VI. Special Presentations to the Board

A. Dr. Cathy Timpone: Results of the 2014-2015 NJASK Grades 4 & 8 Science NJBCT Biology Testing

Dr. Timpone gave a presentation which compared the Park Ridge Schools test scores with the state average and with the average of school districts grouped in our Socio-Economic Factor Group (DFG). Dr. Timpone reported that in NJASK Science testing, Grade 4, both elementary schools, did well. Our overall trend was to show improvement in Proficient and Advanced Proficient.

Grade 8 Science results were slightly better than last year and the High School Biology test results were also better than the previous year.

Dr. Timpone explained that the District analyzes the data it receives and sends teachers to workshops to learn about standards and their applications. Bergen County will once again have a joint curriculum writing session that will be used to update the curriculum for next year.

Dr. Timpone explained that the new code requires that all test results be presented to the public within 60 days after receiving them. The PARCC scores are due out tomorrow. The State has decided to release the actual test questions from last year to assist in preparing for the tests this year.

When asked about her thoughts on the results, Dr. Timpone commented that everything will change next year as there will be differences in the general science standards. Dr. Timpone confirmed that both schools are using the exact same resources materials. Dr. Timpone concluded by stating that the test results will be reviewed with the principals to see if any changes are warranted. Anyone interested in the presentation can download it from the District's website.

VII. Hearing of Citizens

Agenda Items Only

Hearing of Citizens will be restricted to three minutes per person for a total of fifteen minutes for questions and/or comments on agenda items only.

Frank Fuchs commented on the proposed High School field rate changes. He feels that the cost is prohibitive for outside groups. Arsenal Soccer is comprised of 17% of Park Ridge residents. It is not possible to achieve the 51% needed in order to get the fees waived. He explained that Arsenal is essential to Park Ridge High School teams because it acts as a feeder to the High School program. He also felt the current field allocation guidelines are such that outside groups will never get sufficient time on the fields. He stated that PRAA puts in for large blocks of time, which shut other groups out and, as a result, there is no pressure for them to use their time efficiently. He cited several instances where there was no one on the field even though the PRAA had that time allocated. He also complained that he

asked Mr. Montalbano to sit with him to develop a fair fee structure but never received a call. He believes the resolution on the agenda should not be voted on. He asked the Board to come up with a reasonable fee structure. He asked the Board to table the vote.

VIII. Student Representative's Report

Eunique reported that the football team lost to Cresskill in a close game during the last few seconds. They play Becton Regional next Friday. The girls' soccer team beat Waldwick 2-1. Boys' soccer is now 7-4. They beat Emerson earlier today. The cross-country team is getting a lot of recognition in the 5000 meter. The marching band took 2nd place in the Bergenfield competition, narrowly missing first by just two points. This weekend is the Montvale Band Festival and will be their last hurrah. Members of the Interact Club volunteered at Pascack Health Center. SADD will visit schools to educate peers on prejudice and violence. The fall play is still in the works. Set construction is done.

HIB Update

Dr. Gamper reported that there were no HIB investigations since last meeting. He congratulated all the fall sports teams. They have been a lot of fun to watch. Dr. Gamper attended Fitness Day at East Brook. He commented that over \$7,000 was raised. There was a test message sent out on the schools emergency message system on October 1. He asked anyone that did not receive the call to contact the board office. The District recently hosted a Schoology Workshop. There were half-a-dozen districts represented. Dr. Gamper thanked Mr. Lederman and Ms. Bacolas for setting the event up. Dr. Gamper also reported that Mr. Lederman is currently looking into the future of mid-terms and final exams.

The Education Committee reported that they met with the two elementary school principals. They approved the AP music book and professional development plans for the elementary schools.

Buildings and Grounds Committee reported that the library renovations are progressing. They also reviewed the progress being made on general maintenance items.
