

Liz's Closet:
A Discreet, Free Resource for CBE Students in Need



What: Liz's Closet is a place where any student who does not have access to basic needs items may go "shopping" with no cost to the student. This is a safe place where students can get general hygiene products and nonperishable food items. There will also be reusable bags available so items are less visible as students are leaving the building.

Where: Liz's Closet will be located in the music hallway. Students will access Liz's Closet through the Counseling Department.

Who: Any student in need of these items is welcome to take what he/she needs with the help of a trusted adult. This includes but is not limited to students who receive free/reduced lunch, students whose families have experienced a loss of their home or serious illness, students who are new to the U.S., etc.

How: There are 3 ways students can access Liz's Closet. **1)** Students are welcome to directly ask a trusted adult at CBE to use Liz's Closet who will then bring the student to Student Services or notify Student Services that the student will be coming **2)** To maintain privacy as best as possible, a student can click on the link found on the counseling page within the CBE website. This link will bring them to a form to fill out that will then notify the counselors that the student would like to visit Liz's closet. **3)** A parent can call to notify Student Services, and the student will be asked to stop by during a time that works for him/her to collect items.
