

Work-Based Learning Courses

Earned WBL Credit

The Work-Based Learning (WBL) experience allows for the application of the knowledge, skills, and abilities that are delivered through the coursework of the Program of Study (POS). Students build on prior knowledge and skills in the program of study to further develop and apply employability and technical skills that prepare them for success in future career and postsecondary education. 100 contact hours within a work-based learning course code is equivalent to .5 elective credit. All work-based learning opportunities must follow Jeffco Board Policy.

There are three (3) options outlined on this document. CTE, NON-CTE and CareerWise. Option 1 (CTE) is below, Option 2 (NON-CTE) & 3 (CareerWise) are on the next page.

WBL CTE Courses:

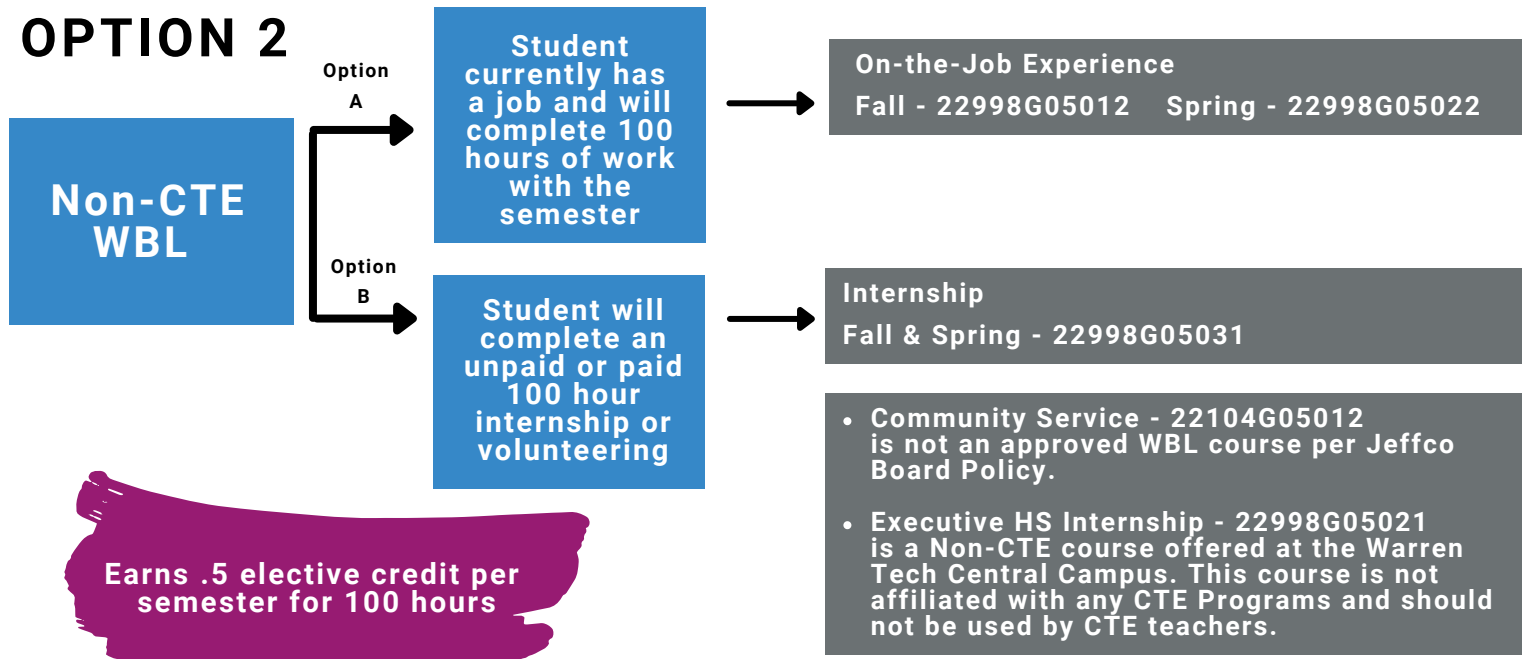
- Open to 9th-12th grade students in a CTE Pathway
- Pass/Fail Courses
- 100 documented contact hours = .5 transcript CTE Elective credit, Max .5 credit per semester
- No limitation on how many times a student can take it. (all 4 years is acceptable)
- Managed by the teacher of record for the specific CTE Pathway the student is in. (This only needs to be one (1) teacher per program).
- Students need to be employed or secure an internship related to their CTE pathway and complete a minimum of 100 clock hours within the semester. Additional credit cannot be awarded for hours above 100 per semester as outlined in the Jeffco Board policy.

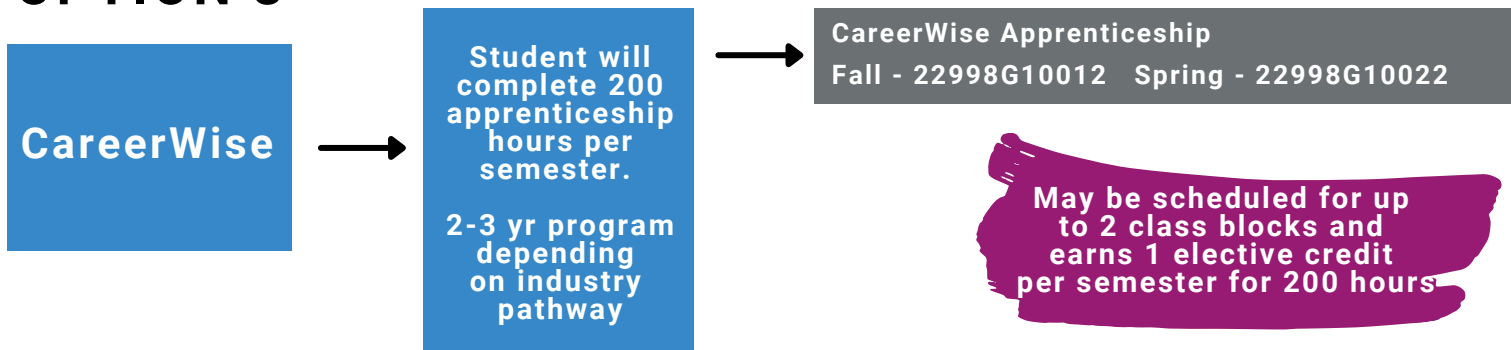

WBL NON-CTE Courses:

- All WBL Non-CTE Courses are P/F for high school juniors and seniors
- .5 Credit per semester (Max is .5 per semester) and managed by NON-CTE teacher or counseling
- CTE teachers should not use these courses for students enrolled in a CTE pathway
- On-the-Job Experience registration must have prior approval from the school principal and cannot exceed 20 hours per week without approval from the principal, parent/guardian and employer
- Maximum credit of 2.0 elective credits (no more than 4 semesters) on transcript (.5 credit each semester for 100 clock hours documented)
- All Non-CTE WBL Courses need to use the WBL Permission Form & WBL Student Agreement Form

CareerWise Courses:

- All CareerWise courses are P/F
- 1.0 Credit per semester and managed by designated school counselor(s)
- Students in the CareerWise program, must be on track to graduate with their class.
- All Non-CTE WBL Courses need to use the WBL Permission Form & WBL Student Agreement Form
