Emergency and Disaster Preparedness

The Board recognizes the importance of being prepared for various types of emergencies, both natural and human, that could occur while school is in session. This necessitates the development of appropriate plans and procedures to deal with such emergencies at school facilities or involving school transport. It is important that students, employees, and parents be knowledgeable about the various emergency plans and procedures and be prepared should such an emergency occur.

Development of Crisis Management Plan

The District shall develop and maintain a Crisis Management Plan to act as a guide for school district board members, administration, staff, students, parents, and community members to address potential crises within the district.

The Crisis Management Plan will provide procedures for the school district and for each building, and will be used prior to, during, or after any emergency situation.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for directing the development of a comprehensive Crisis Management Plan. This plan will be shared with representatives of local municipalities and appropriate emergency personnel. The Crisis Management Plan will be reviewed annually by the Crisis Management Team.

Each principal shall receive a copy of the Crisis Management Plan and shall provide in-service training on plan implementation.

The District Safety Task Force serves as the foundation for the development, training, and implementation of the Crisis Management Plan.
