The percentage of Albany Area Public Schools third graders achieving proficiency on the MCA III Reading Test will be at least 60% in spring of 2023.	<i>Goal Not Met</i> The percentage of Albany Area Public Schools third graders achieving proficiency on the MCA III Reading Test was 45% in the spring of 2023.
The percentage of Albany Area Public Schools third graders making typical or aggressive growth based on start score as measured on the aReading assessment will increase from 52.0% in spring of 2022 to 55.0% in spring of 2023.	<i>Goal Met</i> The percentage of Albany Area Public Schools third graders making typical or aggressive growth based on start score as measured by the aReading assessment increased from 52% in spring of 2022 to 68% in spring of 2023.

<p>The proficiency gap on the MCA reading assessment between students who receive special education services and students who do not receive special education services across the district will decrease from 36.8% in 2022 to 34.8% in 2023 by increasing the percent proficient of the groups as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ SPED from 25.6% to 27.0%</li> <li>○ Non-SPED maintained at 62.4%</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Goal Not Met</i></p> <p>The proficiency gap on the MCA reading assessment between students who receive special education services and students who do not receive special education services across the district increased from 36.8% in 2022 to 42.6% in 2023 by changing the percent proficient of the groups as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ SPED decreased from 25.6% to 21.6%.</li> <li>○ Non-SPED increased from 62.4% to 64.2%.</li> </ul>
