The East Brook recipient was Joanne DeSimone. Ms. DeSimone was described as being beloved by both students and her colleagues. She is known for her love of stickers and decorations in her classroom. She likes to motivate students and is passionate and caring about her job. She was then presented an award by Dr. Gamper and President Joseph Bruno.

The High School had two recipients. The first was Stephanie Buckley. Ms. Buckley is an English teacher who has been teaching for 16 years, the last 9 at Park Ridge. She has an engaging style, strong work ethic and morals. She pushes her students to learn far beyond the average. Morals and work ethic are strong. She was then presented an award by Dr. Gamper and President Bruno.

The second High School recipient was Andy Yeager. Mr. Yeager has been a member of the staff for twenty years. He is well known in the school and throughout the community. He has been instrumental in helping students deal with mental health issues. He heads numerous groups who work with at-risk students. X. Superintendent's Report

A HIB Update

Dr. Gamper reported that on March 26th he attended the Dare Graduation. On March 29th he read to 6th graders at 'Read Across America" Day. On April 6th, the district had its makeup snow day. Attendance was good. Student attendance was between 60-70%. On April 9th he attended a heart screening at Waldwick. He explained that the Shawn Fischer Memorial Fund pays for every student to have an EKG in freshman year to detect heart problems. The Butch Mancini family would like to bring this program to Park Ridge. The program will target the freshman class in September. The funding will come from their foundation.

Mr. Sileo commented that the program has proven to be effective. He has heard that there are cases where things were detected during the tests. The tests are for everyone, not just athletes. It is a simple process and takes 15-20 minutes.

Dr. Gamper reported that he attended the East Brook Science Fair and found it to be excellent. Among the K-6 projects, he saw an egg drop and a spaghetti bridge contest. The PTO did a great job organizing and funding this event.

Dr. Gamper reported that there were no HIB investigations last month.

Resolution Declaring the Public schools as "Stigma Free" and Celebrating Mental Health Month 2018

WHEREAS, mental wellness is essential to everyone's overall health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, the National Institute of Mental Health reports that 1 in 5 adults experiences mental illness in a given year and 1 in 25 adults live with a serious mental illness such as schizophrenia, major depression, or bipolar disorder; approximately 20% of youth ages 13 to 18 and 13% of youth ages 8 to 15 experience severe mental disorders in a given year, and;

WHEREAS, the stigma associated with the disease of mental illness is identified as the primary reason individuals fail to seek the help they need to recover from the disease, and;

WHEREAS, with the proper treatment of, and services to, people with mental illness can lead productive, fulfilling lives that can enrich our society; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Park Ridge formed a Stigma Free Task Force on May 20, 2014 to offer public education and awareness of mental illness in our community, including our schools; and

WHEREAS, the Stigma Free Task Force has done a commendable job in organizing themselves and promoting conversations and knowledge about mental health issues; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is supportive of the education and awareness activities of the Stigma Free Task Force; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Park Ridge Board of Education declares itself and the public schools as Stigma Free; and
