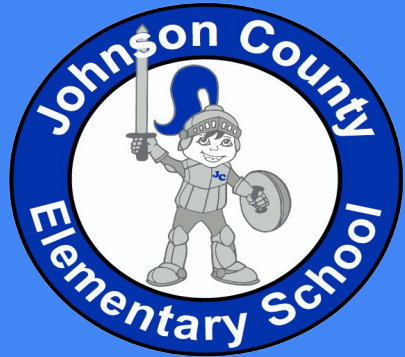

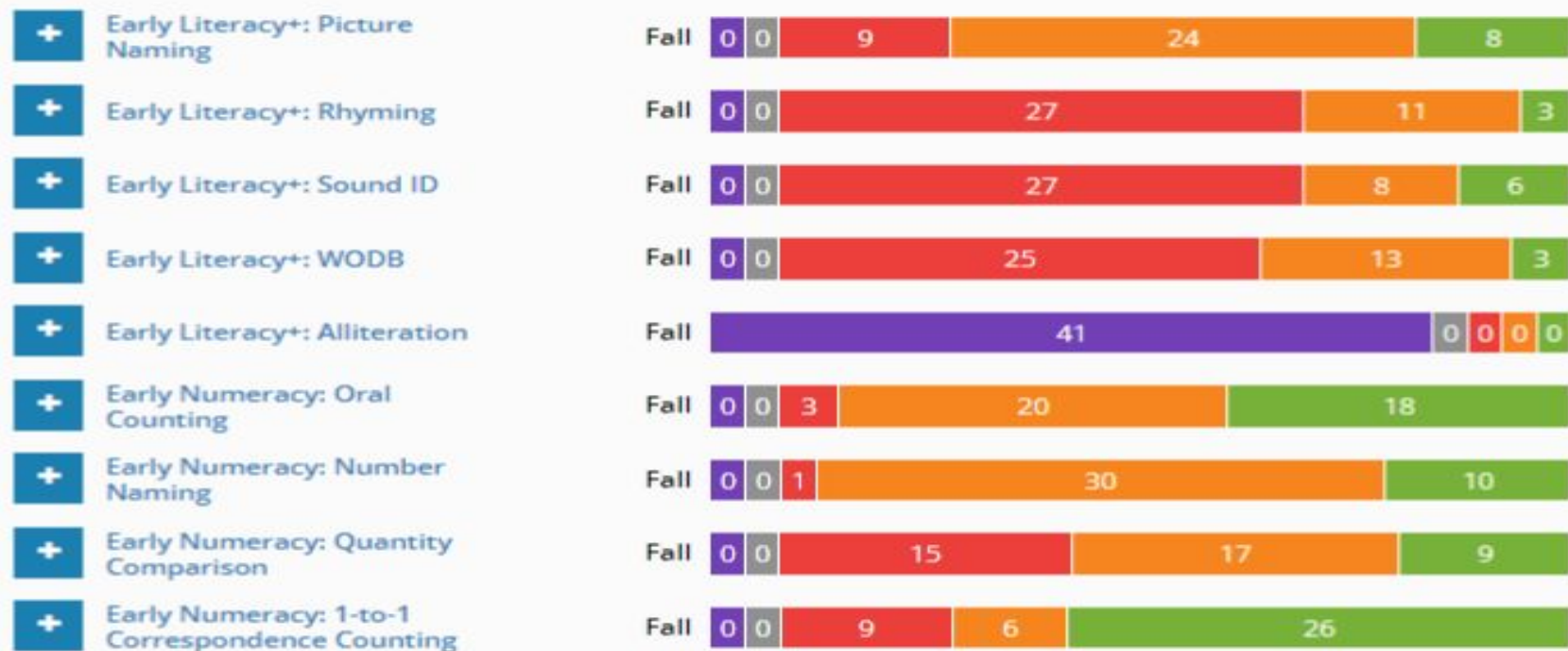
JCES SIP GOALS

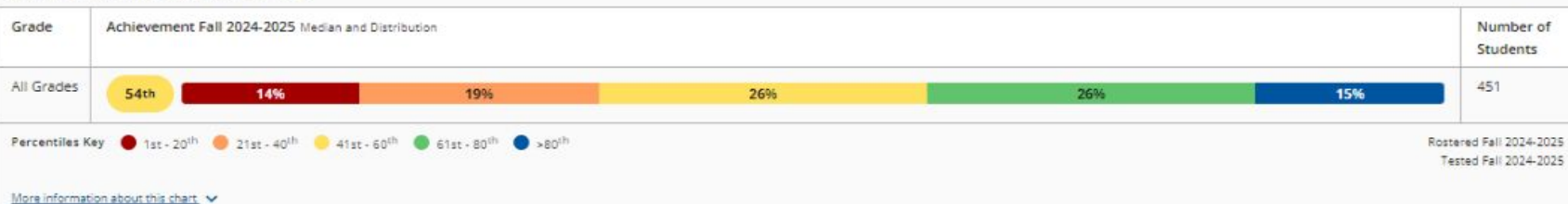

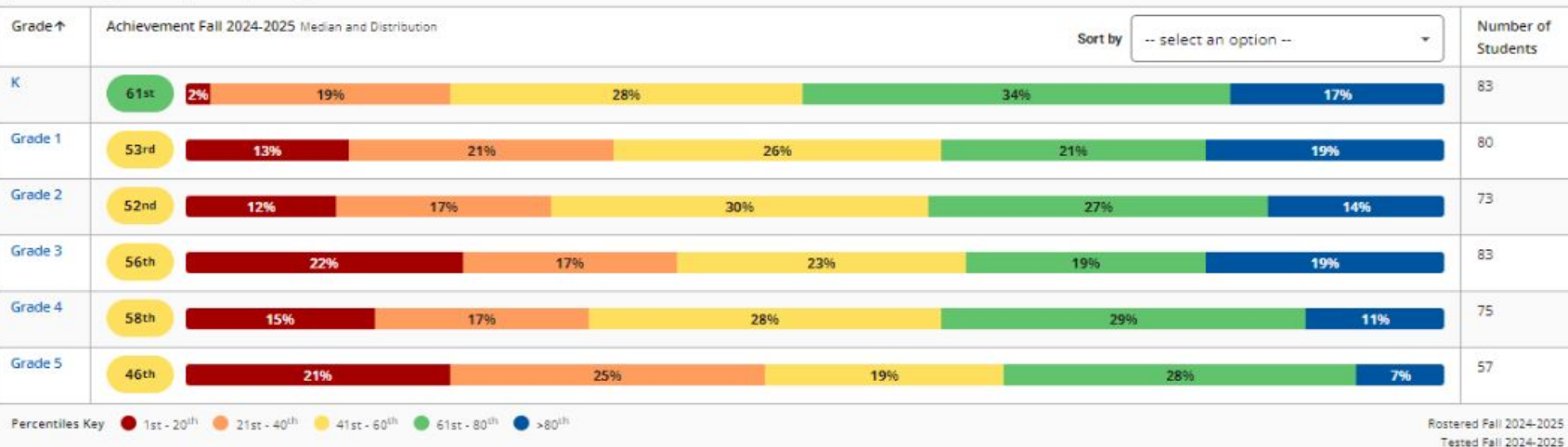

Strategies to Support Reading Instruction:

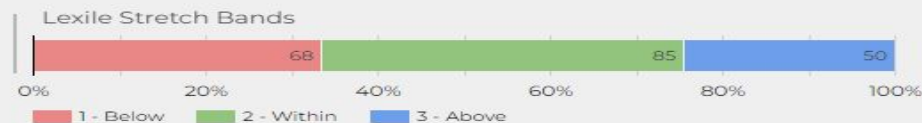
- letter tiles, word building (Elkonin boxes)

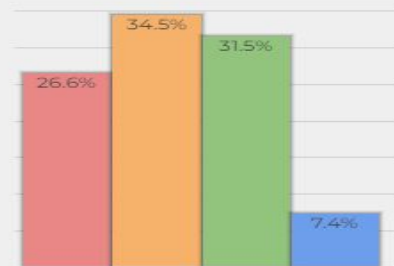

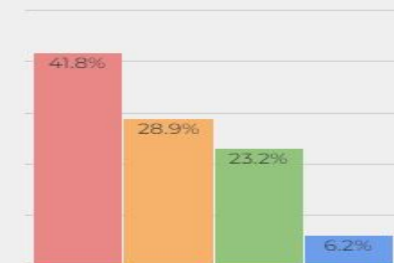

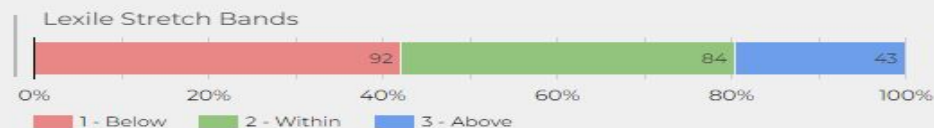

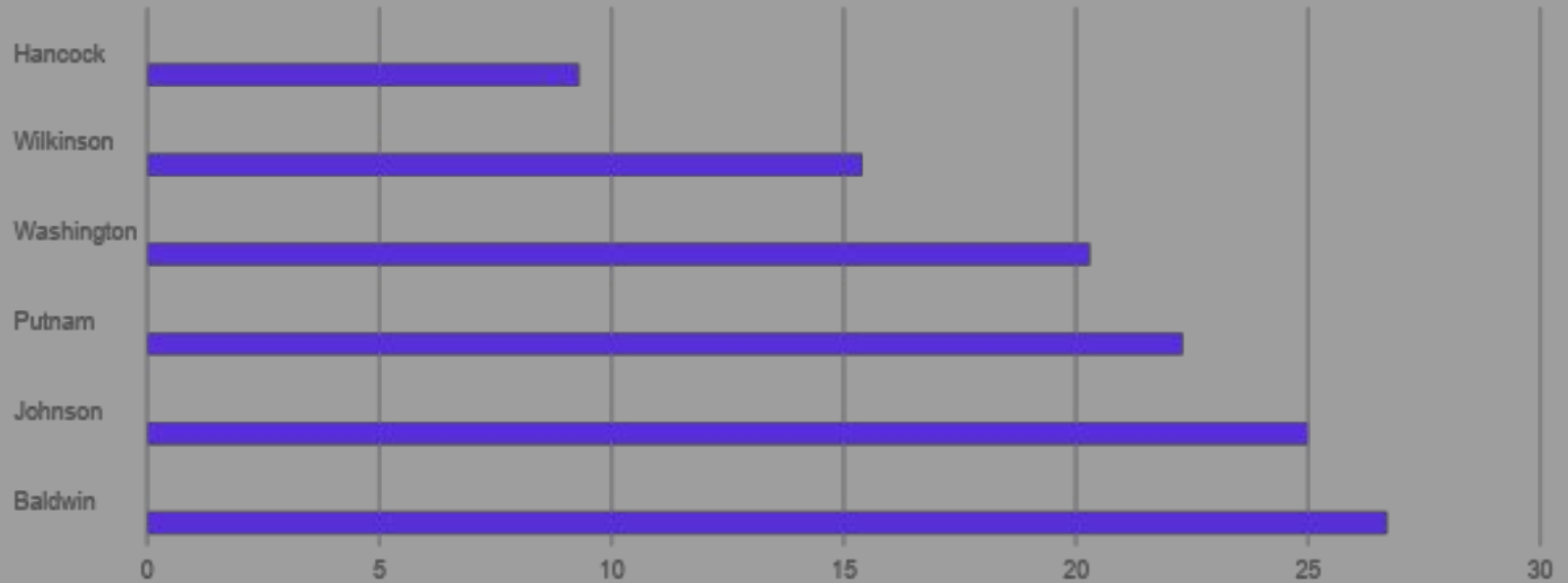
Achievement Level Breakdown



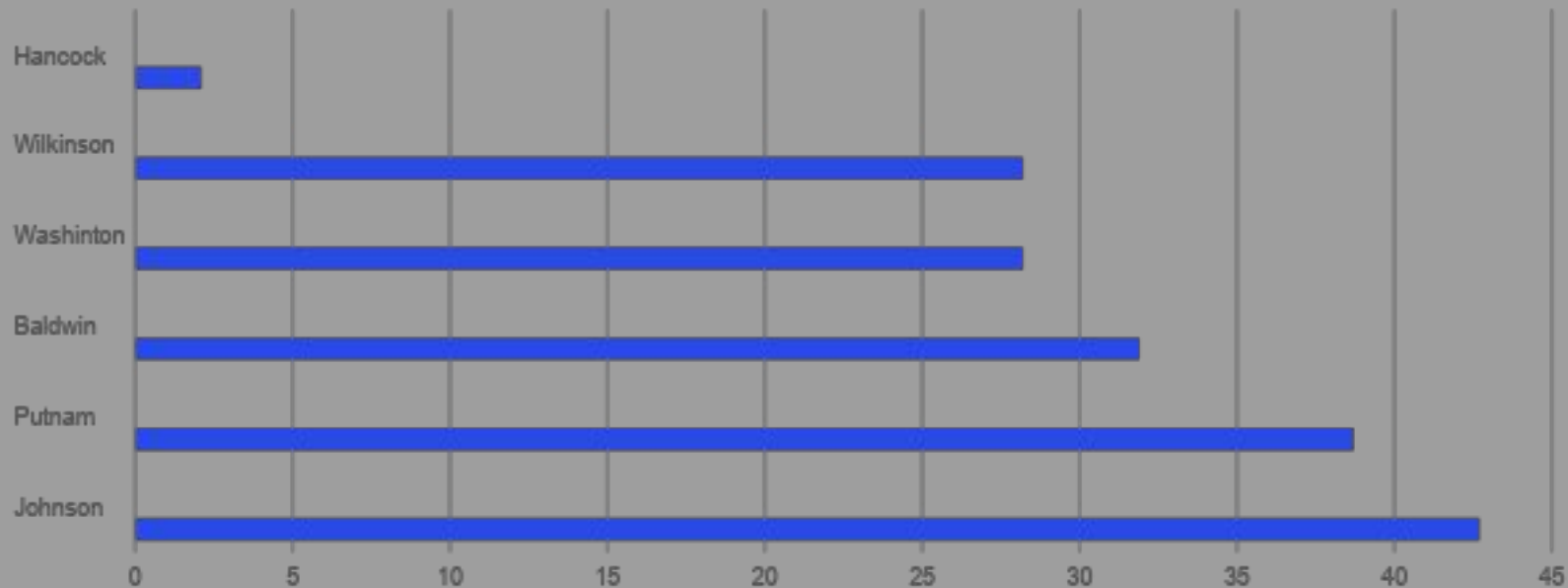

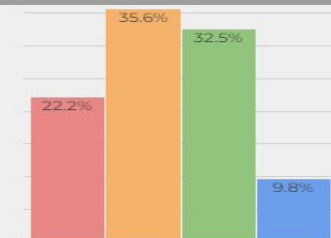

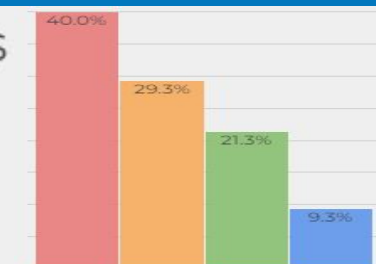

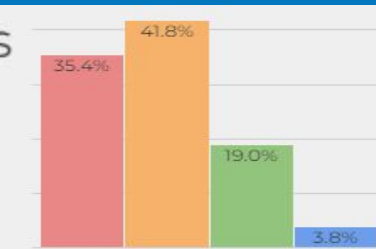

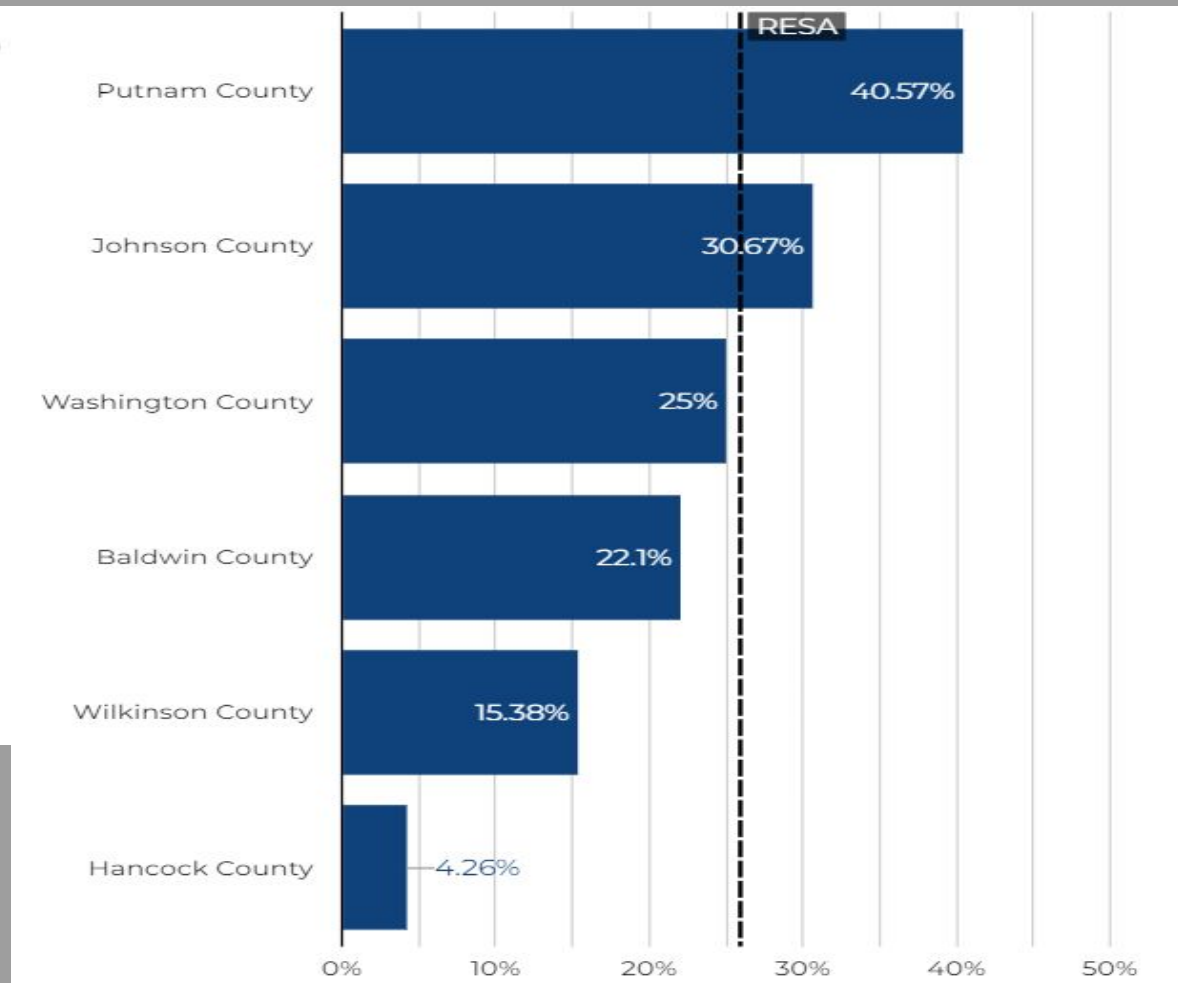

WHAT IS READINESS?

Readiness measures whether students are participating in activities preparing them for and demonstrating readiness for the next level, college, or career. The indicators for elementary and middle schools include at or above grade-level reading, student attendance, and beyond the core. High school indicators include at or above grade-level reading, student attendance, accelerated enrollment, pathway completion, and college and career readiness.

Strategies to support the school climate and culture goal:


1. We will greet students at the door each morning.
2. Monthly Whole Child Team meetings to review data and make data-based decisions
3. Teachers will teach SEL lessons every Monday for the 1st 20 minutes of class.
4. Complete an activity every nine weeks to celebrate students who consistently follow our schoolwide expectations.
5. Students will participate in brain breaks to encourage active engagement.
6. There will be an emphasis on de-escalation strategies and book studies on how to better serve various demographics.
7. Regular character development lessons will be facilitated by the school counselor.
