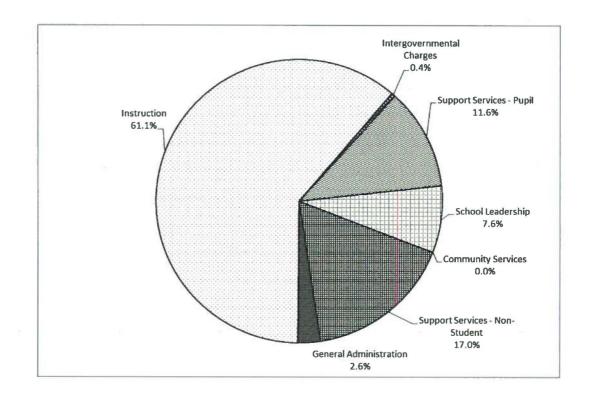

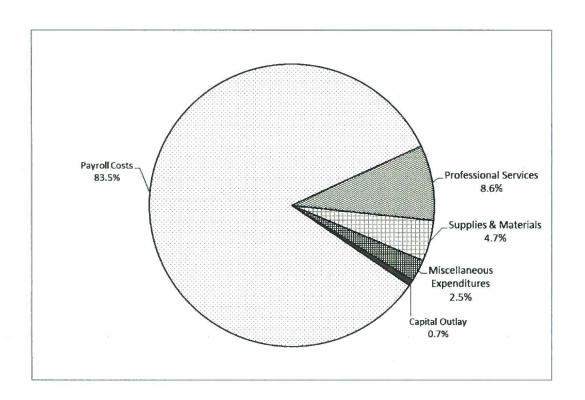

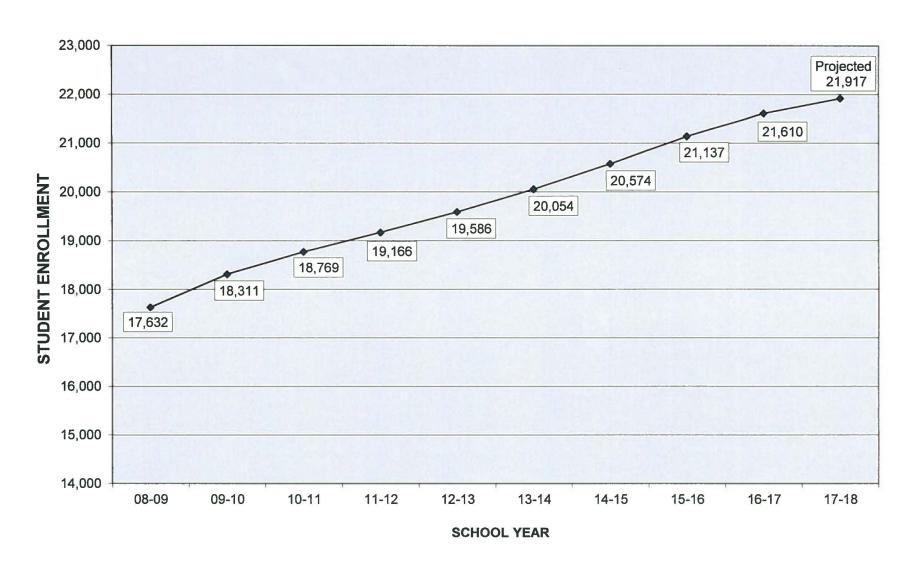

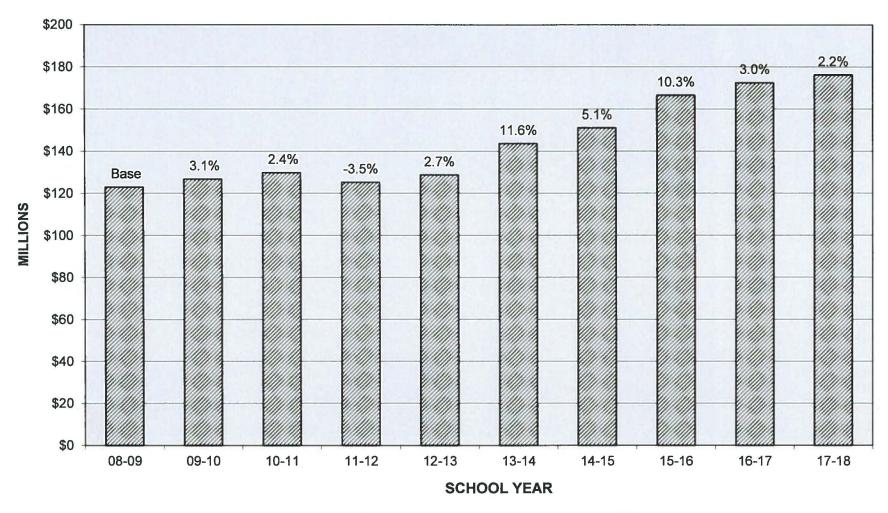

## PEARLAND INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT TEN YEAR HISTORY OF ENROLLMENTS



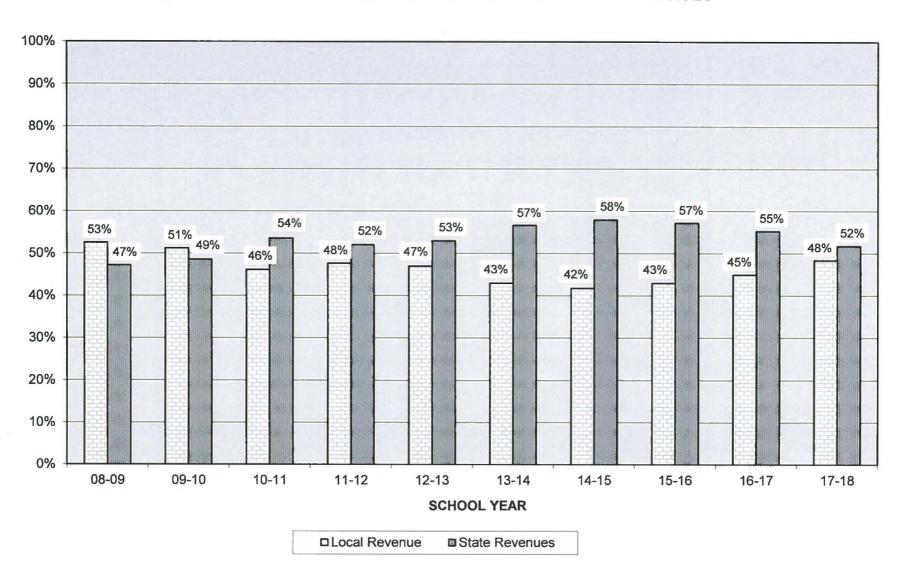
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## PEARLAND INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT TEN YEAR HISTORY OF GENERAL FUND BUDGETS
