WHEREAS, harassment, intimidation or bullying is defined as any gesture, any written, verbal or physical act, or any electronic communication, whether it be a single incident or a series of incidents, that is reasonably perceived as being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristic, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical or sensory disability, or by any other distinguishing characteristic, that takes place on 126 school grounds, at any school-sponsored function or on a school bus, or off school grounds, in 127 accordance with law, that substantially disrupts or interferes with the orderly operation of the school or the 128 rights of other students, and that:

A reasonable person should know, under the circumstances, will have the effect of physically or emotionally harming a student or damaging the students property, or placing a student in reasonable fear of physical or emotional harm to his/her person or damage to his/her property; or has the effect of insulting or demeaning any student or group of students; or creates a hostile educational environment for the student by interfering with the students education or by severely or pervasively causing physical or emotional harm to the student; and

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION TO APPROVE AMENDMENTS TO THE EMERGENCY CLOSURE PLAN

1640 WHEREAS, On March 16, 2020, Governor Phil Murphy signed Executive Order No. 104 (EO 104) 1641 implementing aggressive social distancing measures to mitigate further spread of COVID-19 in New 1642 Jersey. Among other directives, Governor Murphy's Executive Order indefinitely closed all public, private, 1643 and parochial preschools and elementary and secondary schools to students beginning on March 18, 1644 2020. Executive Order No. 107, signed on March 21, 2020, superseded EO 104 and continued the 1645 necessary closure of all schools; and,

1646 WHEREAS, as detailed in guidance issued by the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) on 1647 March 5, 2020 and supplementary guidance issued on March 13, 2020, in order to count days during this 1648 closure period toward the statutory requirement to provide public school facilities for 180 days, school 1649 districts, charter schools, Renaissance School Projects and Approved Private Schools for Students with 1650 Disabilities (APSSD) were required to develop school health-related closure preparedness plans. These 1651 plans were designed to address continuity of critical school services such as remote instruction, special 1652 education and related services, and nutrition benefits. As a guidepost for districts in developing remote 1653 instruction plans, the NJDOE cited its regulations regarding home instruction due to a temporary or 1654 chronic health condition (N.J.A.C. 6A:16-10.1).; and,

1655 WHEREAS, On May 4, 2020, Governor Murphy announced that all New Jersey school buildings would 1656 remain closed for in-person instruction for the remainder of the school year 2019-2020.
