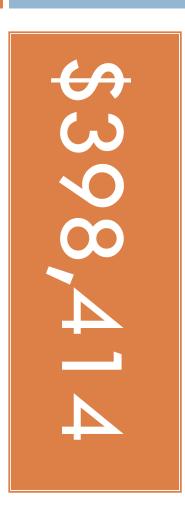

Not really a "cap" or a "limit"

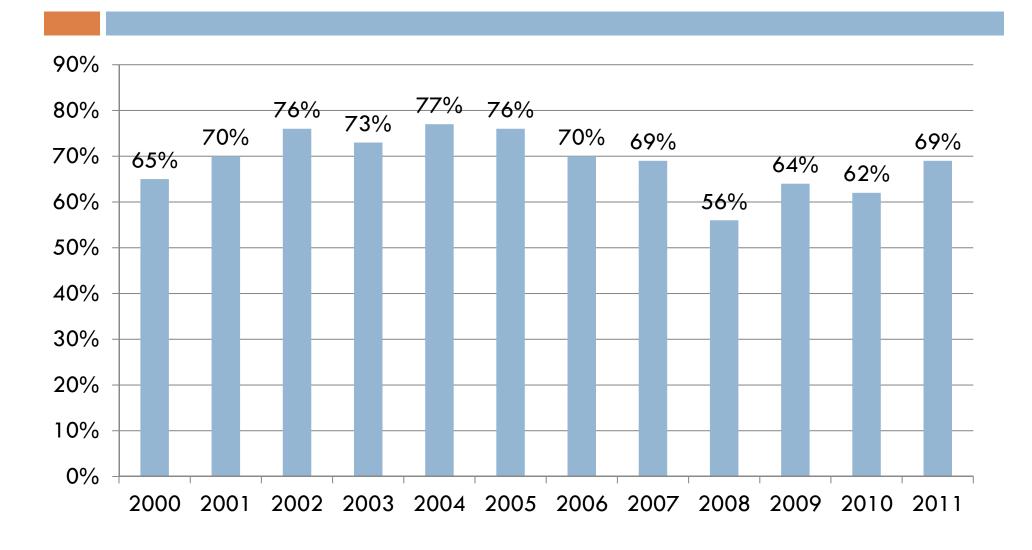
A threshold for level of voter support needed

"Tax Levy Limit"
Calculated by each district
Every district has a different tax levy limit

"Super Majority"
Over "tax levy limit" 60% of voters must approve

"Simple Majority"
Under "tax levy limit" more than 50% of voters must approve
