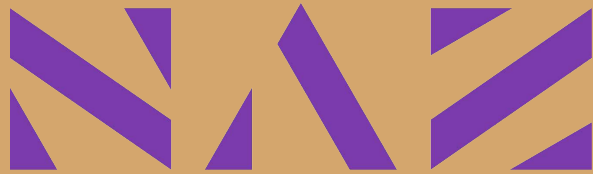
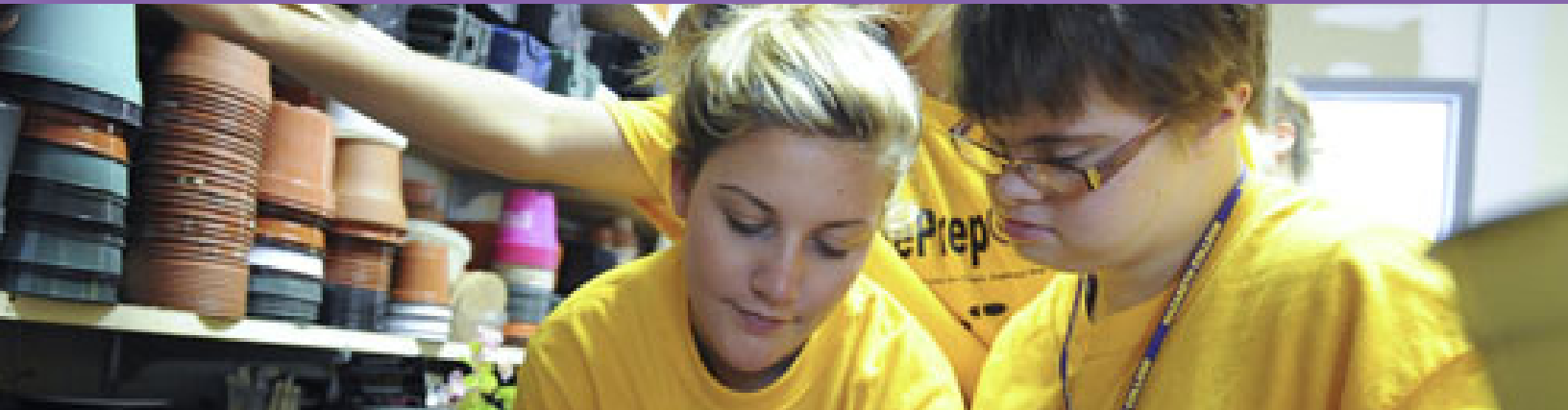

Who is eligible?

- High school students with intellectual disabilities, ages 18-21 years old, who have completed at least four years in the high school setting, will not earn a regular diploma, and require continuing school-aged services. *Further student criteria can be found at <http://tinyurl.com/VCSO-LifePrep>.*
