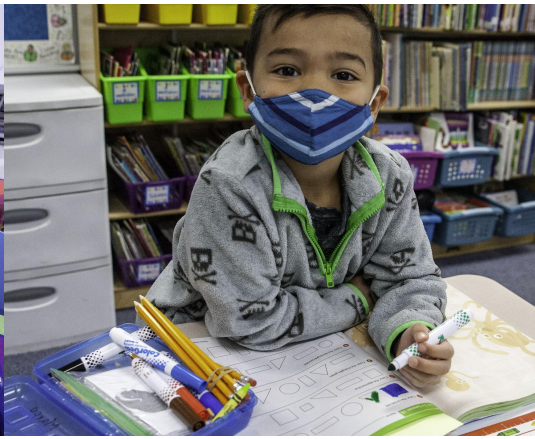
# Process

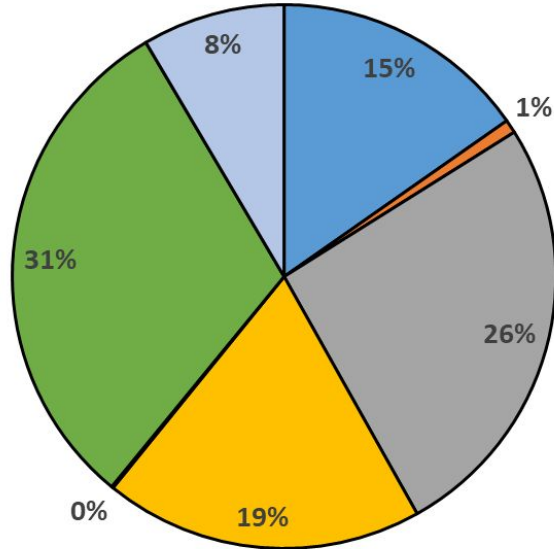

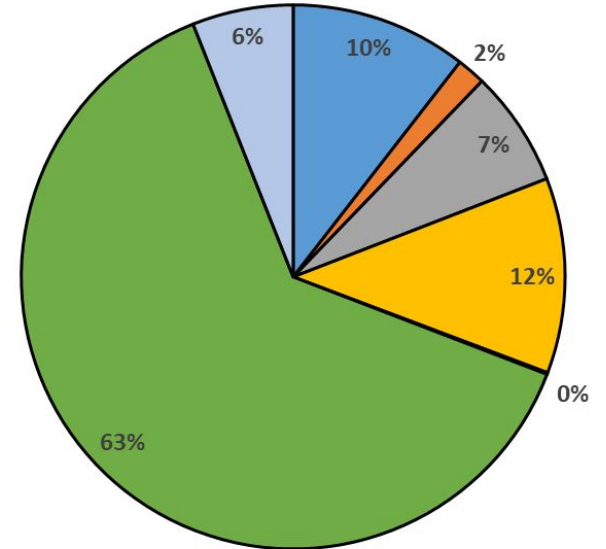

# ISD 622 Students Total SY 2022 Enrollment: 10,450

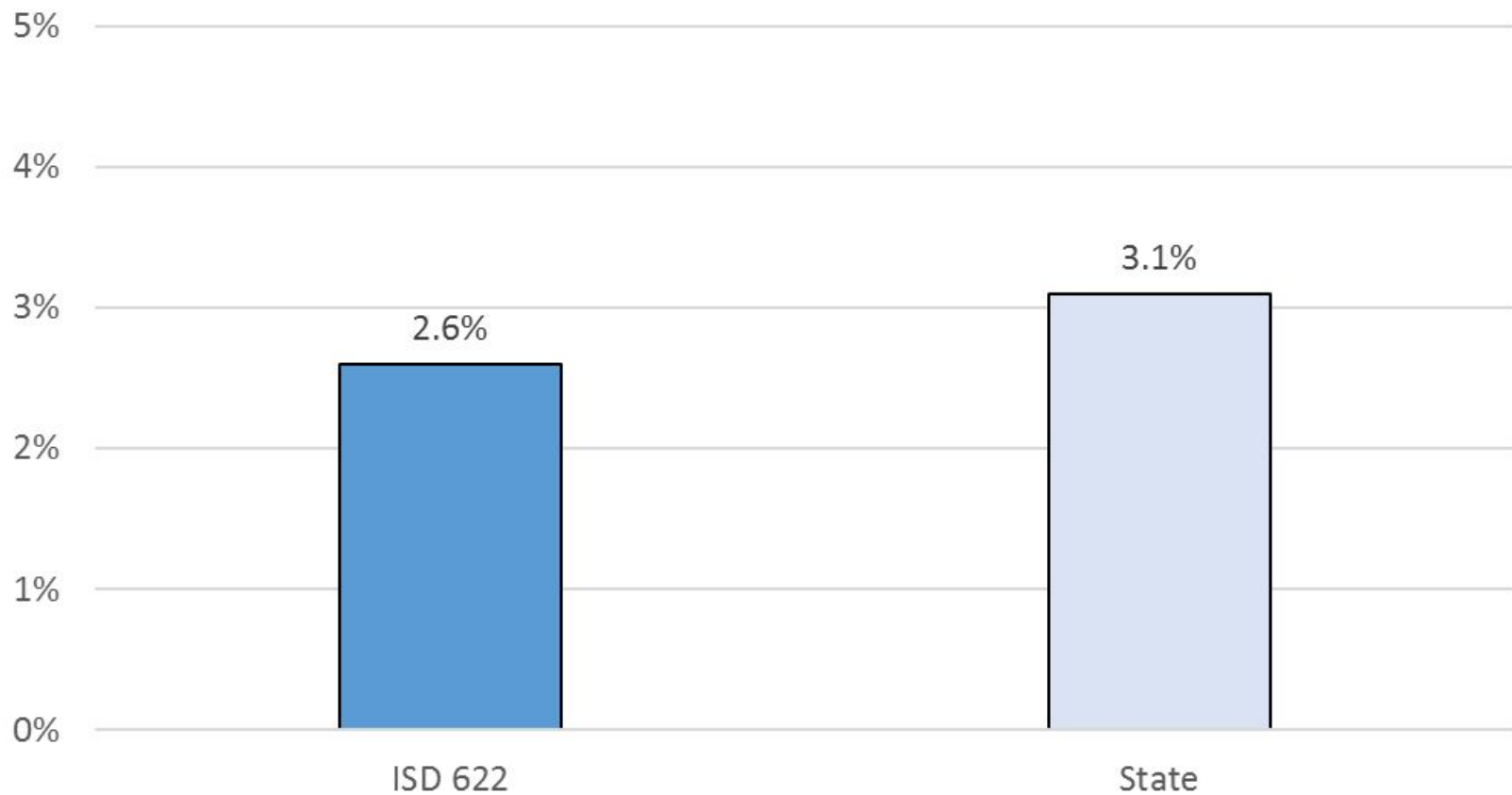

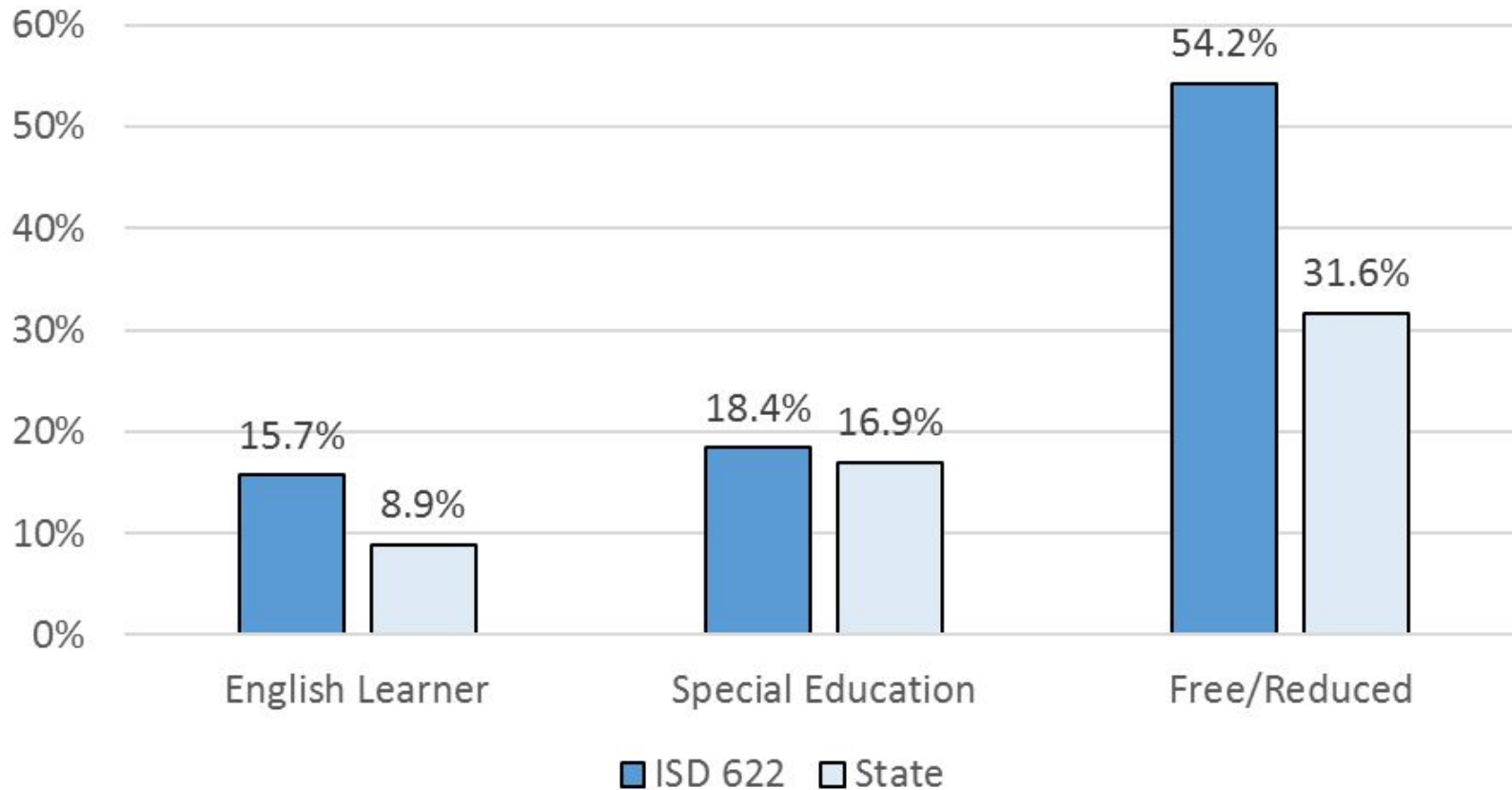

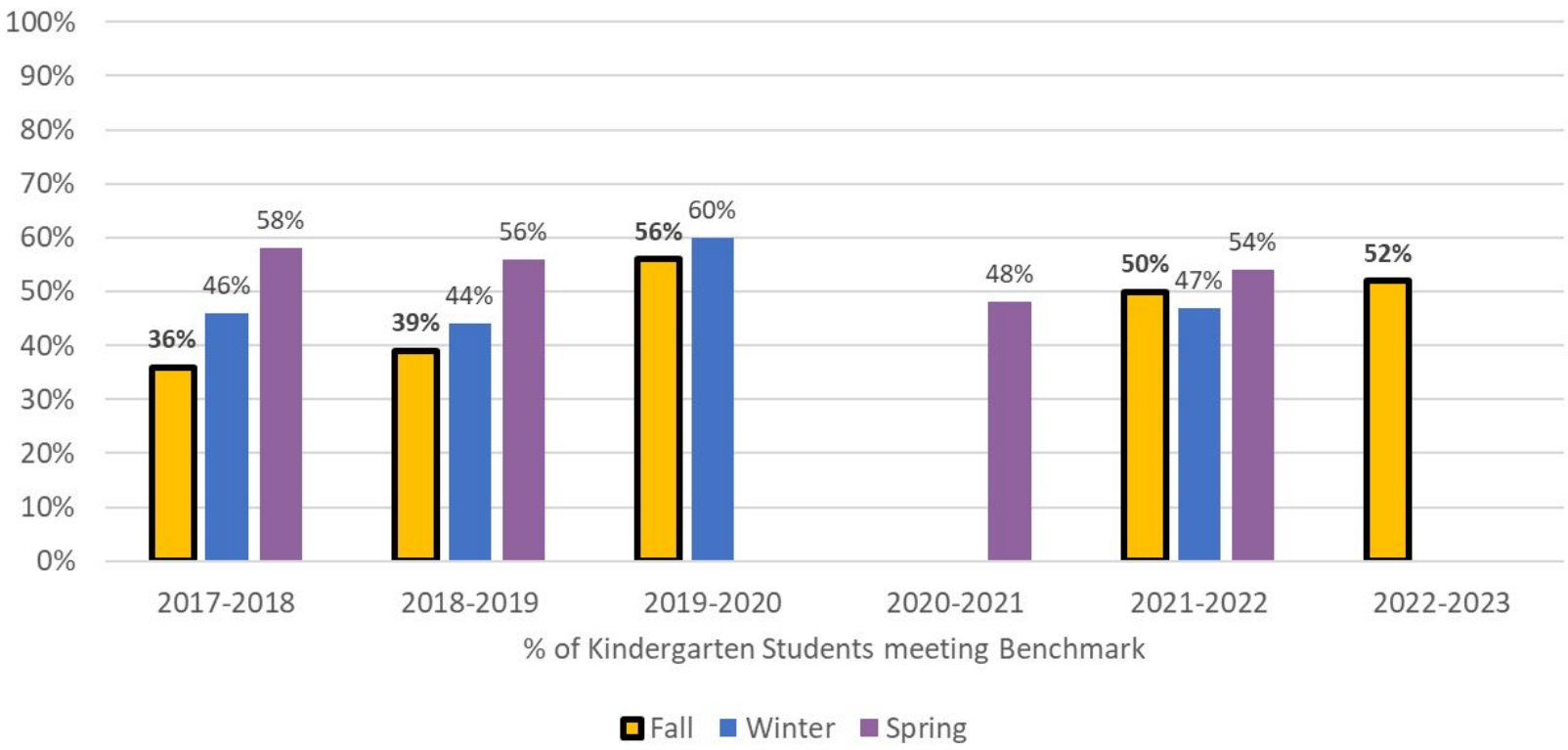

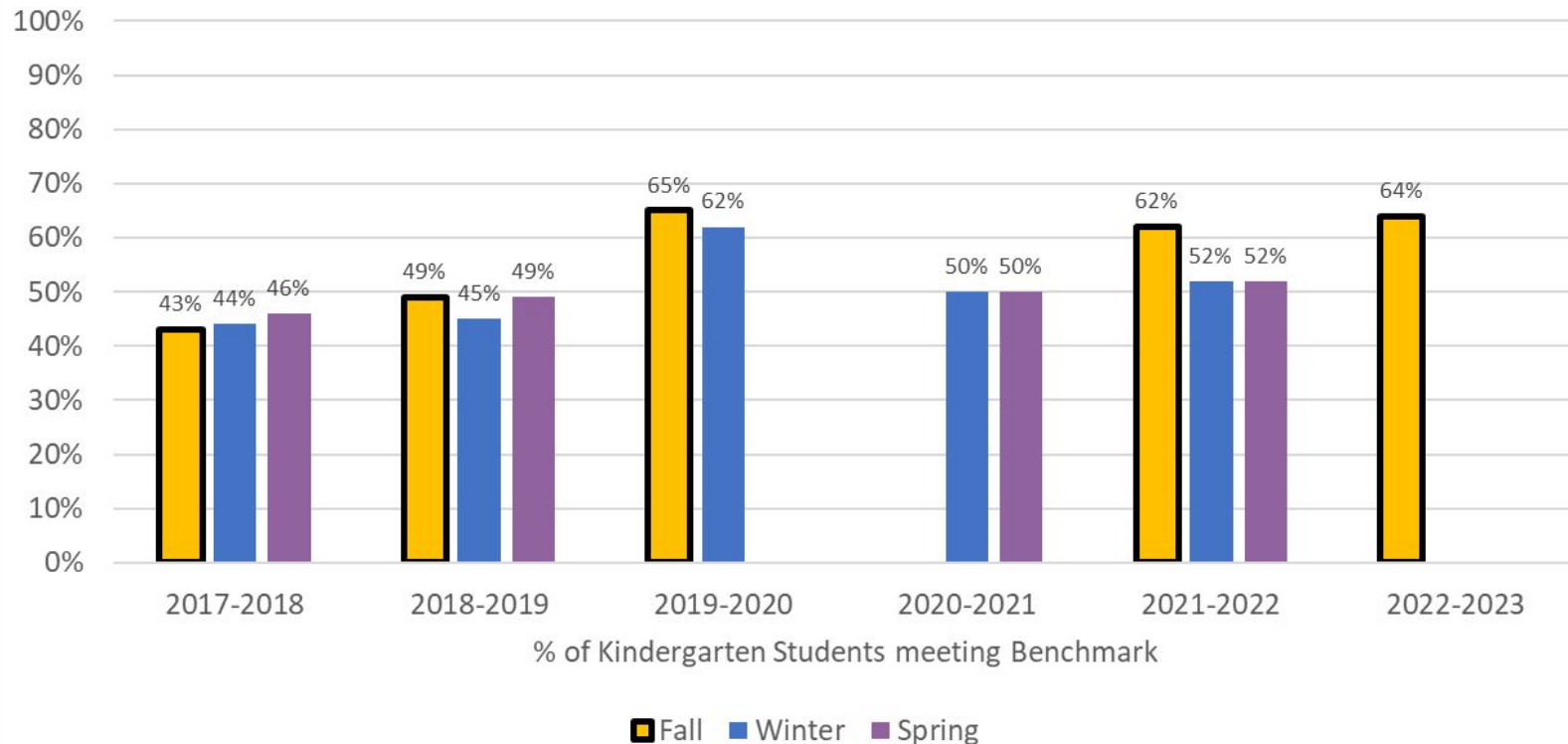

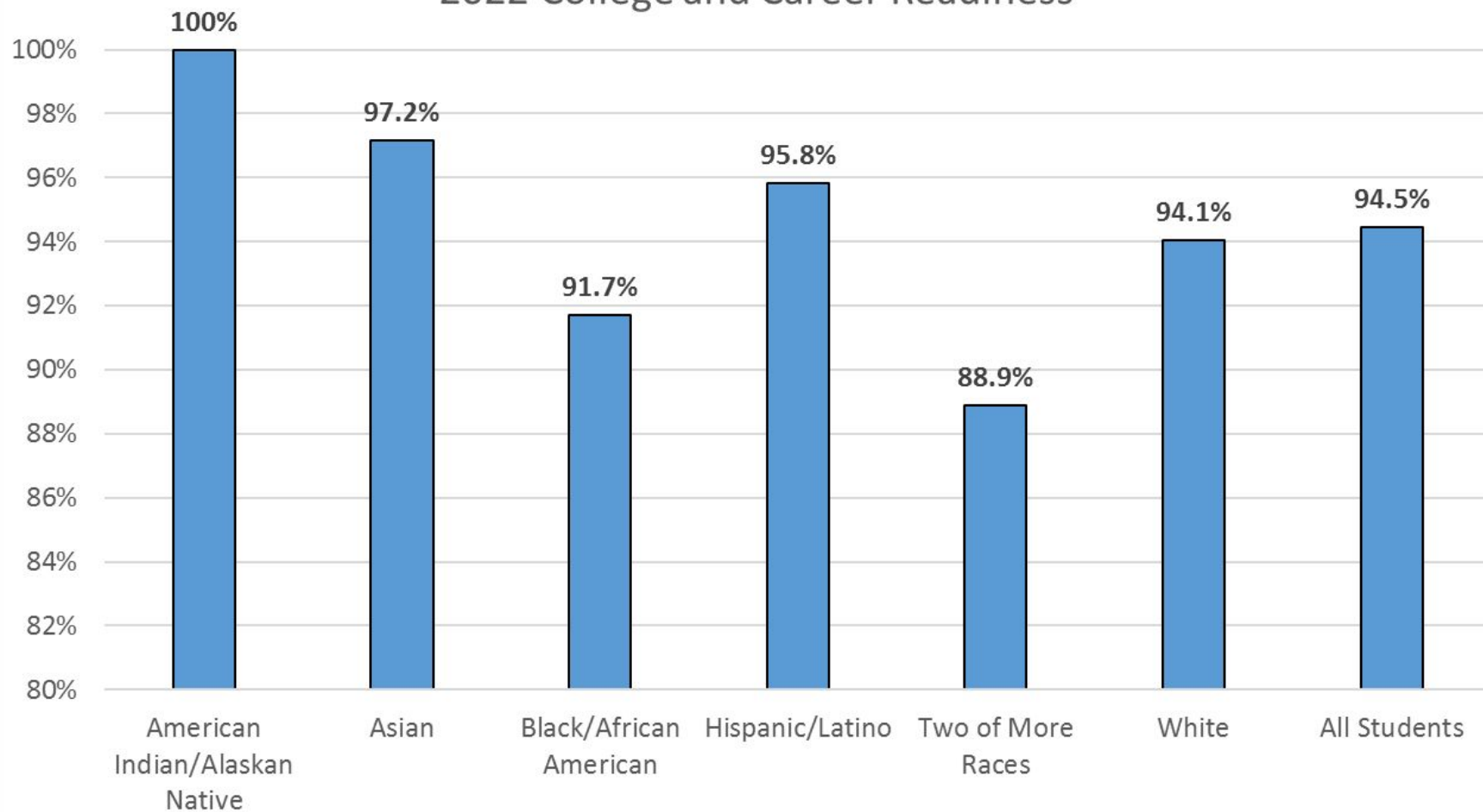
# Updated College and Career Readiness Criteria

  - Earning credit in a college-credit-bearing class
    - Concurrent enrollment
    - **Articulated credit**
  - Postsecondary enrollment options
  - **Industry credentials through 916 Career & Tech Ed (CTE)**
- Scoring a 3 or higher on the AP exam.
- Earning a Bilingual Seal.
- **3.0 GPA or higher**
- **ACT Composite Score of 21 or higher**

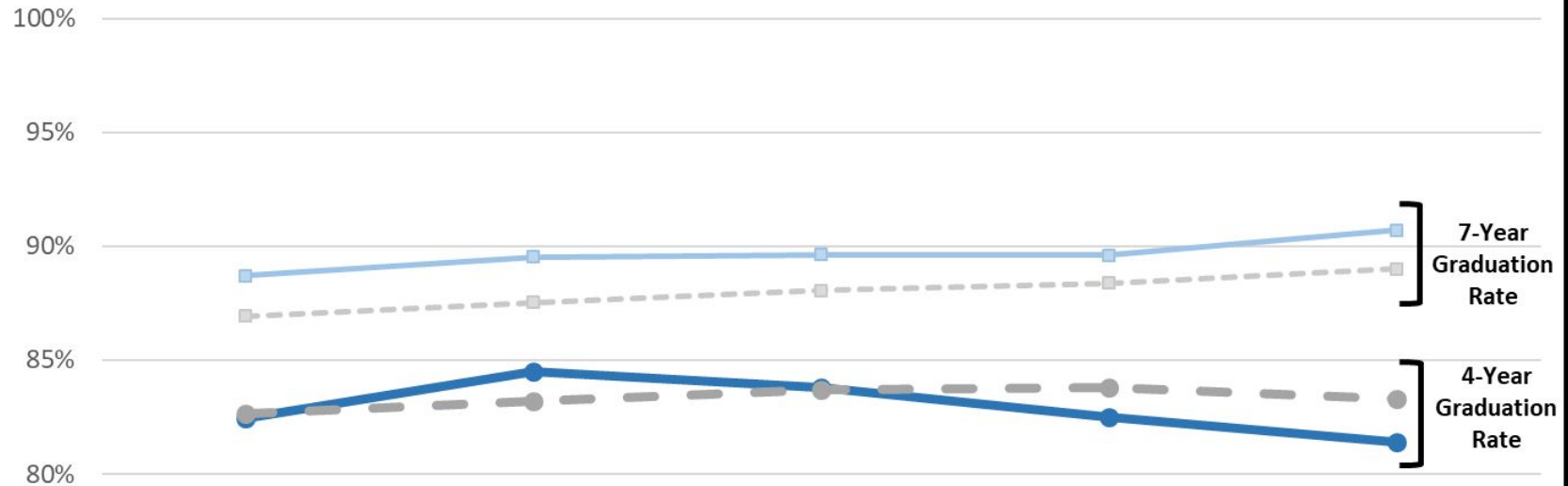

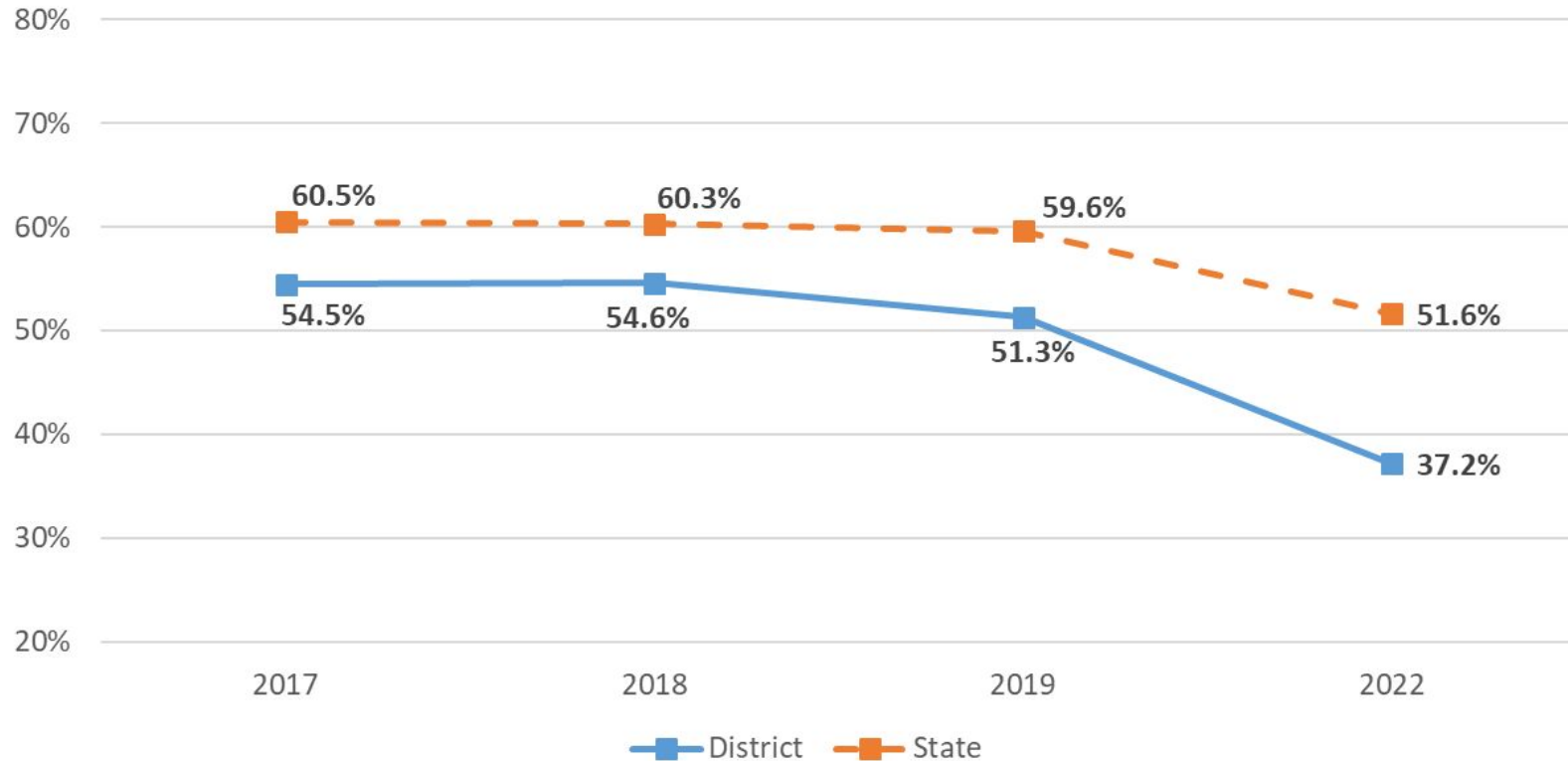

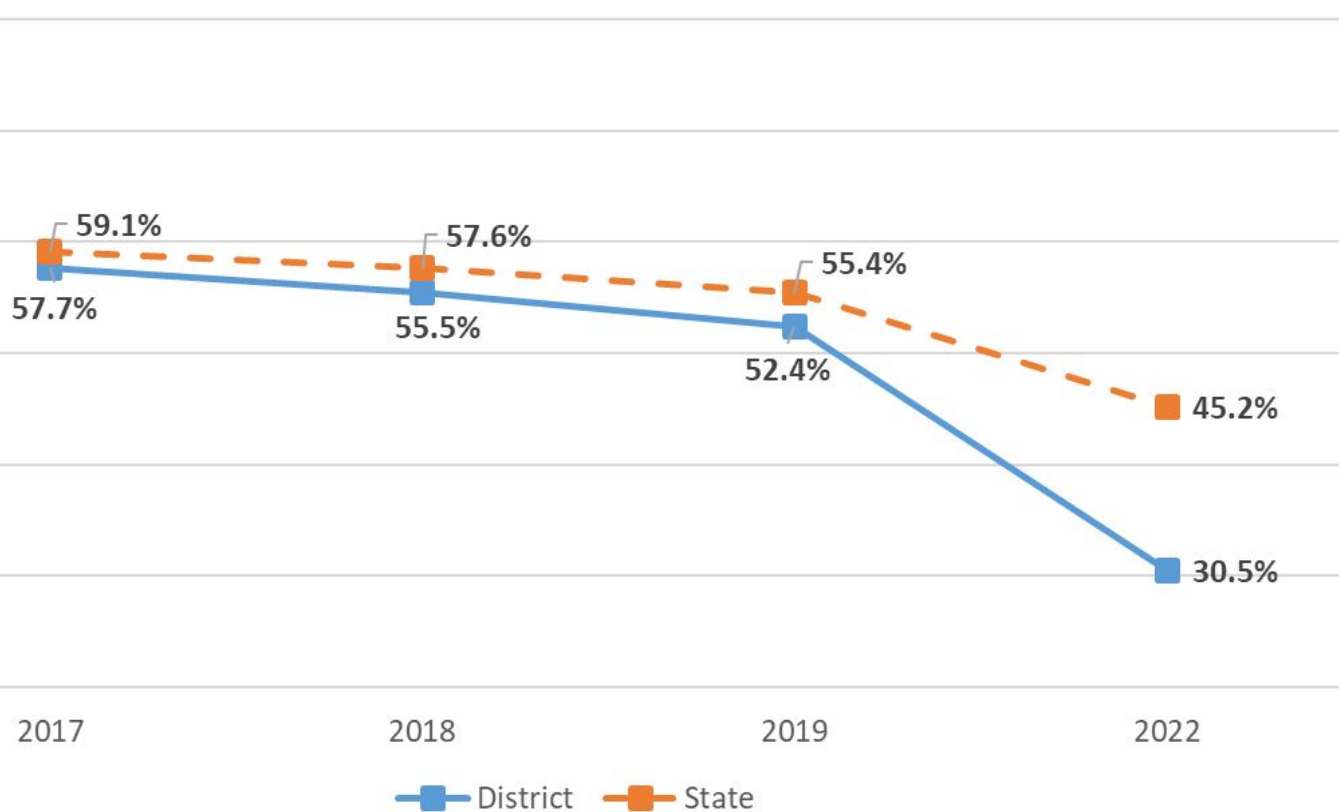

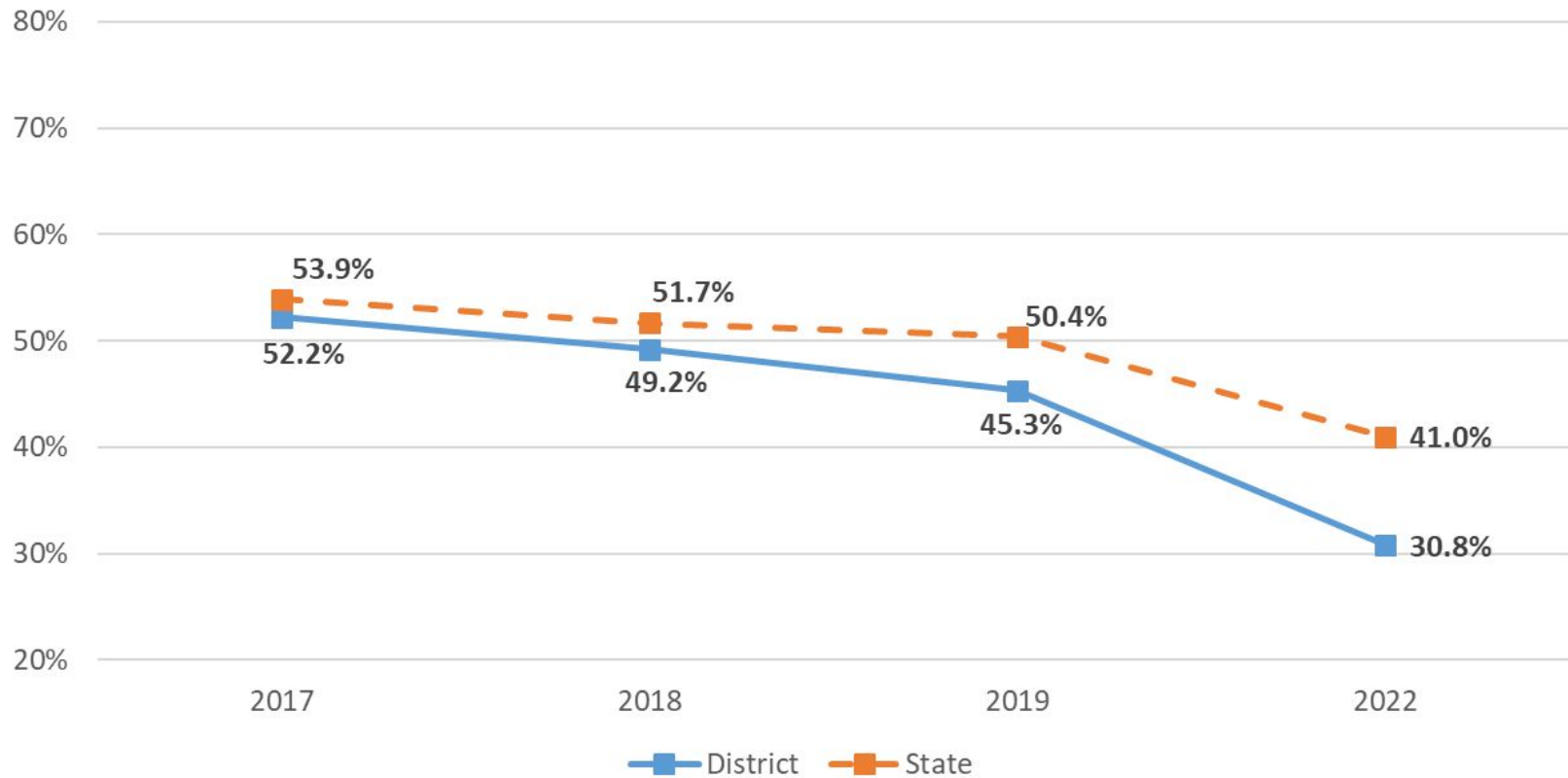
## MCA Percent Proficient Reading: All Grades Tested
