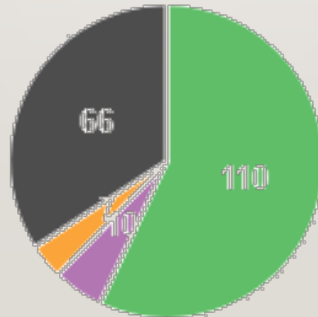
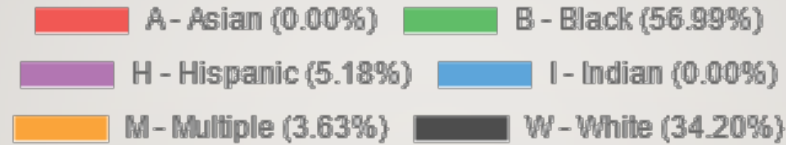
# SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

- I. By the end of 2024 school year, there will be a 3% increase on Satchel Pulse beginning benchmark indicators for middle school students that affect the whole child to cultivate social emotional skills in all areas.

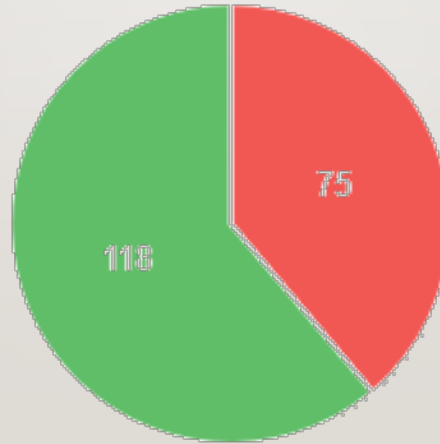

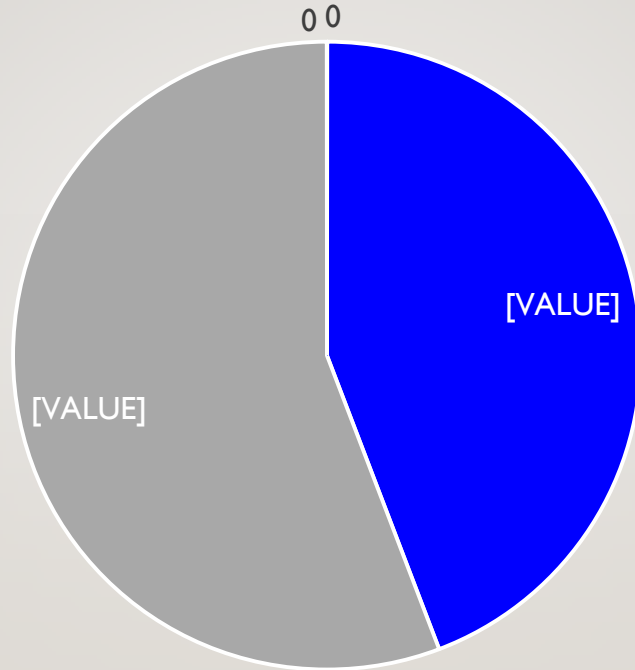

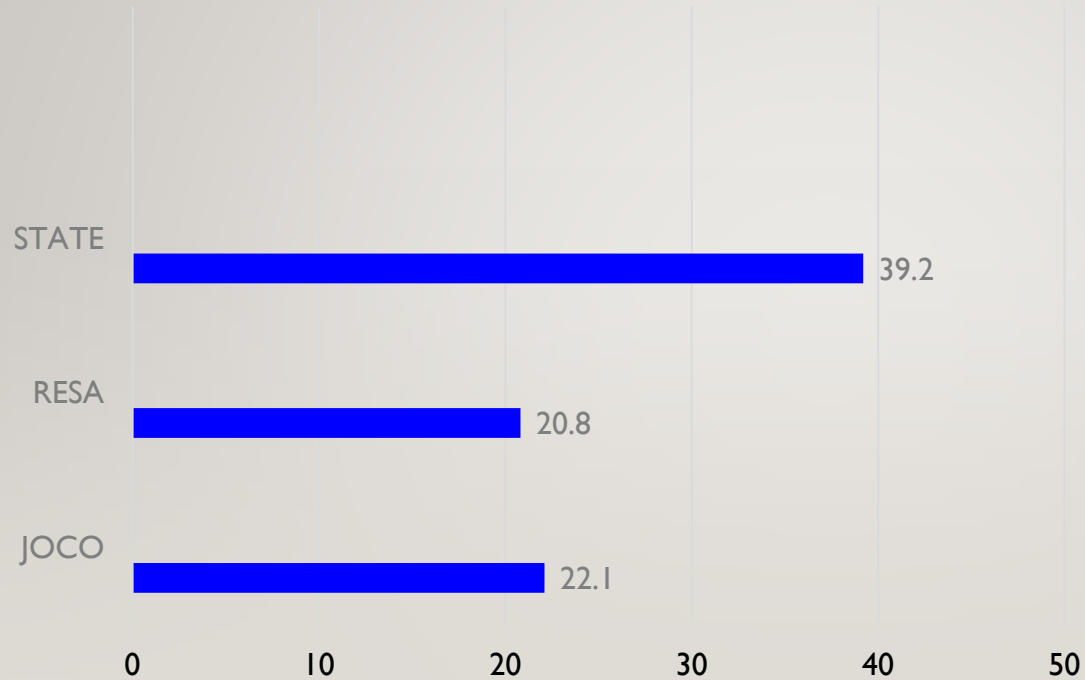

■ % Above Lexile    □ % Below Lexile

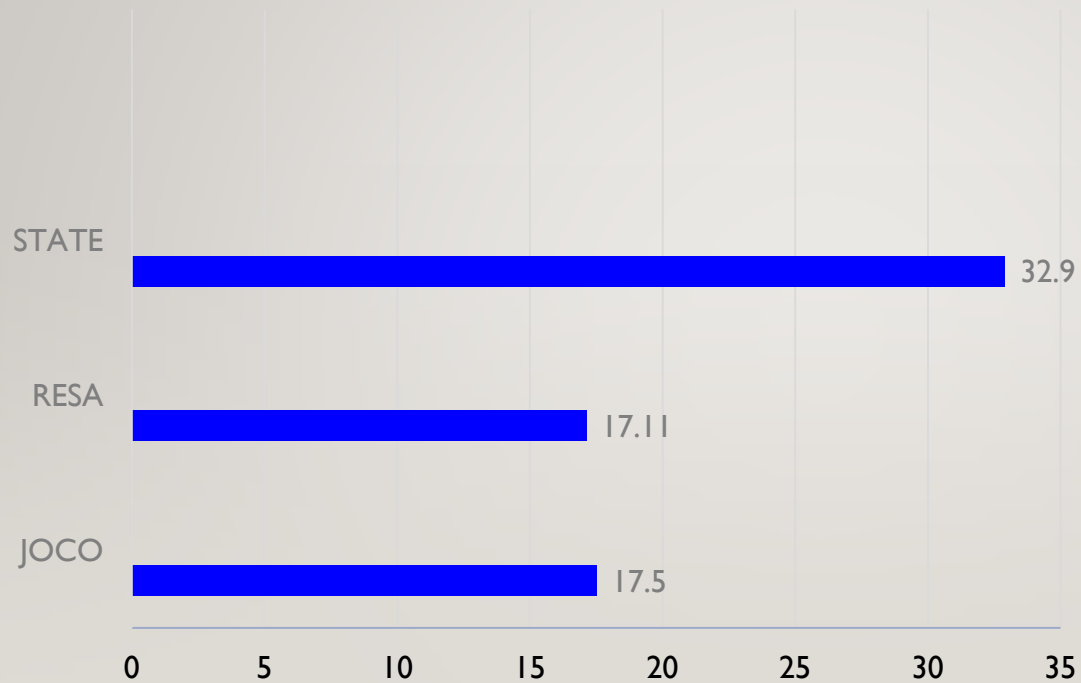

# 6th Grade: ELA Proficient and Above



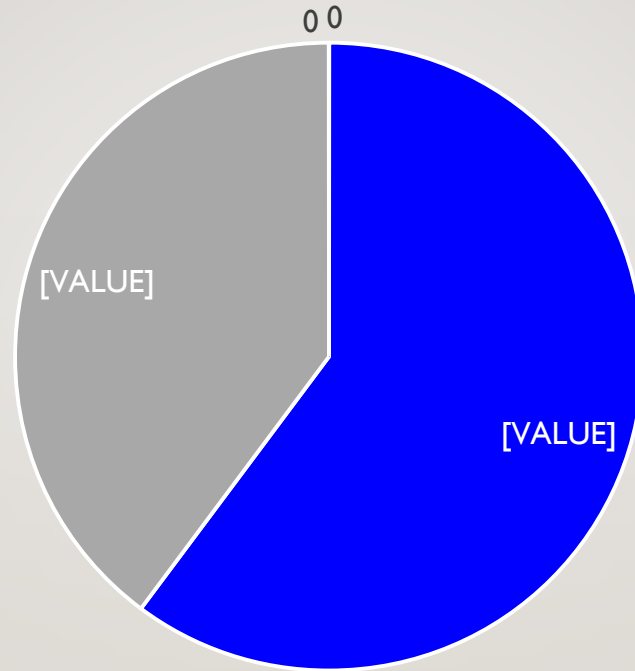

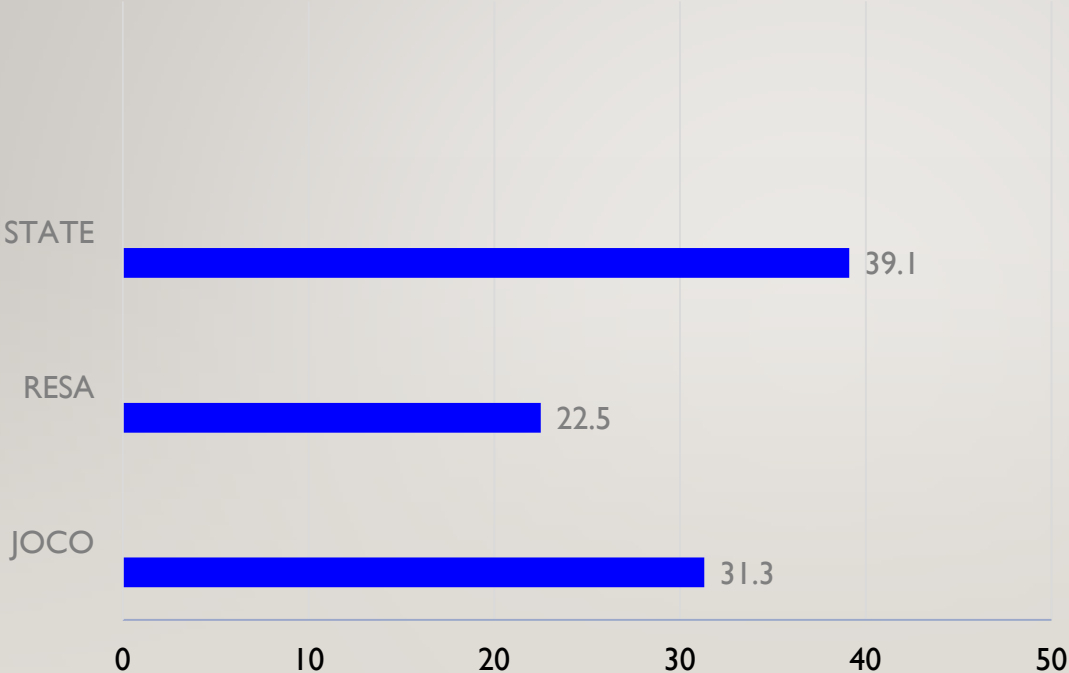

■ % Above Lexile    □ % Below Lexile

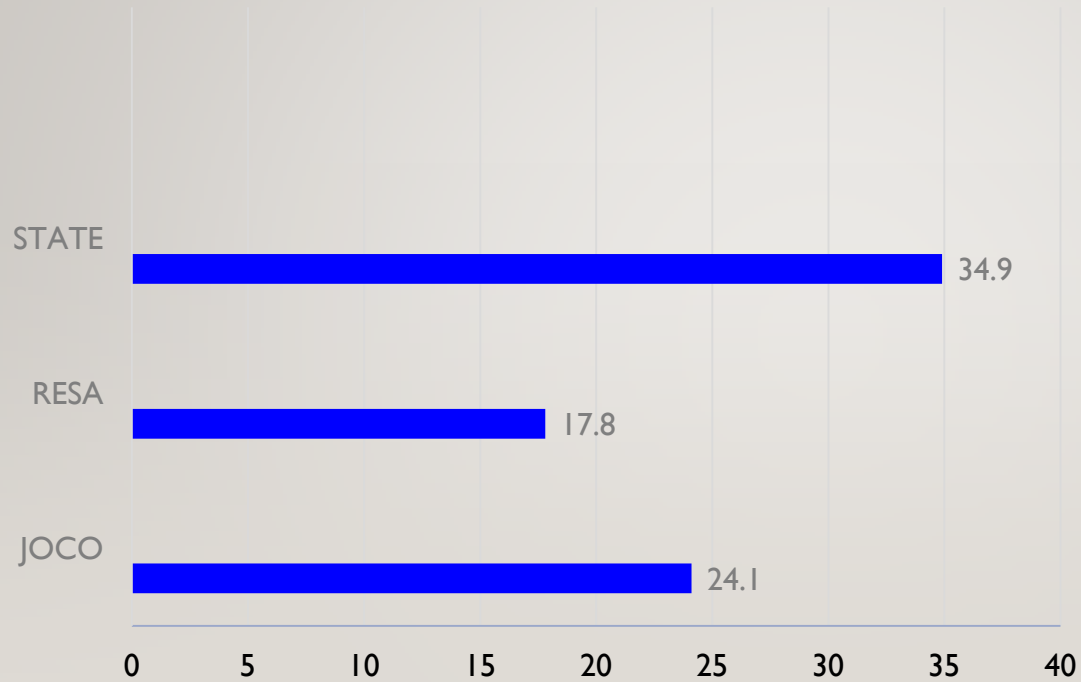

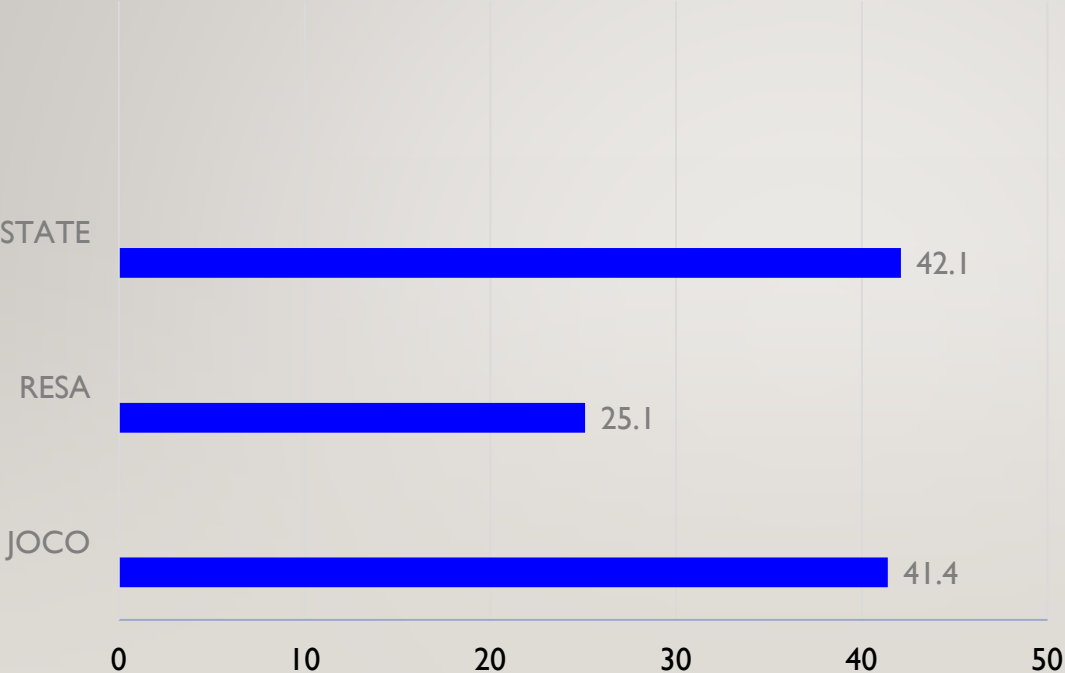
