*\*\*Students graduating in June 2015 and thereafter are eligible for Pathways to Graduation. The 4 + 1 Pathways option was created for student in STEM, Humanities, the Arts, Biliteracy (LOTE) and CTE allows for some flexibility in exam requirements. Students requiring pursuing a diploma through Pathways to Graduation will meet with Mrs. Ellis to discuss and plan options.*

***Regents Diploma with Honors and Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation with Honors*** – Students are eligible for this distinction if the average of all Regents exams required for that diploma type is 90.0 or better (no rounding up is allowed). Students seeking the Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation with Honors must have also scored 65 or better on the Checkpoint B LOTE Examination.

***Regents with Advanced Designation with a diploma annotation that denotes Mastery in Math and/or Mastery in Science*** – Students must meet all assessment requirements for the Regents with Advanced Designation and, in addition, must score 85 or better on each of the 3 Regents Examinations in Mathematics and/or Science.
