THE POSITION

The American International School in Egypt - Main Campus (AISE-Main) seeks to appoint a Principal for the Primary School division who has a passion for excellence and innovation in teaching and a demonstrated track record of leading student-centered programs.

The Primary School Principal has overall responsibility for the organization and operation of the Primary School, including working with the Director and other leadership team members to recruit, develop and retain outstanding faculty and staff, formulate the school's strategic plans and programs, and direct the day-to-day operation of its Primary School programs. As a collaborative and welcoming school leader, the Principal will also make meaningful contributions toward building a strong sense of community and positive culture within the school.
