Mr. Lederman spoke about Duncan’s accomplishment as a National Merit Commended Student. Over 1.6 million students entered the competition last October. From this group, approximately 34,000 students throughout the nation were recognized for their exceptional academic promise. Mr. Lederman congratulated Duncan on his accomplishment and presented him with an award.

Sabrina Sheridan, Grade 8, was recognized for the essay she submitted through the NJ Elks Club Association on “Why it is Important to Vote.” Sabrina was named the North District’s third place winner in the 2016 contest. June Bertini and Beverly Manzini, representatives from the Park Ridge Elks, presented her with an award certificate and a \$150 gift card.

Dr. Gamper congratulated all of the fall athletes. Chris Brown then recognized several accomplishments from student athletes and coaches. Mr. Brown spoke about Coach Harvey being named Coach of the Year in lacrosse. He mentioned that he led the team to a 12-4 record while winning the division title.

Next Mr. Brown spoke about the boys’ cross country team. The team finished 9-0. They won their NJIC Division, placed 8th in the County and 10th in the State. Mr. Brown congratulated each team member and presented them with a sweatshirt.

Mr. Brown then spoke about Mr. Farrell’s accomplishments, including qualifying for the County and State tournaments and finishing first in the league championship. He presented Coach Farrell a certificate and statue for his accomplishments.

Mr. Brown then spoke about Samantha Green saying she rewrote the record book for Park Ridge. He mentioned her accomplishments, which included winning the Great Adventure Safari Race, winning the group and placing 6th at Bergen championship. She was the first female cross country athlete from Park Ridge to win at the State championships. Her Athlete of the Week plaque is displayed in the school’s trophy case. She was named First Team All-League and All-County. She was named Cross Country Athlete of the Year. Mr. Brown congratulated her and presented her with a plaque.

Mr. Somjen gave a presentation on the proposed Elementary School Media Center renovations. He explained that the purpose of the renovations was to improve the aesthetics and modernize the space. The current room has chairs and tables that are not flexible and some equipment is dated. The new furniture would be flexible, on wheels and interchangeable. It will have soft seating and easy to move around. In reviewing the plans, he pointed out a space that was created, which he called a "theater for presentations." The shelves will be moved to the perimeter of the room. Other options being considered are converting storage room to create a green room, and building a Lego wall. There will also be a small sink and cabinet added as well. Lighting will be replaced with LED fixtures. The budget will be just shy of \$800,000 with \$50,000 of furniture at each school. The space will have new ceilings, new carpet and fresh paint. The existing unit ventilators will be replaced. The shelves will be on castors so they can be moved around.

The Board asked several questions:

- Mr. Bruno asked what adding air conditioning would add to the cost. Mr. Somjen responded that it would be \$200,000. He also confirmed that the air conditioning could be added at a later date.*
- Mr. Sileo asked if the architect had explored using split units. Mr. Somjen indicated that he had not explored this option yet as he was waiting for more direction from the Board.*
- Mr. Moran asked about the current age of the unit ventilators. Mr. Somjen indicated that he did not know.*
- Dr. Gamper asked if the hallway walls have only built-ins. Mr. Somjen responded that you can have options. Those options are accounted for in the budget he presented.*
- Mr. Bruno asked about the flooring. Mr. Somjen responded that it would be carpet tile and will be laid down in individual pieces. He explained that the tile allows you to fix damaged tiles with spare tiles.*
- Mr. Sileo asked about the timeline. Mr. Somjen indicated that he was still waiting for direction from the Board on the scope of work. He would need to first speak with the furniture company to find what the lead time is. He would also need to get the DOE application in. He estimated that construction could start in the summer of 2018.*
- Mr. Somjen indicated that the budget assumes regular hours but not after hours work. Doing work after hours would increase the budget.*
- Mr. Bruno asked how much time each space will need. Mr. Somjen responded about 2-3 months of work. Mr. Somjen mentioned there may also be some restrictions due to the district's summer program.*
- Mr. Moran asked about the ventilation units. Mr. Somjen indicated that the unit ventilators need to meet code requirements. These requirements have changed since the last unit ventilators were installed. You do not need to change the current ones but the new ones will need to meet the new code and standards.*

- *Mr. Sileo asked if the High School project is ready to go. Mr. Somjen responded that it was and the referendum was ready for March.*
- *Mr. Sileo asked if the contractor doing the work at the High School could do the unit ventilator work at the elementary schools. Mr. Somjen indicated it would be possible but could not be charged to the High School project.*
- *Mr. Church asked for the “drop-dead date.” Mr. Somjen indicated that the district would need to get a bid out by March or the bid responses may come in too high.*
- *After some discussion, the Board agreed on a budget of \$300,000 for each building and directed the architect to see if the AC cost could be bid through the steam conversion project. The resolution to proceed with the project will be put on the re-organization meeting.*

Everyone is looking forward to winter break.

HIB Update

Dr. Gamper reported that there were 3 HIB reports, 2 were confirmed, one at the High School and one at West Ridge.

Dr. Gamper reported that he attended the December 5th Holiday Concert at East Brook. He also attended the Middle School Vocal Concert. He thought it was very entertaining and had an enjoyable evening. On 12/14 he went to a workshop on future ready certification. He felt the district stood a good chance of receiving this certification. He is currently deciding which schools will apply. He thanked the East Brook PTO for their rock wall donation.

XI. BOE Committee Reports

The Technology Committee discussed security software. They decided on a solution that was not a "Cadillac" but it will sufficiently protect the district.

The Buildings and Grounds Committee asked Mr. Wright to speak to Brian about a card access system for the tennis courts.
