


#### Updated College and Career Readiness Criteria

- Earning college credits and/or industry credentials before graduation, which includes:
  - Earning credit in a college-credit-bearing class
    - Concurrent enrollment
    - Articulated credit
  - Postsecondary enrollment options
  - Industry credentials through 916 Career & Tech Ed (CTE)
- Scoring a 3 or higher on the AP exam.
- Earning a Bilingual Seal.
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- ACT Composite Score of 21 or higher
