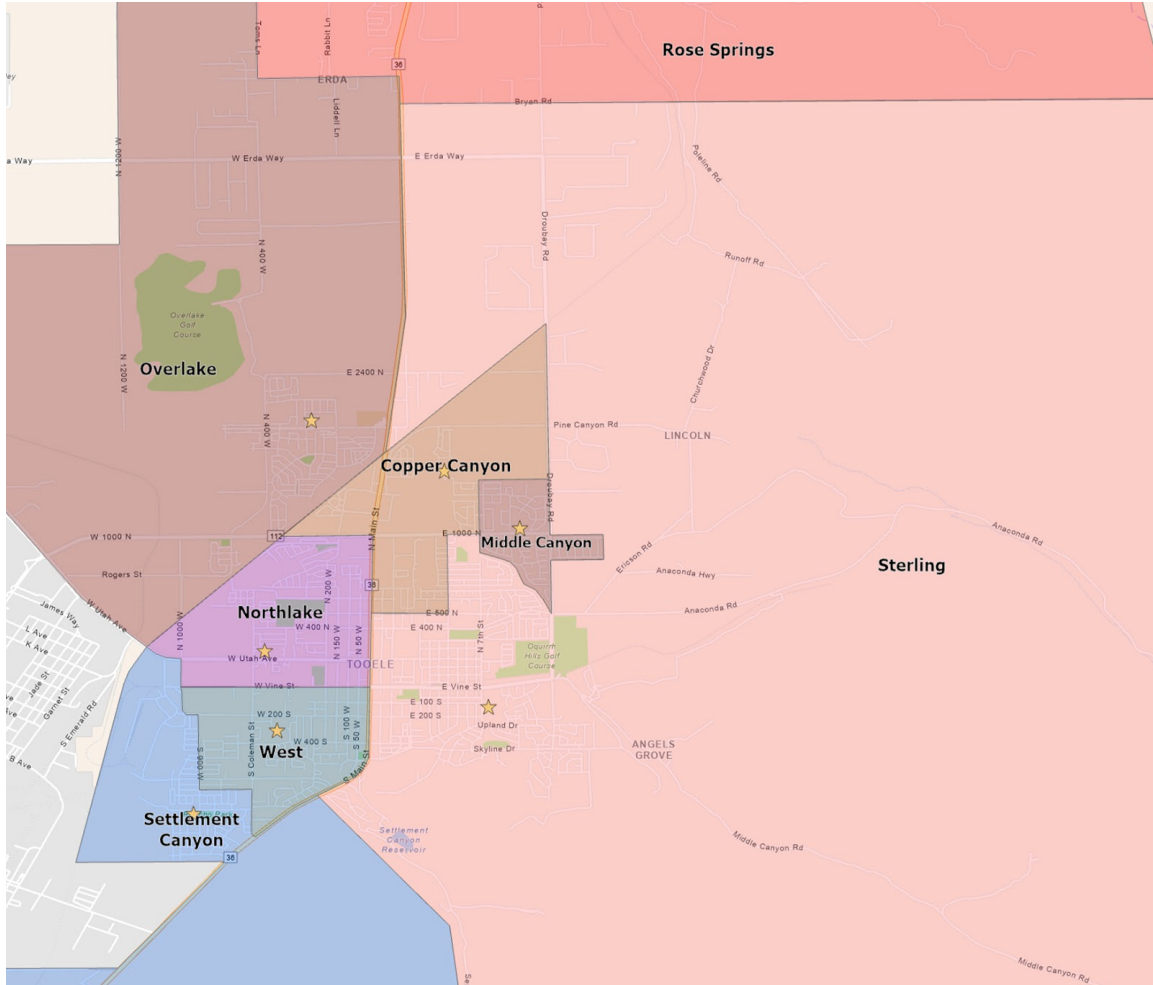

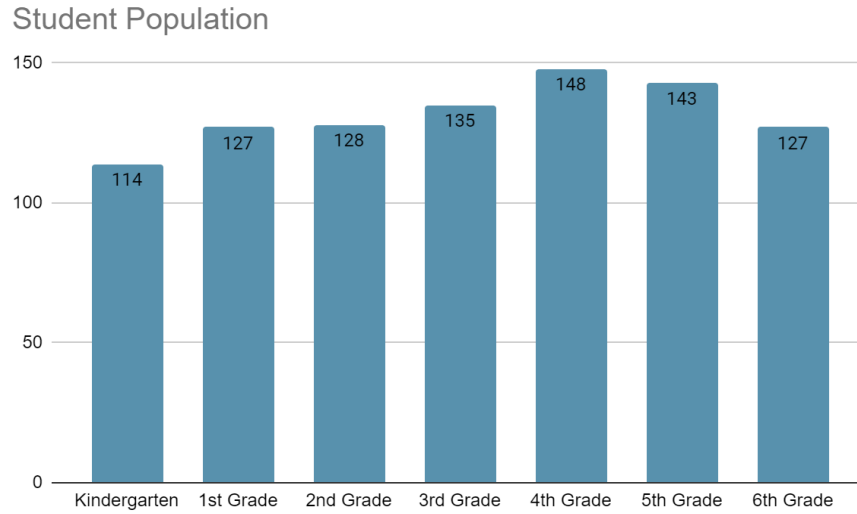
Sterling Elementary School



Boundary Proposals

- The area in between SR-36 and Broadway, and 1000 N and 500 N has been moved to the Copper Canyon boundary.
- The block in between 400 S and 520 S has moved from Sterling to Northlake's boundary.
- The boundary that ran along Settlement Canyon Rd has moved to include all houses on the road to go to Sterling.
- Sterling's boundary now extends north to encompass all neighborhoods east of Droubay Rd until it reaches the train tracks. Everything north of the train tracks and east of SR-36 is part of Sterling's boundary up to Bryan Rd.

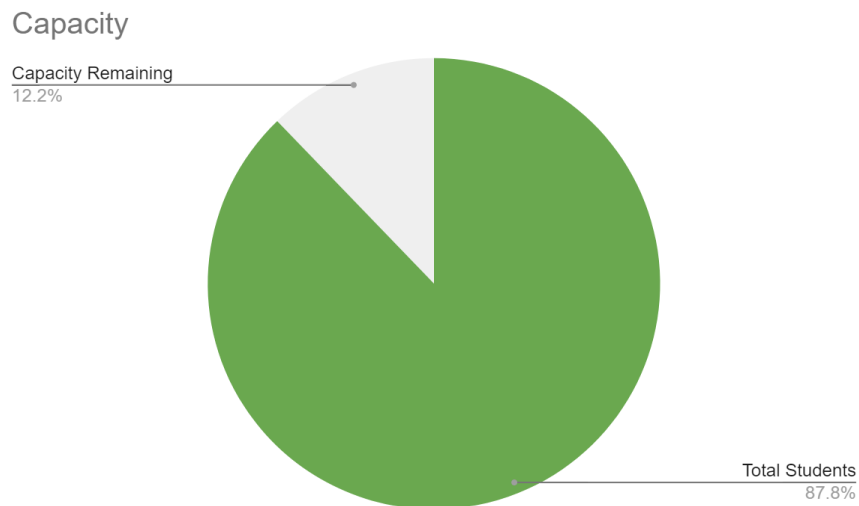

With the proposed changes the student population at Sterling would be approximately:

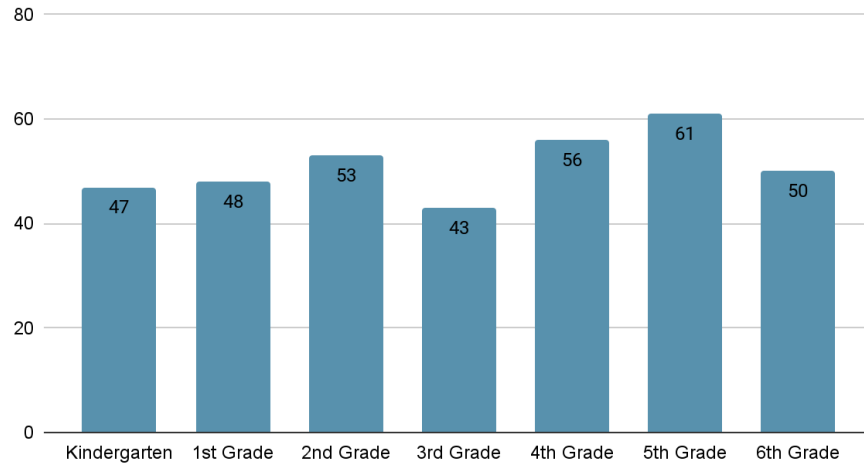
- 114 students in Kindergarten.
