Music Curriculum Fellow December 15, 2023

The ELMS Music Department has had a busy year so far! It is concert season, so all ensemble classes have been practicing for their performances. The Winter Choir Concerts were held at ELMS on Tuesday, November 28, 2023 at 6 and 7pm. The Winter Band concert was at ELHS on Tuesday, December 6, 2023. The Winter Orchestra concert was at ELHS on Tuesday, December 12, 2023. All ELMS music staff and ELMS faculty are so proud of all of the hard work our musicians did to make these concerts special for the community. Band, choir, and orchestra students will also be performing for their peers in two in-school concerts on Friday, December 22rd.

Following highly successful Winter concerts, band, orchestra, and choir are now starting preparations on new songs. This is always a great time in the concert cycle to review and reinforce sight reading strategies. Choir has a collaborative concert with East Lyme High School coming up in March as well the Spring concert in May. All grade levels have at least one song in a language other than English, as well as a more familiar student choice song. Orchestra and Band will have their Spring concerts in June. In preparation for their Spring concerts, band students are rising to meet the challenges of pieces in less comfortable key signatures with more complex rhythms including dotted rhythms, triplets, and syncopation. 5th grade band and orchestra students have been excited to begin work on their first non-unison arrangements and are all doing a great job!

5th and 6th grade general music classes are currently reviewing what they have learned in the first half of the year. This includes music literacy, ukulele, and world drumming. The second half of the year will be largely project based learning based around piano, composition, and music technology.

7th and 8th grade general music is a semester-long class, so January meant wrapping up final projects with the semester one students, and welcoming in the semester two students. These classes review music notation and basic piano skills before moving into guitar, rock band, and music technology. We're excited to get started with our new groups of students!
