## **Gaudete Sunday**

What is special about the Third Sunday of Advent? For much of the Church's history, this Sunday had a special name: "Gaudete" Sunday. The traditions surrounding this Sunday go back as far as the fourth or fifth century, as does the season of Advent itself. Advent, our preparation for Christmas, was originally a forty-day penitential season like Lent. In fact, since it used to begin on November 12 (just after the Memorial of St. Martin of Tours), it was called "St. Martin's Lent." "Gaudete Sunday" was the Advent counterpart to "Laetare Sunday," which marks the mid-point in Lent.

On Gaudete Sunday, the season of Advent shifts its focus. For the first two weeks of Advent, the focus can be summed up in the phrase, "The Lord is coming." But beginning with Gaudete Sunday, the summary might be, "The Lord is near." This shift is marked by a lighter mood and a heightened sense of joyous anticipation.

Liturgically, the colors lighten as well. The priest may wear rose-colored vestments, a hue seen only on Gaudete Sunday and Laetare Sunday. On this day, we light the third candle of the Advent wreath, which is also rose-colored, or if you prefer, pink.

The word "Gaudete" is Latin for "Rejoice." This celebration is a reminder that God who loves us is still in charge and that we await his coming not with fear, but with tremendous joy. Today's Second Reading, from the First Letter of St. Paul to the Thessalonians, reflects this joy: "Brothers and sisters: Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus."

#### **SAVE THOSE STAMPS!**

As you may remember, we no longer collect used postage stamps and other postal items, but the Sisters of Notre Dame continue to collect them to support their various ministries throughout the world. Their "wish list" includes U.S. and foreign stamps on and off paper (commemorative and high value), foreign mint stamp sheets and blocks, U.S. mint stamp sheets, mint strips, and plate blocks, first day covers, postcards, album



collections and other philatelic items. Do not send low value stamps, flag stamps, and other "ordinary" postage items, as they have absolutely no value. Trim the stamps from the envelopes, leaving a border of at least 1/4" and mail them to Stamp Ministry, 100 Augusta Hall -Saint Mary's, Notre Dame, Indiana, 46556-5002. While it seems rare these days to get first

class mail, the holiday season is a time when we get a lot of it. You may want to make a habit of saving stamps throughout the year and send them in after the holidays are over. The Sisters thank you!


