STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

The Holbrook School Committee recognizes the needs of various groups to raise funds in support of extra-curricular and co-curricular activities and enrichment programs.

In the interests of enhanced student safety, it shall be the policy of the Holbrook Public Schools to limit the participation of students in school-related fund-raising activities as follows:

- A. All proposed fund-raising activities that will involve students in selling activities must be registered and receive prior approval from the Superintendent of Schools. The number of fund-raising activities that involve students should be kept to a minimum.
- B. Solicitation by students shall be limited to parents, family, friends, and trusted neighbors only.
- C. No student is to solicit door-to-door to strangers.
- D. All fund-raising activities by students must be properly supervised by adults at all times.
- E. Fund-raising activities that involve sales incentive prizes for individual students are discouraged. In the alternative, fund-raising incentive rewards or prizes should be whole-group or school-wide in nature to promote a cooperative sense of achievement rather than competition.

No money collections of any kind may be held in the schools without the specific consent of the Superintendent or his/her designee.

This policy will be distributed to the building principals for dissemination at the beginning of each school year to the appropriate groups who engage in fund-raising.
