



## DUAL SPORT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

As a student at Caledonia-Mumford High School, it is my request to be an active participant in the sports of \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_. I understand that this is agreeable to my coaches, my parents/guardians, myself, and has been approved by the Caledonia-Mumford Administration.

The following is a list of criteria included in this option.

1. In situations where there is a game/meet/practice in both sports scheduled on the same day, I have decided that I will participate in \_\_\_\_\_ (primary sport).
2. I understand that scheduling will result in conflicts between events in both sports.
3. If there is a conflict between practices in one sport versus game/meet competition in the other sport, the competition has priority.
4. I agree not to switch the priority sport during the course of the season. If one sport becomes a better situation for the team or for me personally, I will still adhere to my decision as stated in #1 above.
5. Academics are the priority. This request will only be considered if the applicant is in good academic standing (85% average) at the time. If this academic standard is not maintained as reflected by bi-weekly grade reports, the student will discontinue participation in the second sport and there will be no appeal.
6. Athletes may compete the same day in both sports. Athletes may NOT leave the primary sport contest until that game is completed. Athletes cannot attempt to play in two games simultaneously.
7. Transportation must be provided by only the parent/guardian of the student-athlete when he/she cannot be released from the primary sport in time to ride on the team bus. No students may drive themselves to a contest or practice. The return to school follows school/team protocols.
8. I understand that a suspension or removal from a team due to a disciplinary reason will result in removal from any other sport the athlete is participating in. The circumstances will be reviewed by the school administration and both coaches to determine if the student-athlete will be allowed to resume participation at all or in only one or both sports.
9. A violation in training rules will result in concurrent consequences in both sports based on the game suspension chart for each sport.
10. An athlete that quits one of the two sports may not utilize dual participation for the remainder of the school year.



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11. The coaches and school administrators will meet at approximately the mid-point of the season to determine if the agreement should be continued for the remainder of the season or if the athlete should focus on the primary sport only.

12. This decision is mine and has been agreed to by all the respective parties.
