Dr. Z Selected as Texas Nominee for 2024 National Superintendent of the Year



Tomball ISD Superintendent Martha Salazar-Zamora, Ed.D., has been selected by TASA as Texas' nominee for 2024 <u>National Superintendent of the Year</u>, an award given by <u>AASA, The School</u> <u>Superintendents Association</u>.

Salazar-Zamora has served as superintendent of Tomball ISD, a fast-growing district of more than 22,000 students northwest of Houston, since 2017, when she became the first female and the first Hispanic to hold the position in the district's history. Prior to that, she served as the district's chief academic officer for three years.

Salazar-Zamora says what makes her most proud of Tomball is the staff's dedication to students and commitment to working as a team to the benefit of everyone in the district. She works to cultivate "Team Tomball," a sense of community and teamwork and a culture of learning in the district that helps benefit individual learners day in and day out.






















# Unique Opportunities Available for ALL Students STEAM Conference
