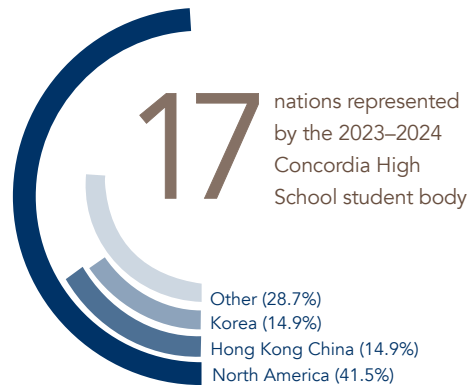

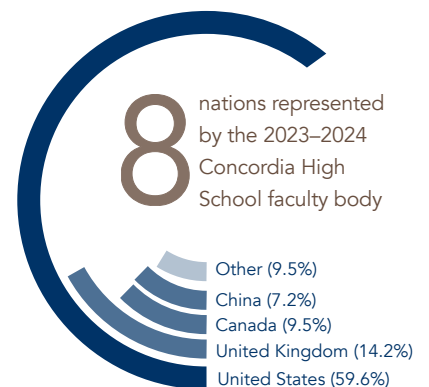

## Student Demographics



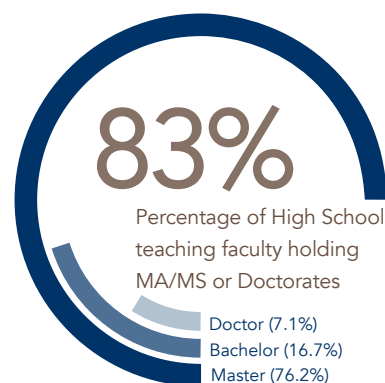
## Faculty Demographics

# Graduation Requirements

Graduation from Concordia (Grades 9-12) requires the completion of the following high school course credits:

- ▶ 4 credits of English
- ▶ 3 credits of Social Studies
- ▶ 3 credits of Science
- ▶ 3 credits of Math
- ▶ 2 consecutive credits of World Language
- ▶ 2 credits of Fine Arts
- ▶ 0.5 credits of Health
- ▶ 2 credits of Physical Education (participation required each year while at Concordia)
- ▶ 2 credits of Identity & Spirituality (participation required each year while at Concordia)

Students are expected to take seven full semesters of classes, choosing additional courses of interest beyond graduation requirements to round out their schedules each year.

For students who do not complete all four years of high school at Concordia, eligible credits from their previous high school will be added to those courses completed at Concordia to determine when graduation requirements have been met.

## Concordia's Applied Learning Curriculum

Concordia's academic departments have created Applied Learning (AL) courses in most subjects that go beyond, or supplement, the Advanced Placement® (AP) curriculum. AL courses were developed based on our understanding of good teaching and learning, as well as research into how students identify personal interests, develop passion and purpose, and practice skills and mindsets that translate to college success and workplace engagement.

Applied Learning courses have been designed with thoughtful and engaged 11-12th grade learners in mind.

To be designated as "Applied Learning", courses include the following:

### All Applied Learning courses *MUST* have

- ▶ An authentic application
- ▶ Academic rigor
- ▶ A focus on process skills (learning by doing)

### Applied Learning courses *MAY* have

- ▶ Learning and experiences outside of the classroom
- ▶ Flexible curriculum that responds to student input
- ▶ Interdisciplinary learning where students apply knowledge and skills in novel settings
- ▶ Experts in the field who work with students

## Global Online Academy (GOA)

Consortium of the world's leading independent schools, who use online platforms as classrooms.

GOA courses are open for enrollment by 11-12th graders; students in Grades 9-12 may opt to take additional language courses not offered on campus. Students may take one credit of GOA per academic year, with the option to take additional courses in the summer term.



## AP Courses Allowed

Students may take a maximum of nine AP courses over four years.

Grade 9 ▶ 1    Grade 10 ▶ 1    Grade 11 ▶ 3    Grade 12 ▶ 4

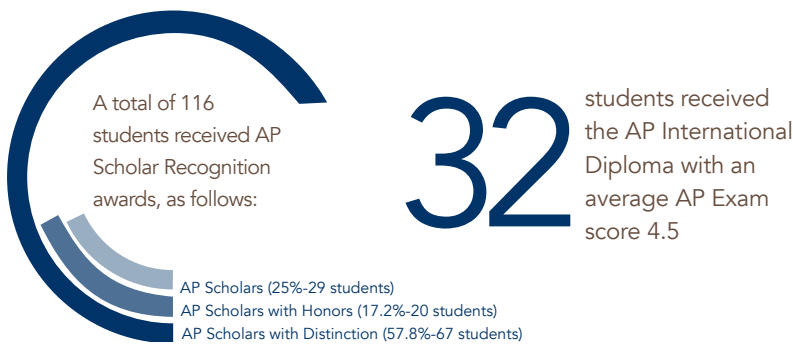
## AP Passing Averages

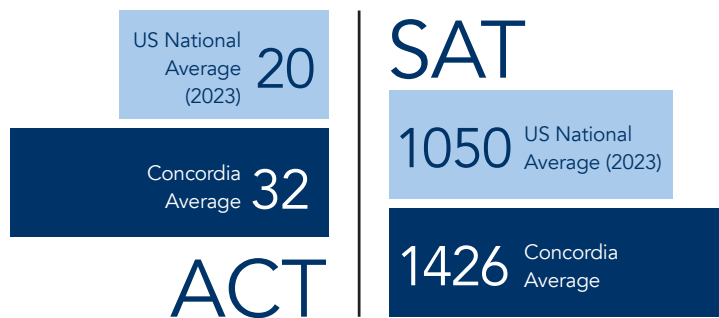

### ACT & SAT Mean Score Comparison for the Class of 2024

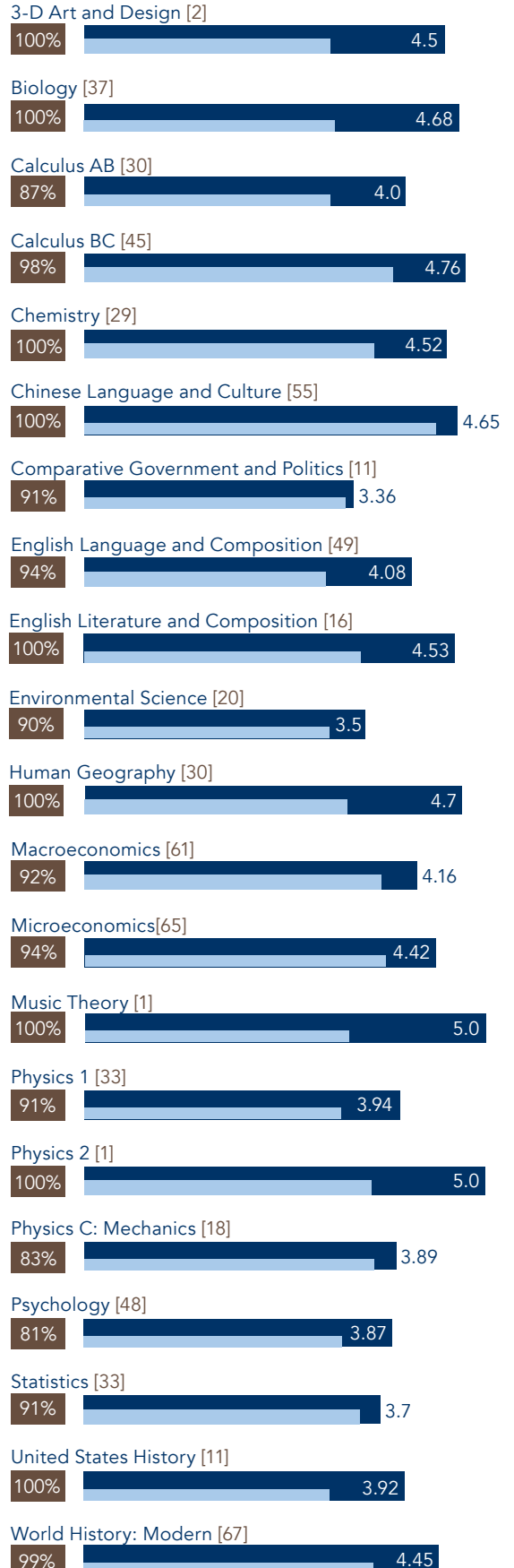

# Class Rank & GPA

- ▶ All instruction is in English with the exception of World Languages.
- ▶ Concordia uses a 4.0 grading scale. Only coursework completed at Concordia and through GOA are used in the calculation of a student's GPA.
- ▶ Concordia does not weight grades for AP or Honors courses.
- ▶ Due to the highly accomplished nature of the Concordia student body and the mobility of expatriate families, an individual's class rank is not reported.
- ▶ An estimated percentile placement will be provided to assist in university admission decisions if requested.

# University Matriculation

Our **336 graduates** from the classes of **2019 to 2023** received **1,350** acceptances to **362** universities in **16** countries and matriculated to **136** institutions. Universities with multiple matriculations are denoted by boldface print. Universities located outside the United States include acceptances as well as matriculation.

Concordia limits students to 12 applications to ensure each application is intentional. The Class of 2023 applied to an average of 7 colleges or universities per student.
