GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation requirements as well as requirements to receive a competency determination can be found in the Holbrook Junior-Senior High School Handbook.

Any student whose graduation with his or her class is in jeopardy will be informed of this possibility as will his or her parents/guardians. Notification of this possibility will be sent in writing to parents/guardians at the time of subject selection for junior and senior years and when in either of those years a subject is failed.

Notification from the school must be signed by a parent/guardian and returned to the school.

Credit for Out-of-District Study: Students who are away for a term or year to participate in a student exchange program may receive credits toward high school graduation when (1) study plans are approved by the school administration in advance; and (2) the institution where the study occurred submits a record of the student's work. In these instances, the Principal and student's guidance counselor will evaluate the work and assign credit for it according to standards prevailing in the Holbrook Junior-Senior High School.
